





District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given. Vitamin A was given to the affected case.
JH/GDA/2022/04/014	Jharkhand	Godda	Measles	16	00	28-01-22	30-01-22	Under Surveillance	Cases reported from Village Danre-Harijantola and Yadavtola, PHC Danre, Block Poreyahat, District Godda. Cases presented with fever, cough and maculo popular rashes all over the body. Seven blood samples and three throat swab samples were sent to RIMS Ranchi for further investigation, the result is awaited. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given. Vitamin A was given to the affected cases.
JH/HAZ/2022/04/015	Jharkhand	Hazaribagh	Japanese Encephalitis	01	00	22-01-22	25-01-22	Under Control	Case reported from Village Birbir Bhuiya Tola, PHC/Block Sadar, HSC Oriya, District Hazaribagh. Three blood serum samples were sent to RIMS Ranchi for further lab investigation, out of which two samples were found to be positive for Japanese Encephalitis by IgM ELISA. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given. Fogging was done in the affected area.
JH/PAK/2022/04/016	Jharkhand	Pakur	Fever with Rash	06	00	22-01-22	25-01-22	Under Surveillance	Cases reported from Village Bara Kendua, CHC Maheshpur, HSC Devinagar, District Pakur. Blood sample was sent for further lab investigation, it was found to be negative for Measles by IgM ELISA. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.
