

15th Week Map






Cases presented with fever, maculopapular rashes and body pain. Four blood samples were collected and sent to RIMS, Ranchi. Of these, one sample was found positive for Measles by IgM ELISA. District RRT investigated the outbreak. The vaccination status of the case is unknown. Health education was given regarding importance of vaccination.

Cases presented with abdominal pain, vomiting and loose stools. Two stool and four water samples were sent to DPHL. Result awaited. Cases had apparently consumed temple offerings which were prepared by using tab water. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water and properly cooked food.

Cases presented with loose stools and vomiting. Three rectal swabs and two water samples were collected and sent to District Public Health Laboratory and to MKCH MCH, Berhampur. None of the rectal swabs showed presence of any pathogenic organism. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water.

Cases presented with loose stools and vomiting. Seven water samples were collected and sent to District Public Health Laboratory. Water sample was found to be unfit for drinking. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water.

Cases presented with abdominal pain, loose stools and vomiting. District RRT investigated the outbreak. 05 food samples were collected and sent to King Institute Guindy, Chennai. All the food samples were found to be negative for E.coli, Staphylococcus aureus, bacillus cereus and Salmonella. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Cases had apparently consumed food and water in a company where they were working. Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water and properly cooked food.

Ariyur, District Kallakurichi. Cases presented with abdominal pain, loose stools and vomiting. Three water and three stool samples were collected and sent to DPHL Kallakurichi. The water was found not fit for drinking. No pathogenic organism was isolated from stool samples. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water.

Cases presented with fever and rashes. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given regarding personal hygiene and proper sanitation measures.

Cases presented with abdominal pain, loose stools and vomiting. Three stool and two water samples were collected and sent to MMCH and to PHE respectively. The water sample was found fit for drinking. Result of stool sample is awaited. District RRT investigated the outbreak. They concluded the probable source of infection to be an old water tank which was used for drinking water purpose and also used dirty pond water for washing and bathing purposes. Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water.

Cases presented with abdominal pain, loose stools and vomiting. Seven stool samples were collected and sent to SSKM and three food samples were sent to Public Health Laboratory. Result awaited. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Cases had apparently gathered for a religious ceremony where they had consumed food. Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water and properly cooked food.

District RRT investigated the outbreak. Anti-larval spray was used and fogging done. Health education was given regarding importance of vector control measures.
