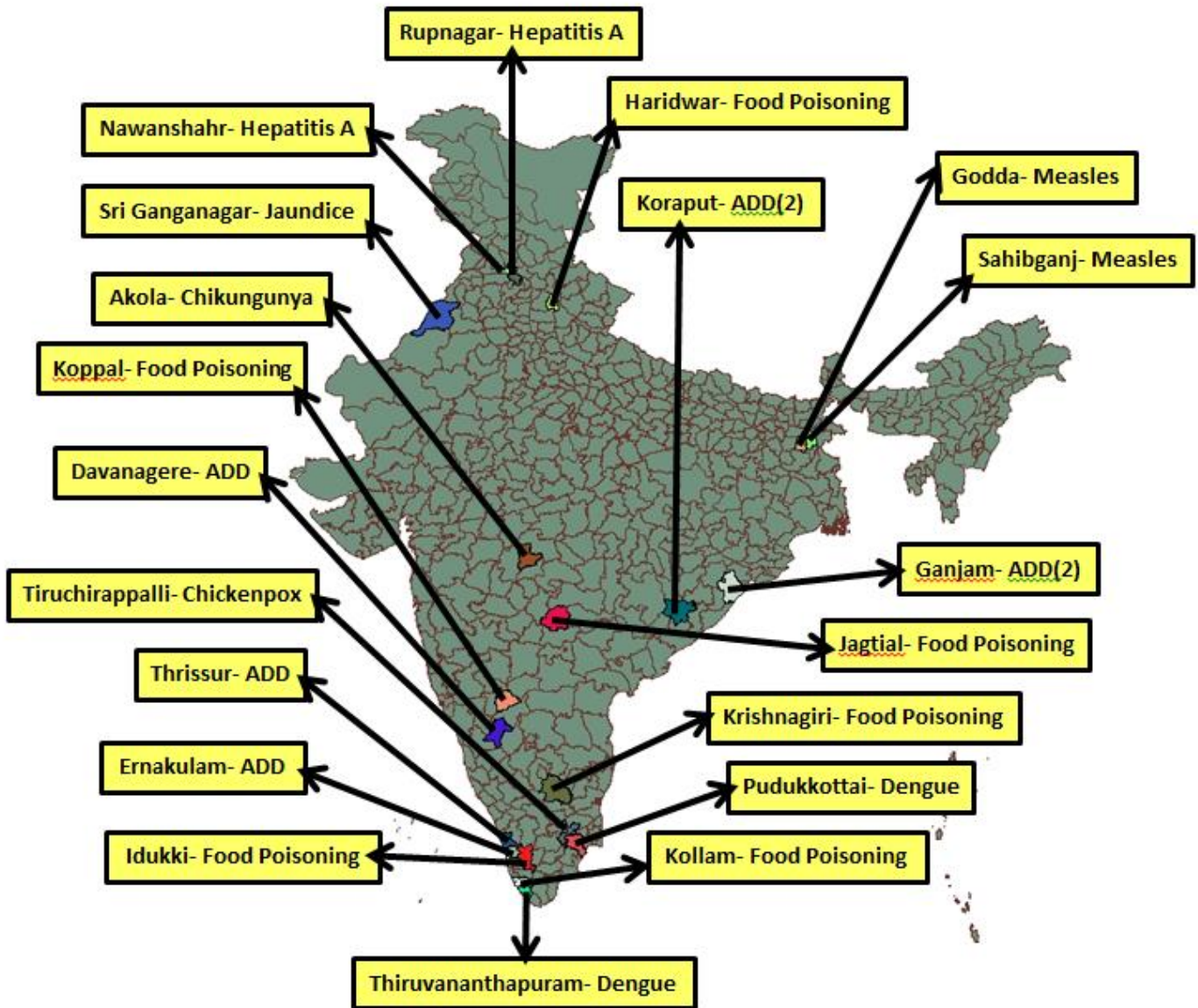

