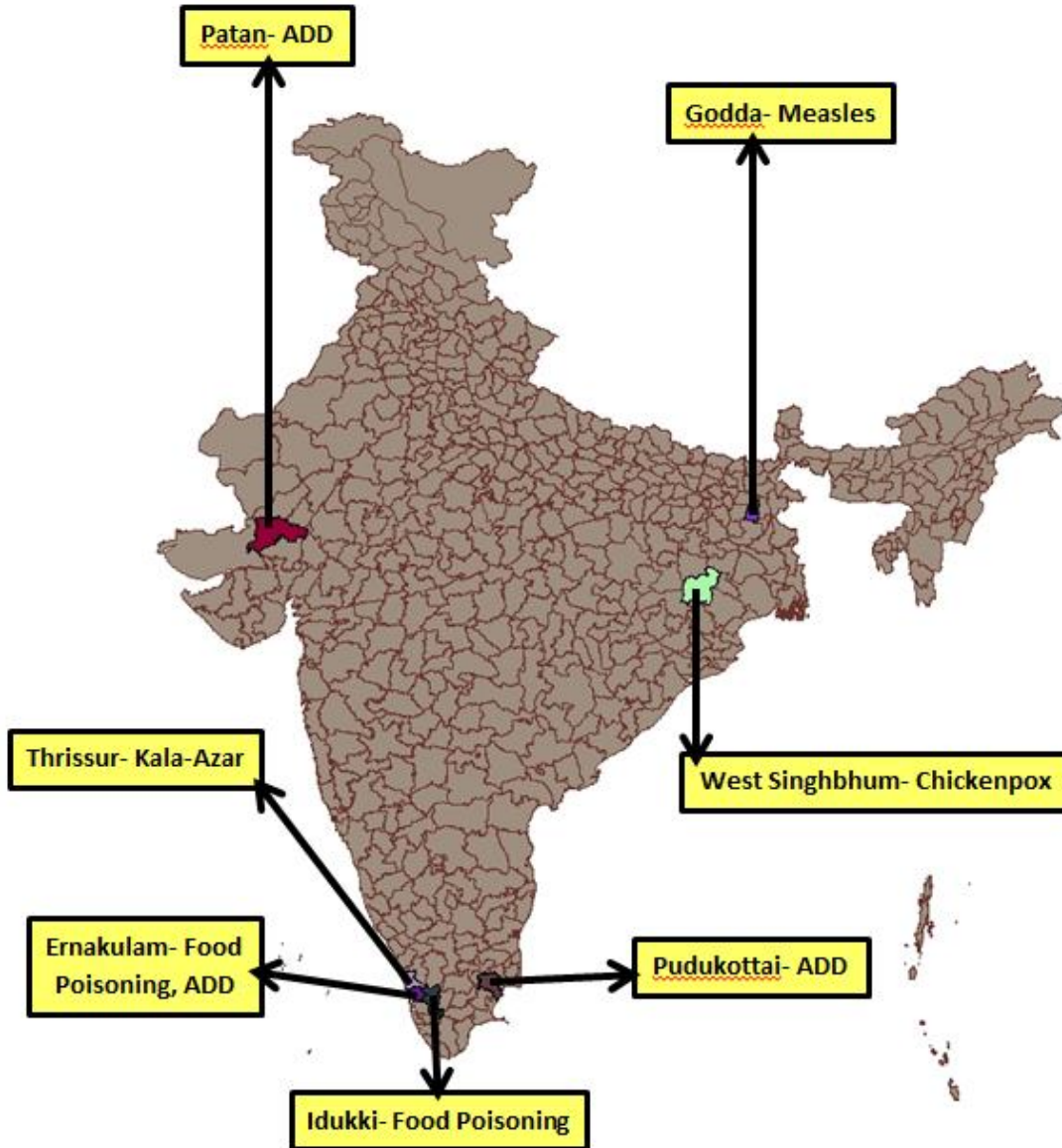
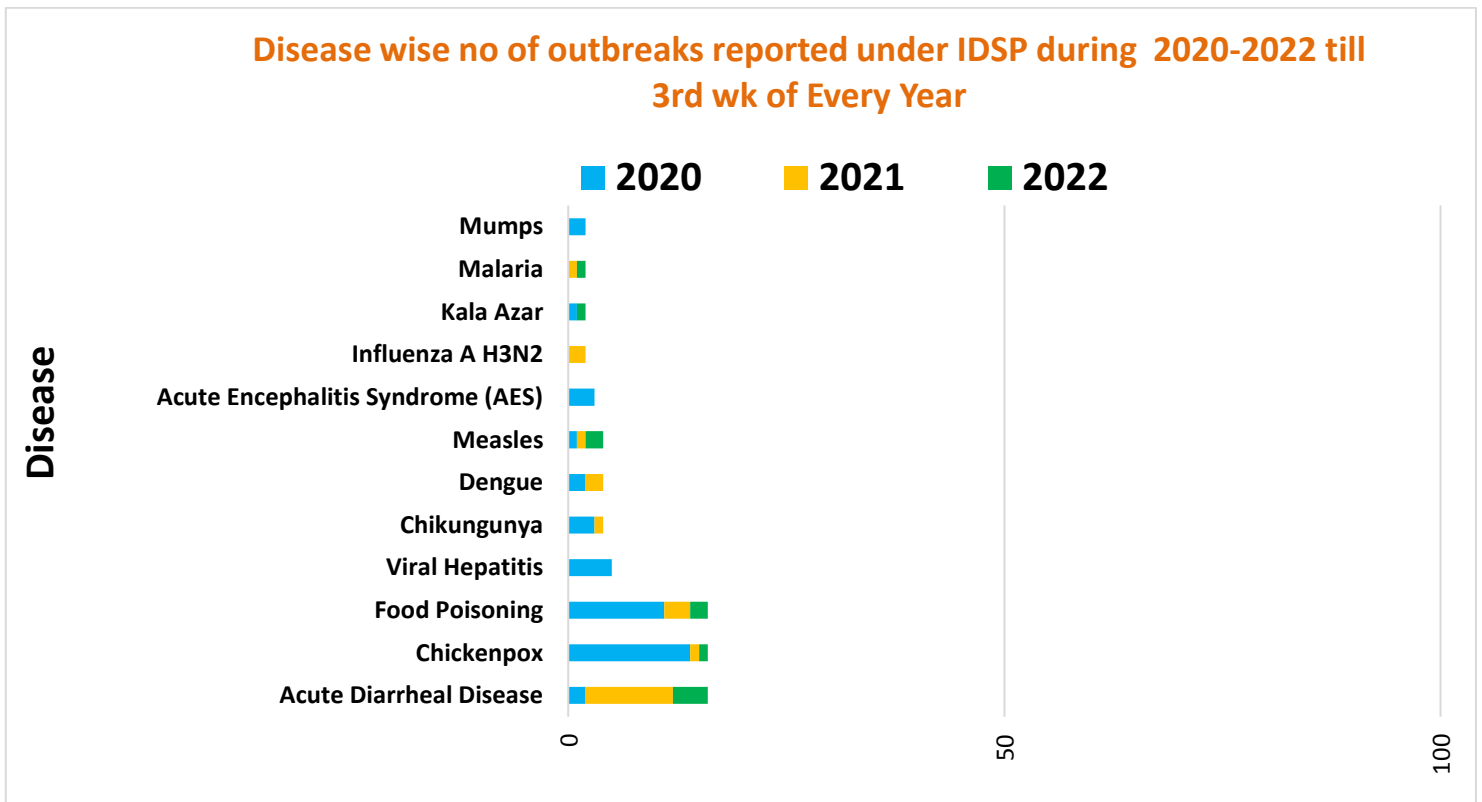
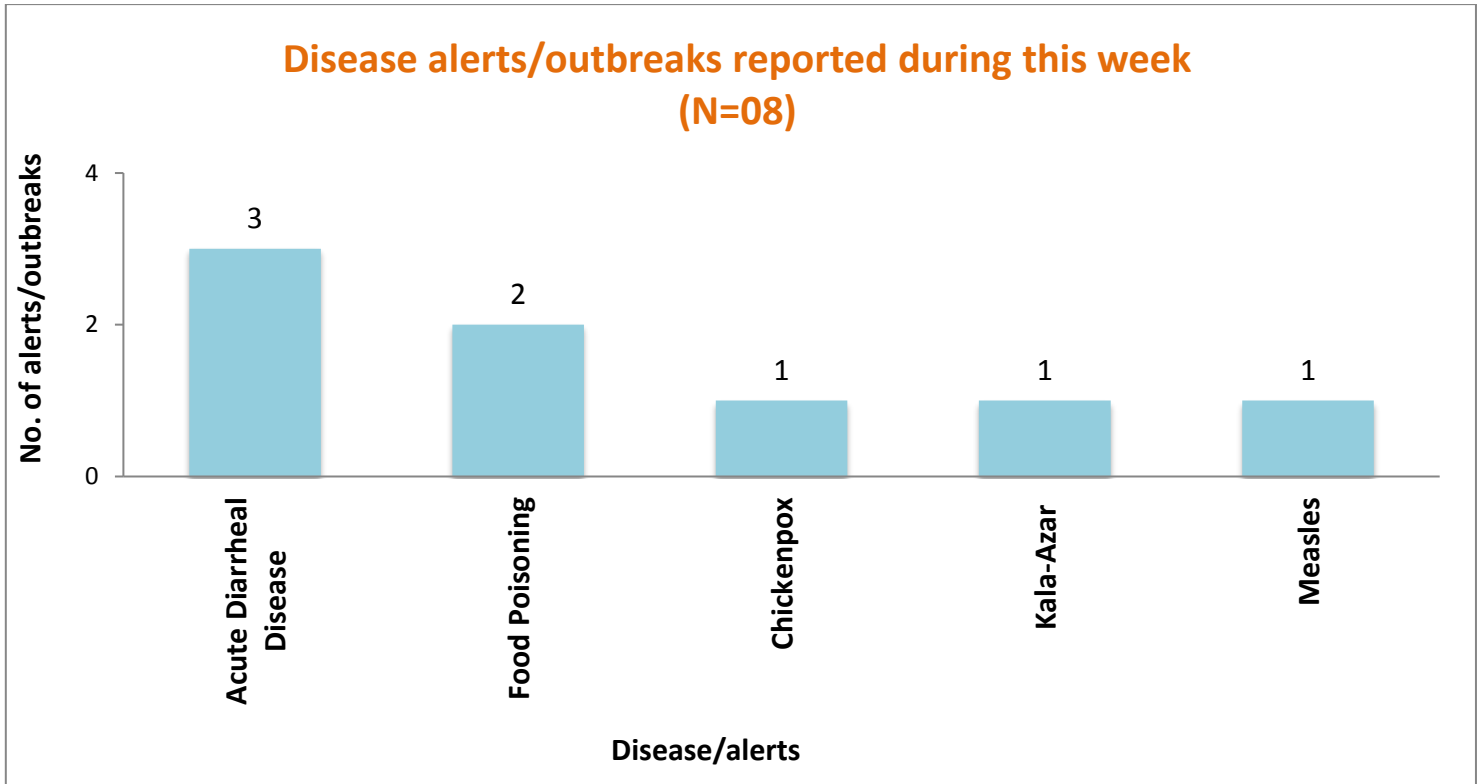

Four blood samples were collected and sent to DPHL Sadar Hospital, Chaibasa. Of these, three were found positive for Chicken pox by IgM ELISA. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.
JH/GDA/2022/03/006	Jharkhand	Godda	Measles	03	00	21-01-22	22-01-22	Under Surveillance	Cases reported from Village Nawadih, SC Panjradih, PHC/Block Thakurgangti, District Godda. Cases presented with fever, cough, coryza and maculopapular rashes over the face. They were not vaccinated. Two Blood and two nasopharyngeal samples were collected and sent to RIMS, Ranchi for ELISA IgM. Result awaited. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.
KL/IDK/2022/03/007	Kerala	Idukki	Food Poisoning	16	00	17-01-22	20-01-22	Under Control	Cases reported from DH Thodupuzha, Block Purapuzha, District Idukki. The cases presented with