




9<sup>th</sup> Week Map






Health education was given on the importance of immunization.

Cases were treated with symptomatically. Both district and block RRT investigated the outbreak. The affected age group was years. They were advised to get isolated. Health education given on the importance of personal hygiene and sanitation.

Cases presented with loose stools and abdominal pain. Eleven stool samples were collected and sent to GMCH Manjeri and were found positive for Vibrio cholera on culture. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Symptomatic treatment was given to all affected cases. Health education was given on the importance of safe drinking water, food hygiene and sanitation.

They presented with fever and rashes all over the body. Two blood and vesicular fluid samples were collected and sent to NIV Allappey. Result awaited. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given on the importance of isolation and personal hygiene.

Cases presented with fever and cough. 14 blood samples were collected and sent to MCH Thrissur and District Serology lab. All were found negative. 11 blood samples were sent to NIV Alapuzha. Of these, eight samples were found positive for Adeno Virus and one positive for Influenza B by PCR. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.

Cases presented with fever, cold and cough. District RRT investigated the outbreak. After visiting School all students who had consumed cold drinking water were found to have symptoms. All students are stable now. Health education was given to practice isolation and COVID appropriate behavior.

The cases had symptoms of abdominal pain and loose stools. Both block and district RRT investigated the outbreak. The possible source of outbreak was due to consumption of contaminated food (Curds dish) in a feast. All were given symptomatic treatment. ORS sachets were distributed. Health education was given by block health team through community sensitization meetings on the importance of food hygiene, safe drinking water and sanitation.

They presented with fever with rashes and were clinically diagnosed. All were given symptomatic treatment. District RRT investigated the outbreak. The school classrooms were cleaned using Lysol and surrounding premises with bleaching powder. Cases were isolated. Vitamin A supplementation was done. Health education was given on the importance of personal hygiene.

District RRT investigated the outbreak. Cases were isolated. Vitamin A supplementation was done. Health education was given on the importance of personal hygiene.

They presented with fever and rashes. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Medical camp was organized in the affected village. Symptomatic treatment was given. The most affected age group was 0-10 years. Health education was imparted on the importance of personal hygiene and sanitation.
OR/RAY/2023/09/200	Odisha	Rayagada	Acute Diarrheal Disease	11	00	21-02-23	Under Control	Cases reported from Village Chakunda, SC Chakunda, GP Kadama, Nlovk, Godari, District Rayagada. The cases had symptoms of abdominal pain and loose stools. Four rectal swabs and two water samples were collected and tested at DPH, Rayagada. Of these rectal swabs, two were found positive for E.coli on culture and two water samples were found safe for drinking by H2S test. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given through community sensitization meeting on the importance of food hygiene, safe drinking water and sanitation.
