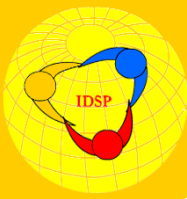

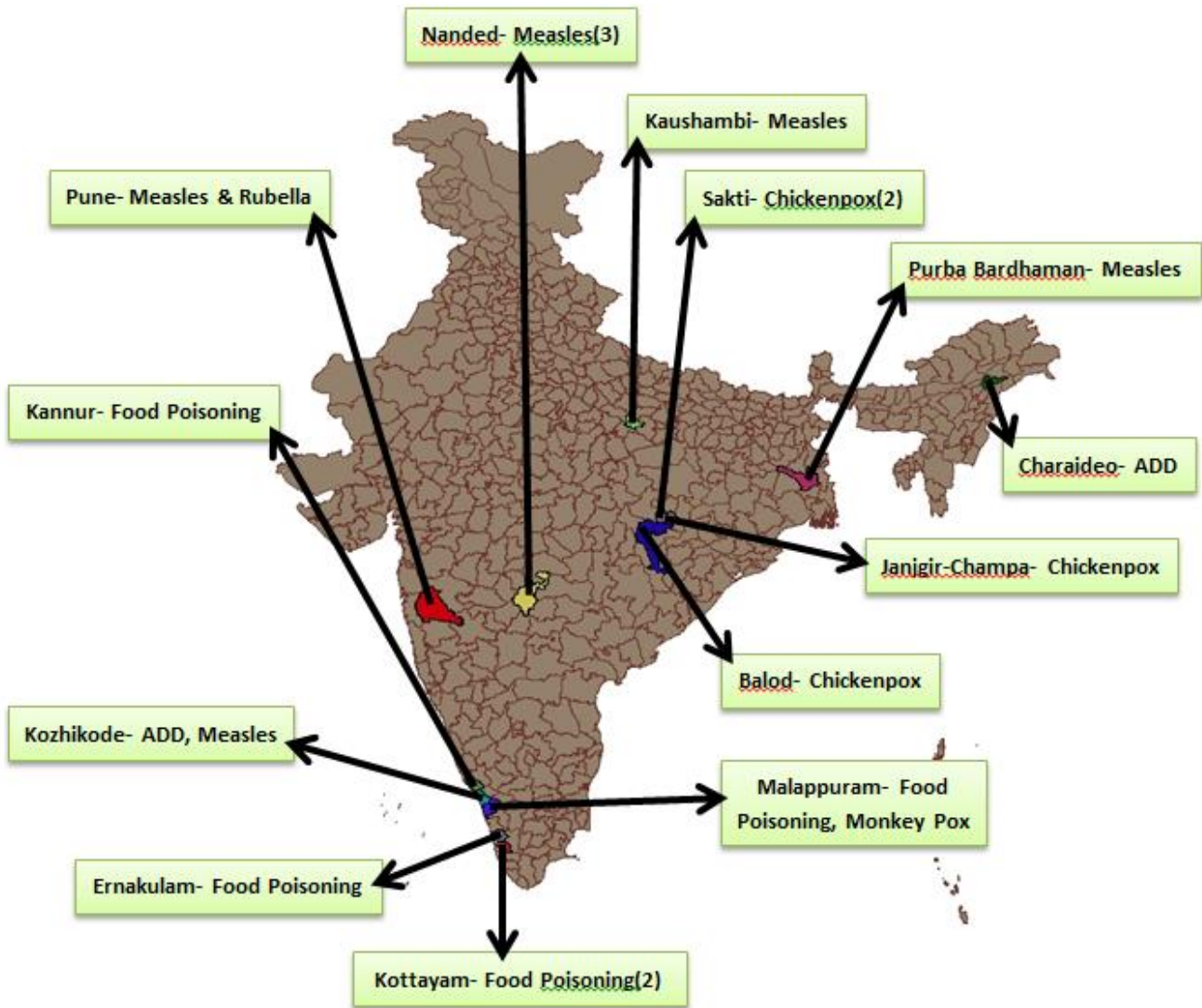

