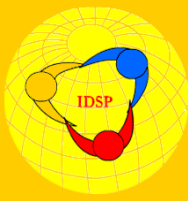

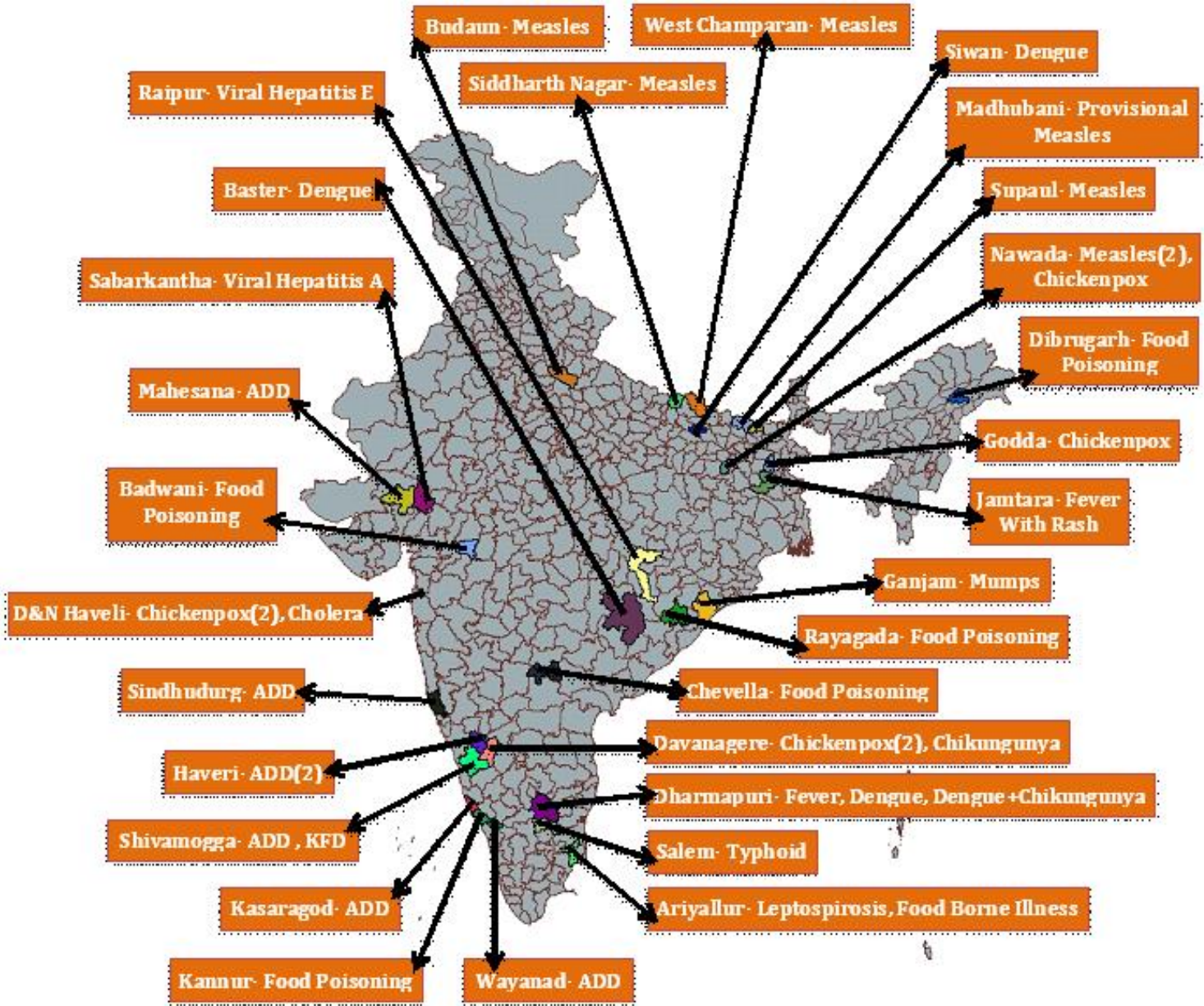

