


One 07 year old male child died due to the condition. All cases were isolated and given Vitamin A supplementation. Health education given.

The patient was treated symptomatically and blood sample was sent to NIV Pune, which was found to be positive for CCHF virus. Patient died on 26/03/2015. There was a cattle shed near the residence of the deceased. House to house search for Fever cases done. 05 fever cases identified by the RRT and 35 blood samples were collected for testing; result awaited .Anti tick activities started with the taluka animal husbandry department.