2nd Week Map

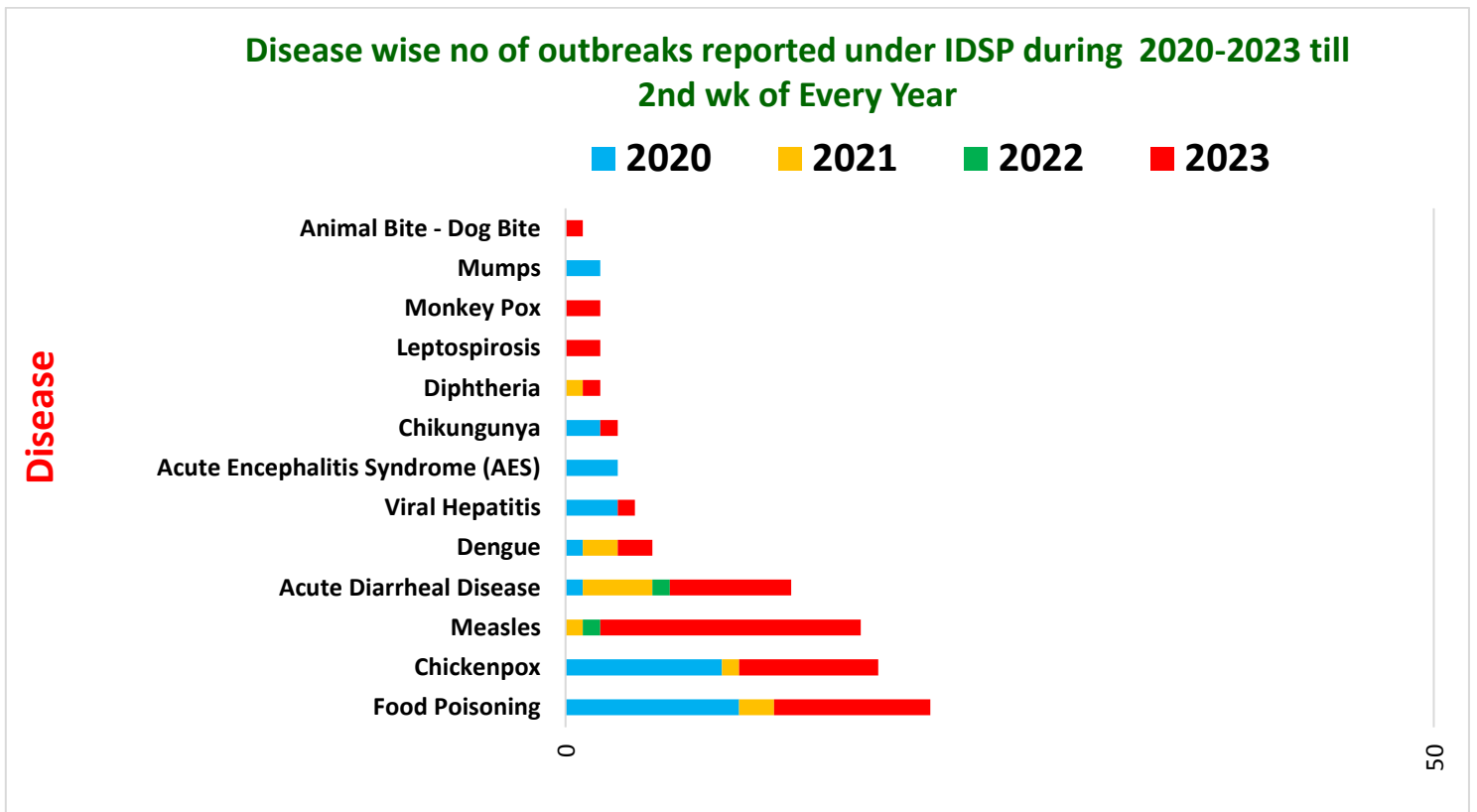
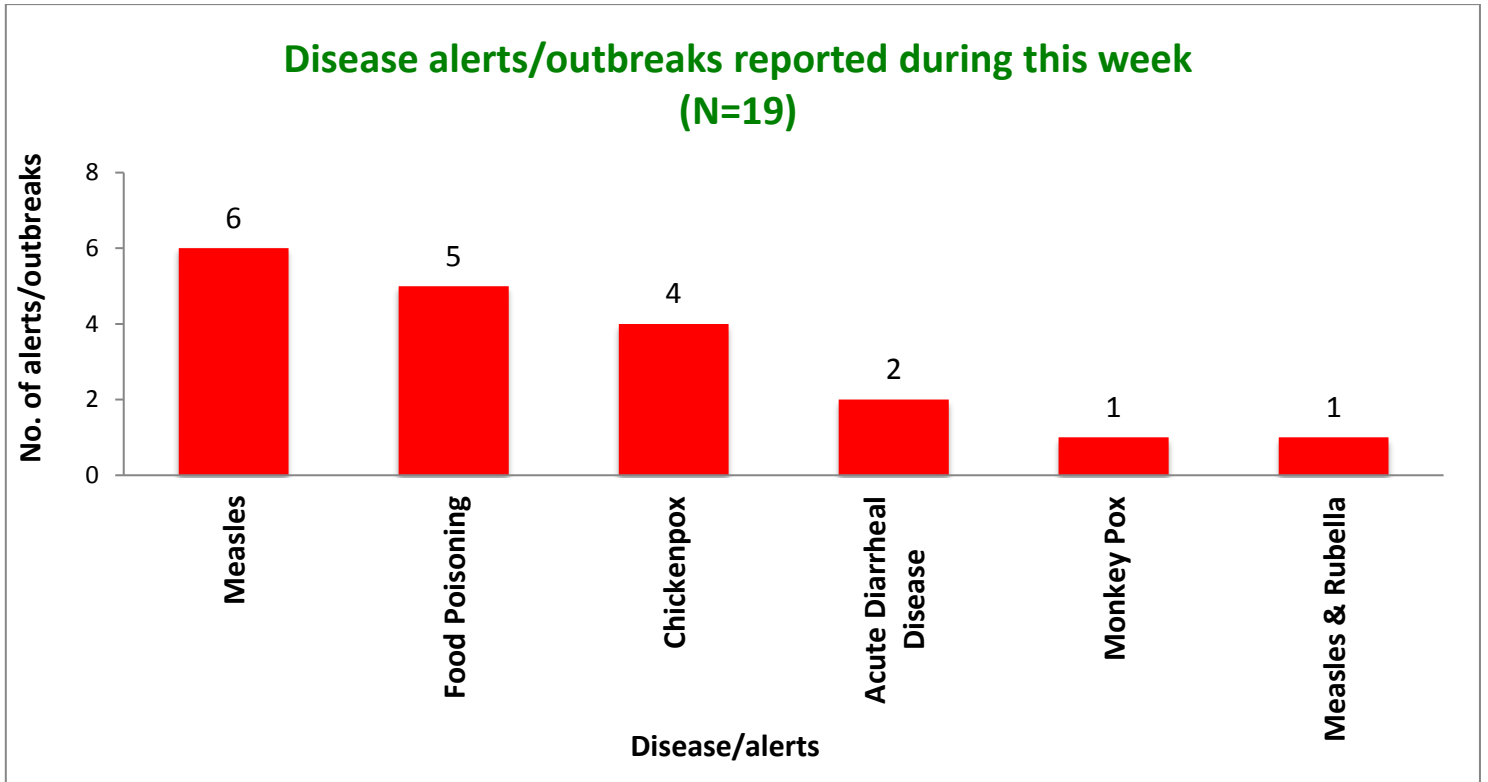