1st Week Map



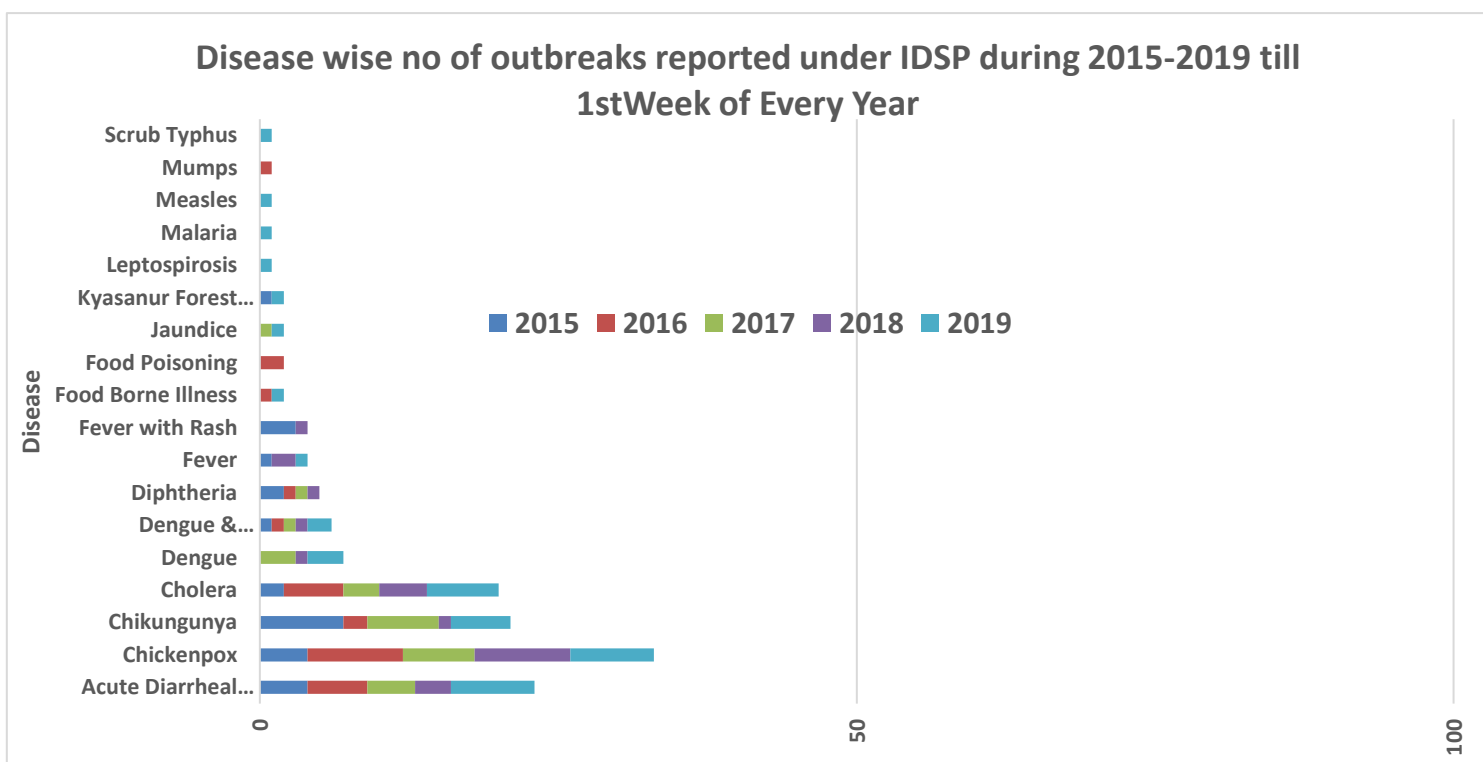
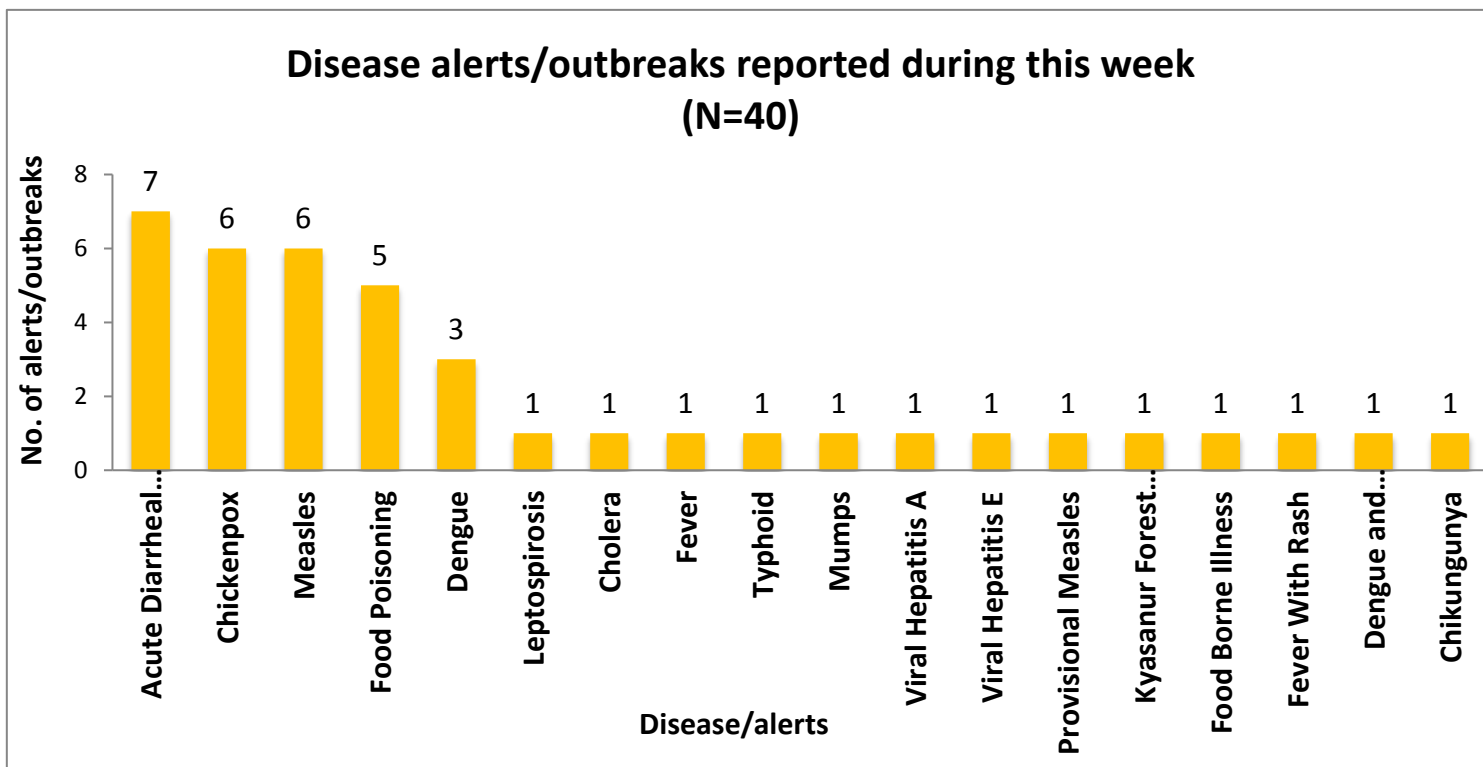