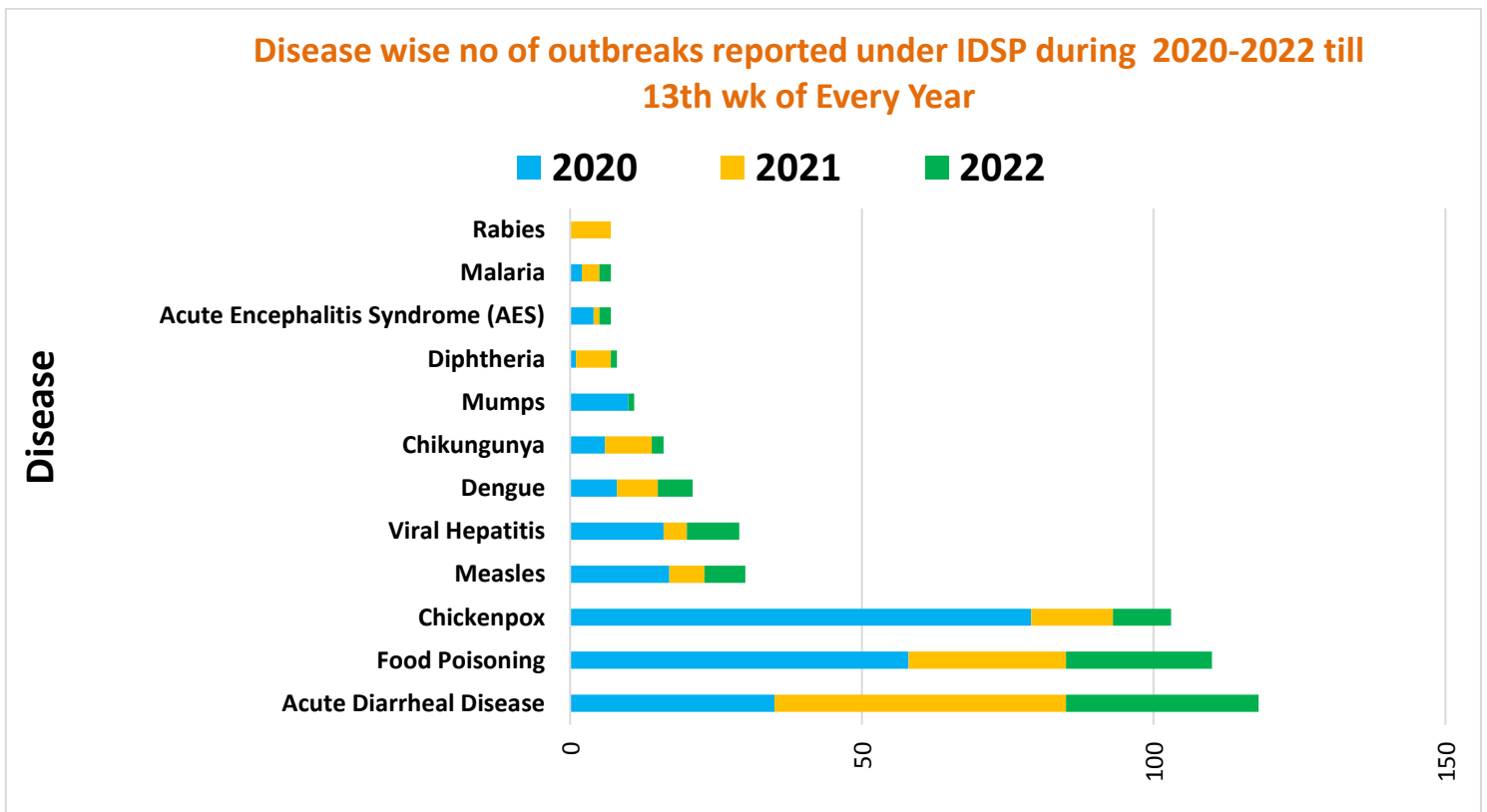
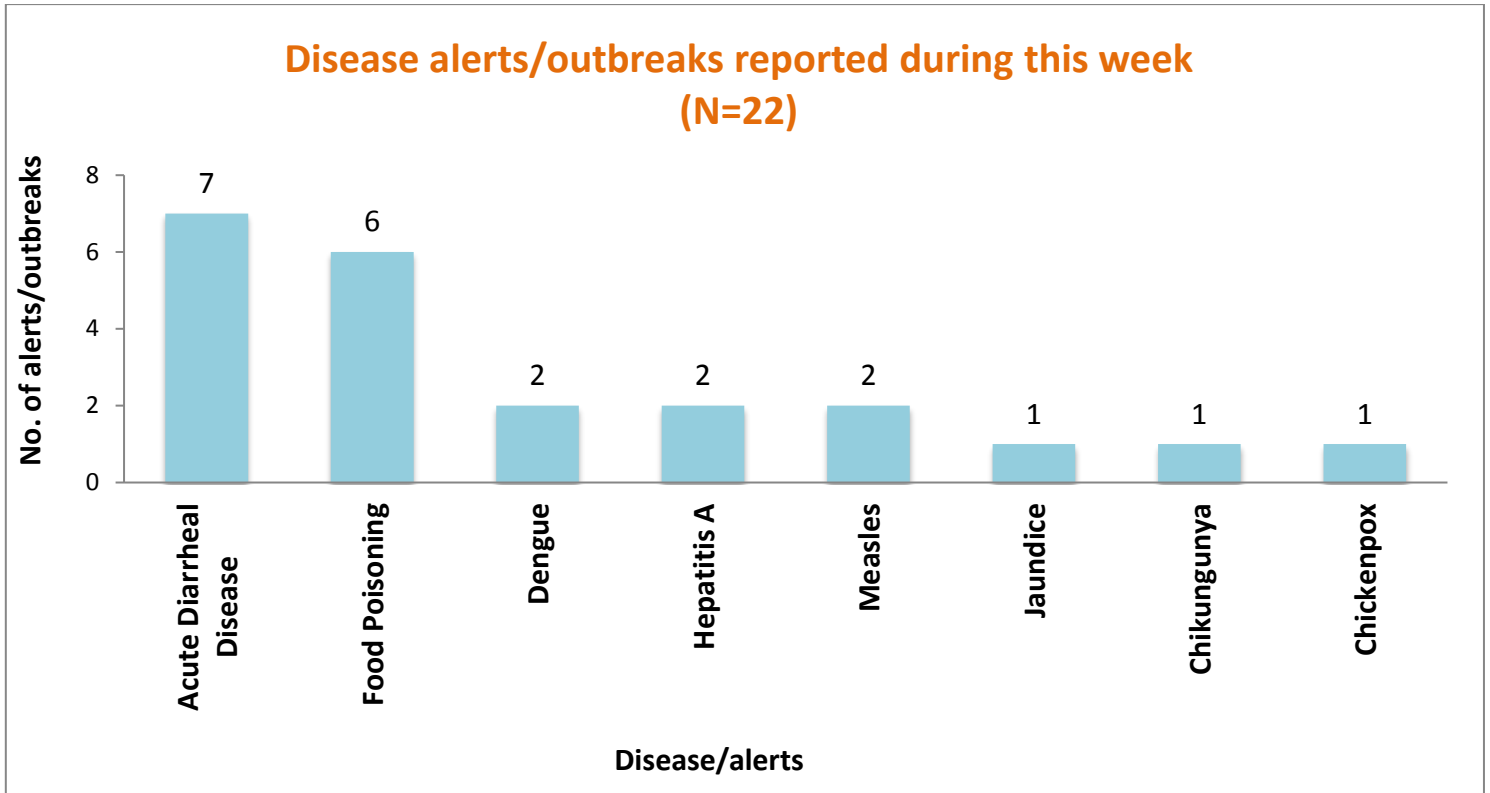

