




16th Week Map






Stool samples and drinking water samples were sent for lab analysis. 2 stool samples were found to be positive separately for Vibrio cholera (Ogawa) and E.coli. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given regarding the importance of hygiene and intake of safe drinking water.
