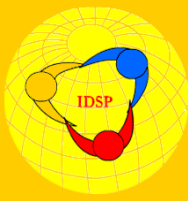

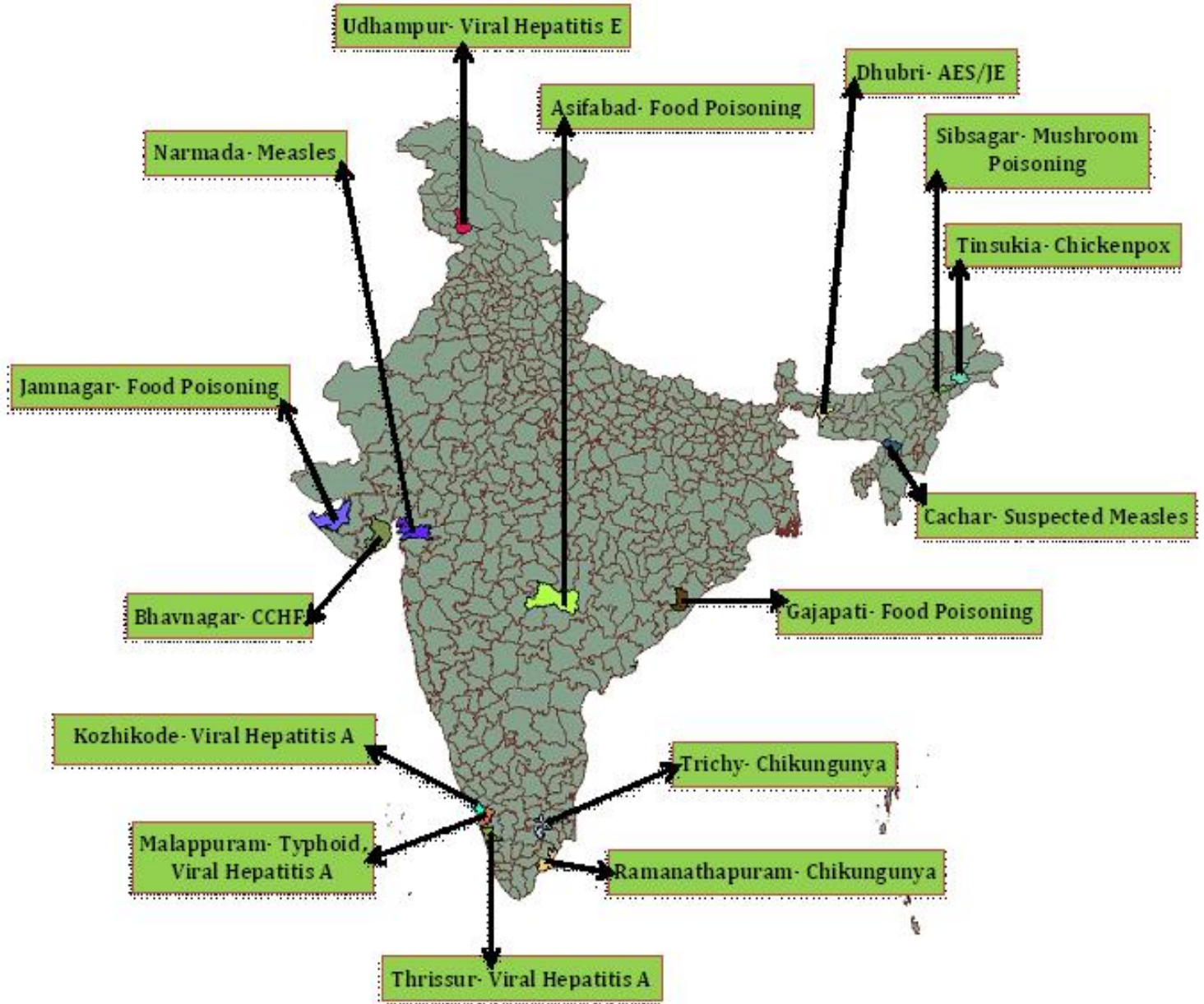

12th Week Map



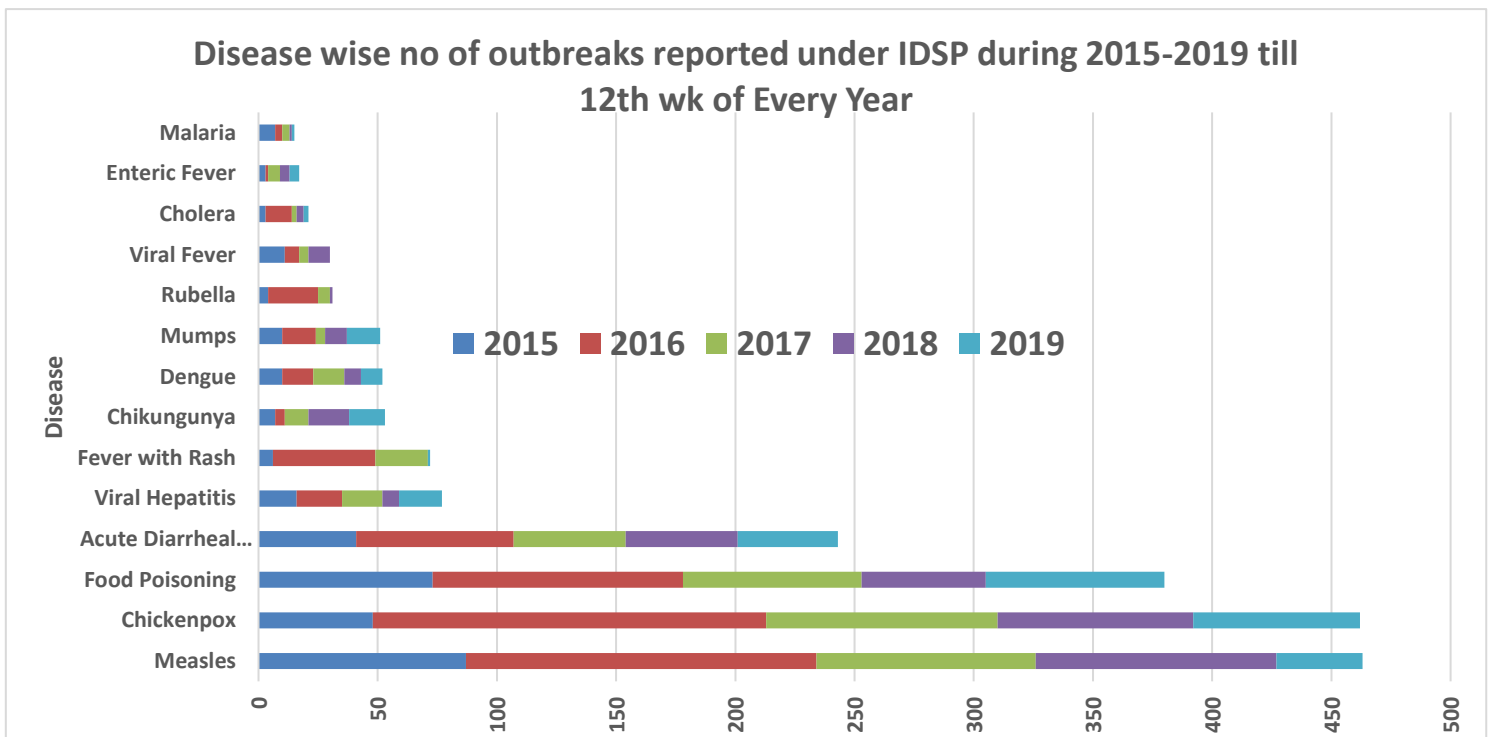
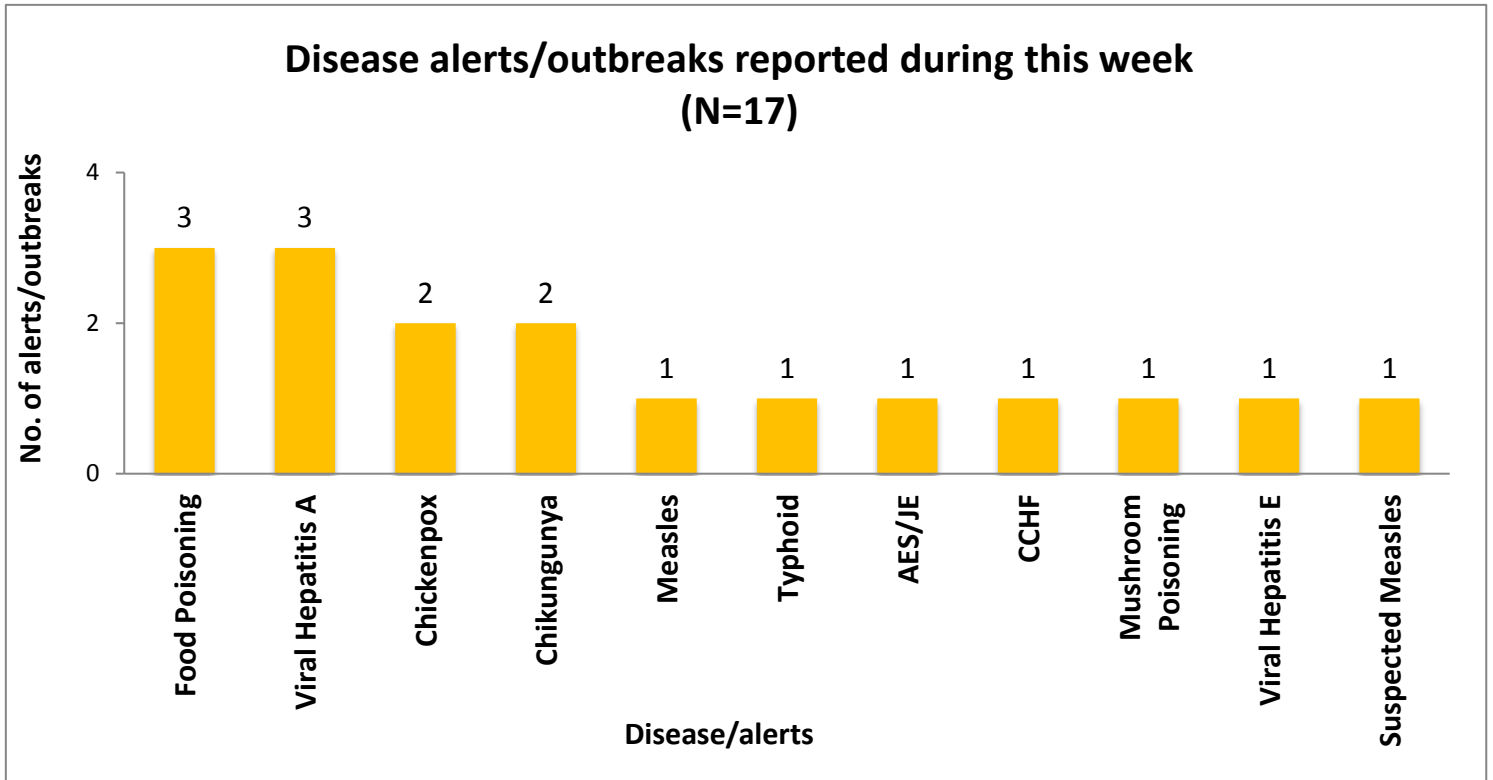

District RRT investigated the outbreak. House to house survey done. All cases belonged to one village and among them, two cases from one family. Blood Slide was collected and found negative for malaria by BPHC Medical team. Serum samples for measles was denied by the family members. Cases provided vitamin A and some necessary symptomatic treatments. Awareness done by health workers. Fever surveillance is going on.