Cases presented with fever and rashes. 22 blood samples were collected and sent to the Institute of Serology, Kolkata, and 18 were found positive for Measles by IgM ELISA. Out of 63 positive cases, four were MR vaccinated. District RRT investigated the outbreak. House to house survey was done. Vitamin A was given and cases were treated symptomatically. Health education was given regarding the importance of immunization.

One sample was found to be positive for Measles. District RRT investigated the outbreak Vitamin A solutions and symptomatic treatment was given. Health education was given regarding the importance of immunization.

Cases presented with abdominal pain, loose stools and vomiting. Three water samples were collected from the KWA pipe and sent to Regional Public Health Laboratory, Ernakulam for bacteriological analysis. All samples were found to be sterile. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Super chlorination was done in the pump house. ORS sachets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of hand washing and safe drinking water.

Water sample was also sent for analysis at the Microbiology lab and the result is awaited. District RRT investigated the outbreak and symptomatic treatment was given. Health education on the safe drinking water and on the importance of hand hygiene was delivered

Food samples were collected by the Food Safety Department and sent to Analytical lab, Trivandrum. Result awaited. District RRT investigated the outbreak and visited nearby houses and stalls, chlorinated all the water sources, and distributed ORS sachets. Health education was given regarding the importance of safe drinking water.

Out of these, three NS1 antigen and one IgM ELISA tested positive for dengue from KIMS hospital and two NS1 antigen tested positive from GG hospital. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Fever survey was done. Anti-larval spray and fogging was done. Health education was given regarding the importance of vector control measures.

Health education was given regarding the importance of safe drinking water and sanitation.

Health education was given on the importance of safe drinking water.

It was found that one sample tested positive for Dengue IgM and two for Dengue Ns1. Also, two water samples were sent to Water Analysis lab, Trichy, and they were found to be potable. District RRT investigated the outbreak and a medical camp was set up. Vector control activities such as fogging and cleaning of overhead tanks were carried out. Health education regarding the importance of vector control measures was given.

District RRT investigated the outbreak and conducted a Medical camp the cases were given symptomatic treatment and Health education on hand hygiene and sanitation was imparted.
