





District RRT investigated the outbreak, all the cases consumed food(brinjal curry with peanuts and sambaru) in the hostel 01 food & 4 water samples collected and sent to RIMS Srikakulam; results awaited. All the cases treated symptomatically. Health education given. |
| | | Vishakhapatnam | ii. Food Poisoning | 18 | 0 | 05/03/15 | 05/03/15 | Under Control | Cases of nausea, vomiting and diarrhea reported from ZP High School, PHC/Mandal K.D. Peta District Visakhapatnam. District RRT investigated the outbreak. All the cases consumed midday meal in school. All the cases treated symptomatically. Chlorination of water source done. Health education given. |
| 2. | Arunachal Pradesh | West Kameng | iii. Chickenpox | 8 | 0 | 02/03/15 | 06/03/15 | Under Surveillance | Cases of fever with rash reported from JNV School Block Nafra District West Kameng. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Majority of cases were in 8-14 year age group. All the cases treated symptomatically. Health education given. |
| 3. | Assam | Kokrajhar | iv. Measles? | 7 | 0 | 04/03/15 | 05/03/15 | Under Surveillance | Cases of fever with rash reported from Village Kachukata, near Million Bazar, SC Chautara, PHC Bhowraguri, BPHC Gossaigaon District Kokrajhar. Majority of cases were vaccinated. All the cases treated symptomatically. Health education given. |
| 4. | Goa | North Goa | v. Fever | 44 | 2 | 28/02/15 | 06/03/15 | Under Surveillance | Cases of fever with loose motion reported from Villages Pali, taluka Thane and Sattari, CHC Valpoi, District North Goa. District RRT investigated the outbreak. House to house survey done. All blood samples sent to DPL at Goa Medical College Bambolim; tested negative for Widal, Hepatitis A, dengue & chikungunya. Stool samples tested negative for any pathogen.all the blood smears examined were found to be negative for malaria. One female aged 55 years and one male aged 50 years died due to the condition. All water samples were found to be potable. All cases treated symptomatically. Health regarding personal protection and safe drinking water given. |

Health education regarding awareness of the disease in the form of group meetings. |

All cases treated Symptomatically. Health education given. |

Health education given |

District RRT investigated the outbreak.Majority of cases were in 5-10 years age group. All 05 samples tested at Institute of Serology Kolkata were found to be positive for Measles IgM ELISA. All cases treated symptomatically. |

District RRT investigated the outbreak All cases had history of consumption of food in a temple festival. 03 water samples sent to DPHL Trivandrum,, and food samples were collected by food safety department; result awaited. All cases were treated symptomatically. Health education given. |

Health education given. |

Chlorination done in all water sources. All cases treated symptomatically. Health education given. |
| 10. | Madhya Pradesh | Shivpuri | xiv. Measles? | 6 | 0 | 28/02/15 | 05/03/15 | Under Surveillance | Cases reported from Rajpura & Yadavpura Block Pohari District Shivpuri. District RRT investigated the outbreak. All cases treated symptomatically in the health camp and Vitamin A supplementation done. Health Education Provided. |

Food samples sent to DPHL Villupuram; result awaited. All the cases treated symptomatically. Health education given. |

All 08 water samples collected and sent to IPM Lab Wanaparthy were found to be potable. Alternate source of safe drinking water arranged. Medical camp organized in the area and all cases treated symptomatically. OHT cleaned and chlorination done. Health education given. |