The affected area is a slum with very poor sanitary conditions and water stagnation. Pigs were present in the vicinity of houses. 5 nos. of serum sample was collected and sent for testing at DPHL, Dhubri. Lab result is awaited. All cases treated symptomatically. Health education given.

District RRT investigated the outbreak. All the affected were from same family and gave history of consuming wild mushrooms. After consuming they developed vomiting and diarrhea. All cases were referred to higher center for treatment. Two females aged 37 years and 4 years expired due to illness.

All the cases belonged to 4 families and were located close to each other. Cases presented with fever, headache and vesicular eruption. Families were of low socio economic status. Health education given and isolation was advised. All the cases were treated.

House to house survey done. 2 water samples taken and sent to Jal Bhavan, Jamnagar, found safe for drinking; 4 food samples taken by F & D department, result awaited. IEC Done. All cases treated. Chorine tablets distributed to all households.

Health education given All cases treated symptomatically.

District RRT investigated the outbreak. House to house survey done. 10 blood samples and 04 Water samples from water supply sources including Natural spring water, sent to the Department of Microbiology Govt. Medical College Jammu for testing. All 10 blood samples found positive for Hep E by IgM ELISA and all water samples found unfit for consumption. All cases treated symptomatically. Source reduction activities undertaken. Health education given.

Health service center comprising of health supervisors and health workers (M/F) & MHT staff have been set up in the affected area for 7 day. RDK and Slide Collection for 21 students and MAT for 10 students done.

All cases treated.

District RRT investigated the outbreak. House to house survey done. 4 serum samples sent to DPHL Ramanathapuram and all found positive for Chikungunya by IgM ELISA. People advised to tightly cover water containers to prevent mosquito breeding.

District RRT investigated the outbreak. Water samples collected and sent to District Hospital, Asifabad. Report awaited. Health education given on personal hygiene and demonstration on hand washing methods. Chlorinated drinking water tank of the school and intimate the school staff to maintain safety measures at kitchen while preparing the food. Health camp organized in the school and all cases treated symptomatically.

MC RRT & DRRT visited affected area. All houses in the area were sprayed with insecticide and 133 animals were treated with insecticide spraying and treatment. Patient had history of tick bite 22 days prior to onset of illness and was also suffering from lung and kidney disease. He was farmer and had exposure to cattle and other animals.

Group talk conducted.

Cases had history of consuming food in a marriage. 27 Lab samples collected and found positive by Widal test. 1 blood sample tested positive for Typhoid by culture and tested at MCH Manjeri. Mass chlorination conducted in the affected areas. 134 wells chlorinated. 1312 chlorine tablets distributed. Group talks and Health education class conducted. IEC materials supplied. All cases treated symptomatically.

Two water samples were taken for laboratory test and both found unfit. All cases had history of consumption of food and drinks in two marriage function held close to each other. Chlorination done. Chlorine tablets distributed. Health education given.

District RRT investigated the outbreak. Cases occurred amongst school students having a common source of drinking water. 25 blood samples were tested for raised liver enzymes and all samples had raised levels. 3 blood samples were positive for Anti HAV antibody by IgM ELISA. Super chlorination done.
TN/TPL/2019/12/0309	Tamil Nadu	Trichy	Chikungunya	23	00	12-03-19	Under Surveillance	Cases reported from Village CKVI, HSC Ward 5, PHC T.V.Koil UPHC, Block Corporation. District RRT investigated the outbreak. House to house survey done. 8 serum samples sent to DPHL Trichy and 7 found Chikungunya positive. Indoor mosquito breeding found in refrigerators. Mass cleaning done. All cases treated symptomatically. Health education given.