loose stools, vomiting, abdominal pain and headache. Three stool and three water samples collected and sent to Analytical lab, Kakkannadu. No enteropathogens were isolated. Water sample was found to be fit for drinking. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Cause of outbreak was due to intake of stale food. Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water.
KL/TRC/2022/03/008	Kerala	Thrissur	Kala-Azar	01	00	23-01-22	24-01-22	Under Surveillance	Case reported from SC Nattyanchira, PHC Thonnurkara, CHC Thiruvilwamala, District Thrissur. Case presented with weight loss, abdominal distension and pedal edema. Bone Marrow Biopsy shows Hypercellular marrow with Visceral Leishmaniasis done at GMCH, Thrissur. Bone Marrow aspirate also showed Visceral Leishmaniasis. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.

Cases presented with fever, bodyache, headache, loose stools and vomiting. Two stool samples were collected and sent to Govt. Medical College, Ernakulam and both the samples showed presence of Shigella Sonnei. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water.
<b>TN/PUD/2022/03/010</b>	<b>Tamil Nadu</b>	<b>Pudukottai</b>	<b>Acute Diarrheal Disease</b>	08	00	18-01-22	19-01-22	Under Control	Cases reported from Village Anna Nagar, PHC Kodumbalur, HSC Mathiripatti, Block Viralimalai, District Pudukottai. Two water and one stool sample was collected and sent to DPHL, Pudukottai. Of these, both water samples were found fit for drinking. Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water.

One stool sample was collected and culture test done at RPH Lab. Result found to be negative. Two water samples were collected and sent to RPH Lab. Result, found to be sterile. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Source of outbreak was found to be intake of contaminated water. Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water.