Cases presented with fever, loose stools and abdominal pain. Five rectal swabs, two water samples and two blood samples were sent for laboratory investigation. Out of five stools samples, two were found positive for E.coli. The two water samples were found unfit for drinking. District RRT investigated the outbreak. It was found that outbreak was due to unhygienic drinking water conditions. Pig rearing was seen in most of the households. Broiler chicken was reared and the residues from the broiler farm were seen scattered in places. The deceased case was a 50 years old male. Active surveillance for similar cases was done. Symptomatic treatment was given to all cases. ORS sachets and halogen tablets were distributed. Health education was given on the importance of safe drinking water.

Symptomatic treatment was given to all cases. ORS sachets and halogen tablets were distributed. Health education was given on the importance of safe drinking water.

Cause of outbreak was found to be consumption of food in a marriage ceremony. Health education was given on the importance of safe drinking water and to maintain food hygiene.

Cases presented with abdominal pain, loose stools and vomiting. Water samples were collected and sent for lab analysis. Colliforms were found and hence, water samples were found unfit for drinking. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Outbreak occurred after consumption of food in hostel canteen. Health education was given on the importance of safe drinking water and to maintain food hygiene in kitchen premises.

Cases presented with abdominal pain, loose stools and vomiting. Water samples were collected and sent for lab analysis. Result awaited. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Outbreak occurred after consumption of food in hostel canteen. Health education was given on the importance of safe drinking water and to maintain food hygiene in kitchen premises.

Cause of outbreak was due to consumption of food in a house warning ceremony. Health education was given on the importance of safe drinking water and to maintain food hygiene.

One lesion sample was collected and sent to NIV Pune and was found positive for Monkey pox by RT-PCR test. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.

Cases presented with fever with rashes and bodyache. Two blood samples were sent to NIV, Mumbai and both samples were found positive for Measles by IgM ELISA. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Active search of cases was done. Measles vaccination was carried out. Vitamin A doses were given. Health education was given on the importance of immunization.

Eight blood samples were sent to Haffkine Institute, Mumbai. Of these, two samples were found for Measles by IgM ELISA and two other samples were found positive for Rubella by IgM ELISA. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Active search of cases was done. Measles vaccination was carried out. Vitamin A doses were given. Health education was given on the importance of immunization.

Five blood samples were sent for lab analysis and all five were found positive for Measles by IgM ELISA. The cases were less than 10 years old and all were unvaccinated. District RRT investigated the outbreak and health education was given on the importance of immunization.

Cases presented with fever and rashes. Five blood samples were sent for lab analysis and of these, three samples were found positive for Measles by IgM ELISA. District RRT investigated the outbreak and health education was given on the importance of immunization.
