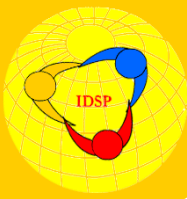

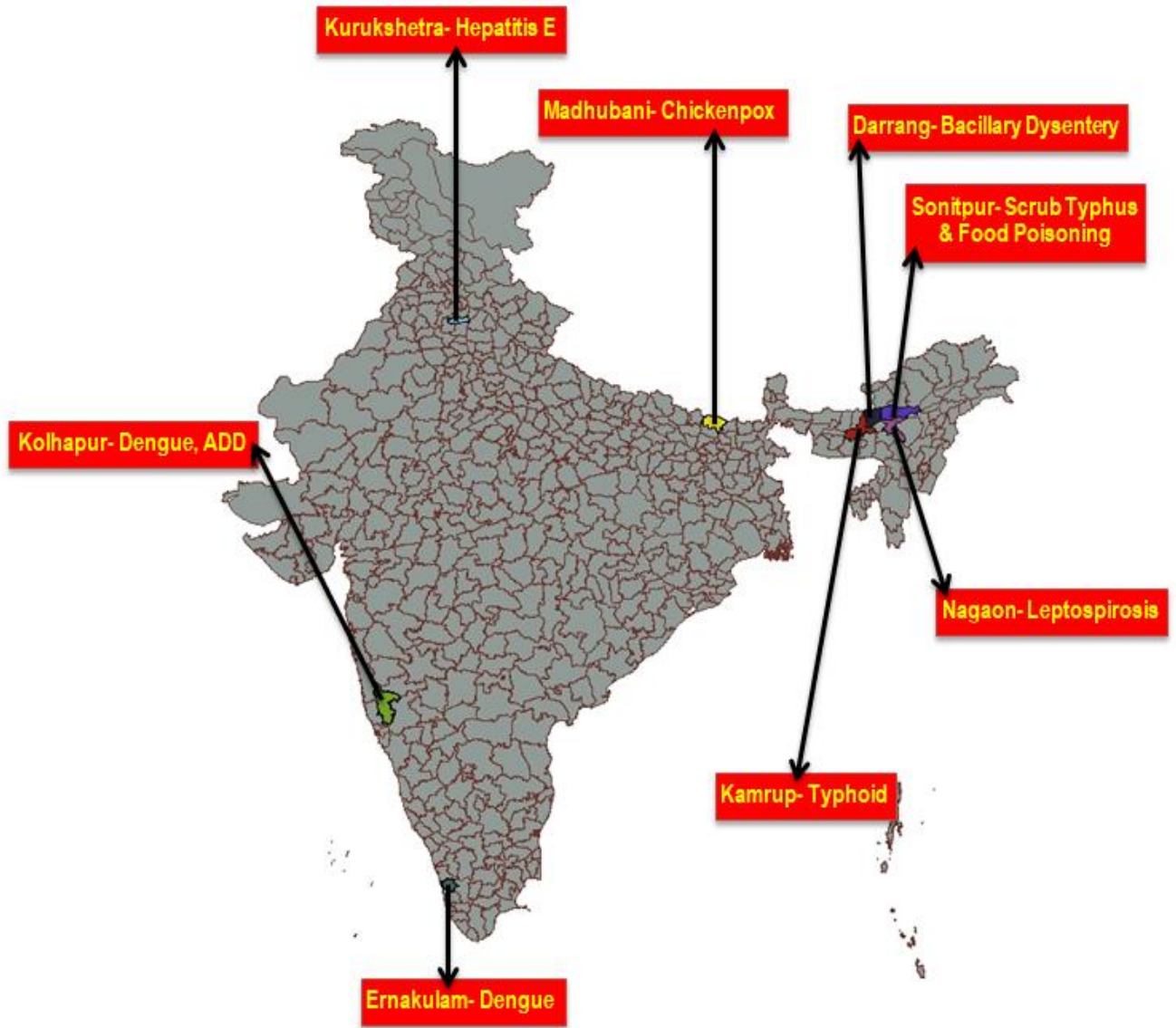

17th Week Map

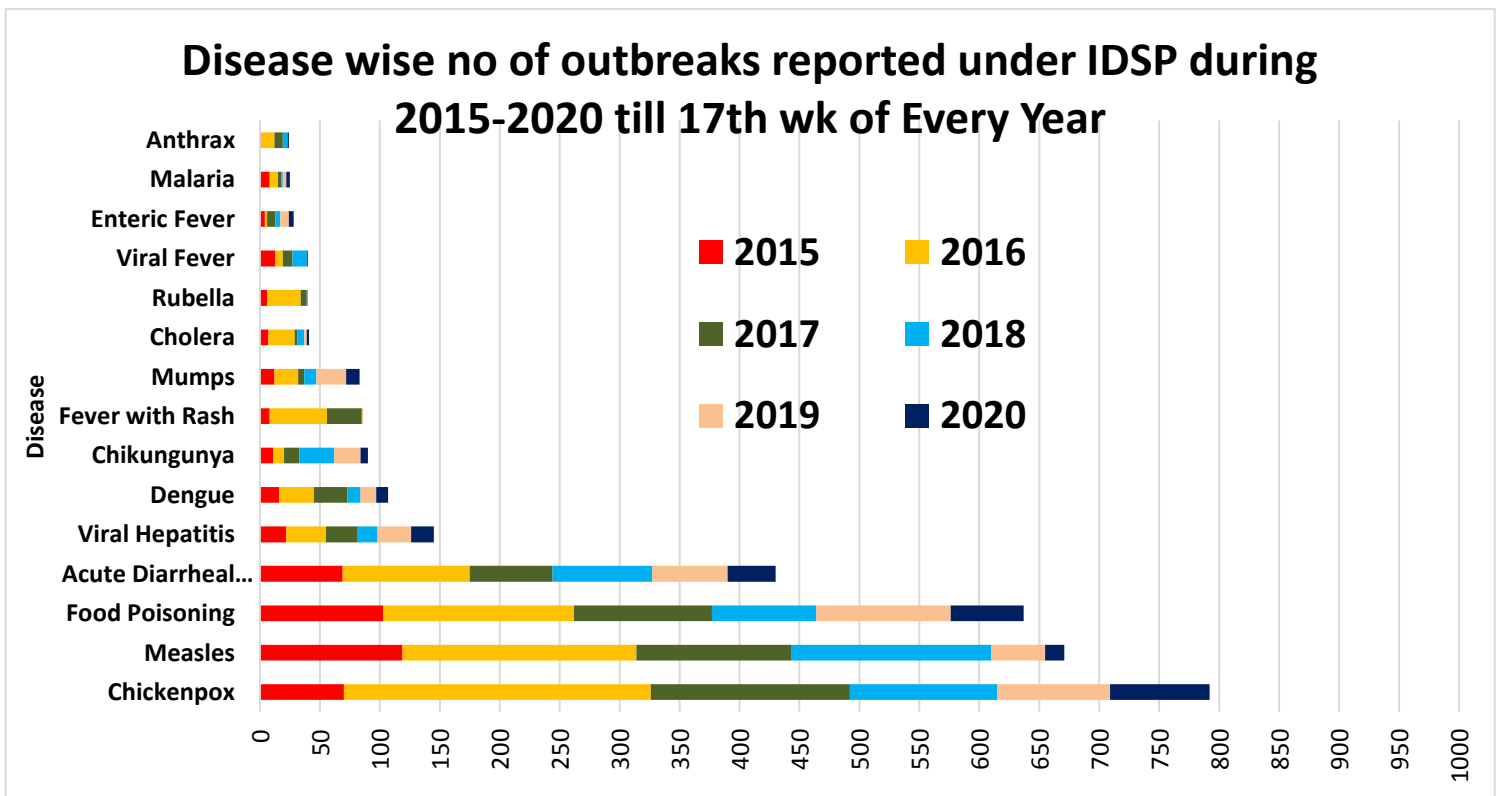
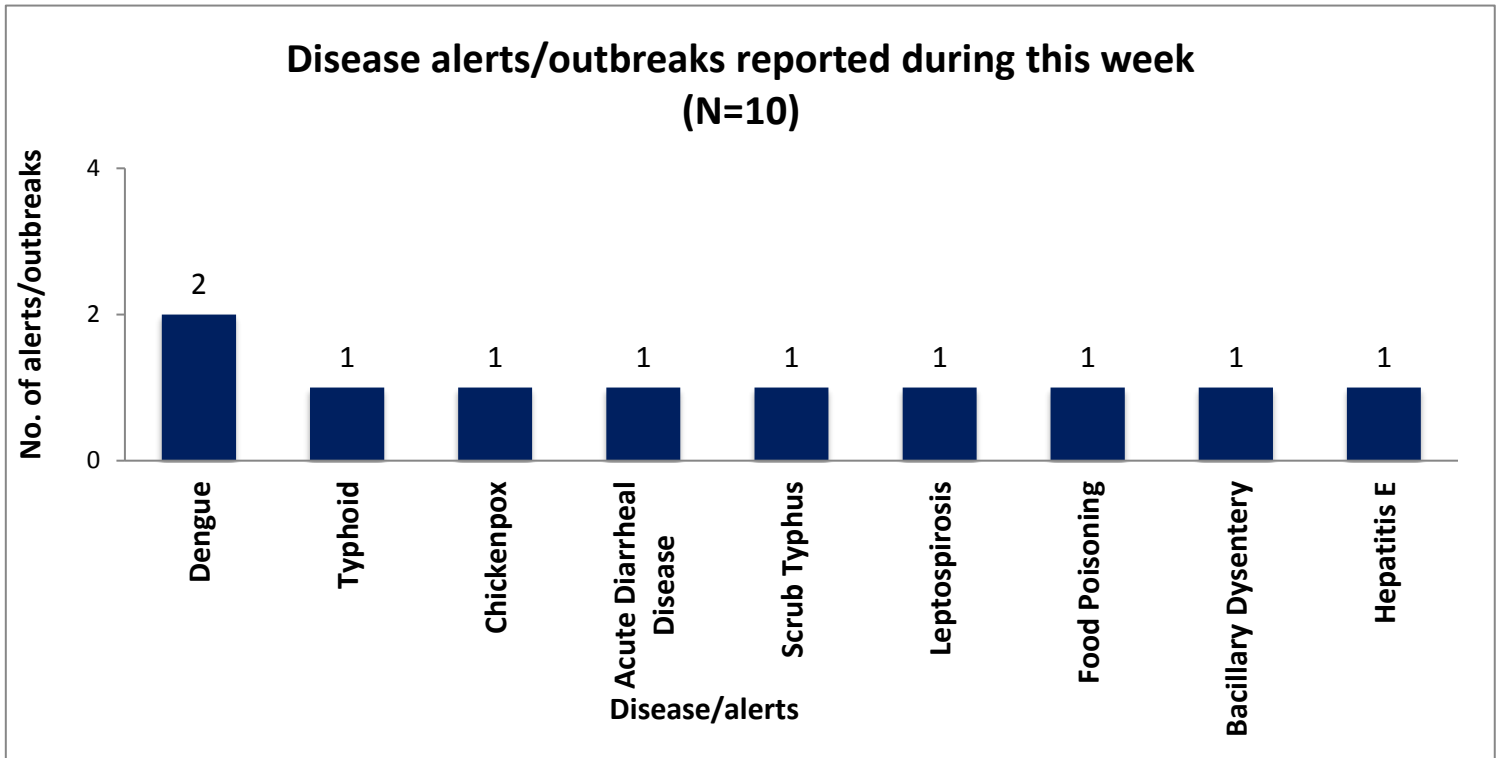

A total of 08 water samples collected and sent to Microbiology department GMCH, and found unsatisfactory. All cases treated. Health education given.

District RRT investigated the outbreak. House to house survey conducted. The deceased was a 60y/M who was suffering from kidney disease, presented with fever and headache. A total of 02 serum sample collected and sent to Guwahati Medical College and Hospital (GMCH), Guwahati and both were found positive for Leptospirosis by IgM ELISA. Health education given on personal hygiene.

Active case search conducted. Cases presented with fever with vesicular rash. Cases were between 1 and 40 years of age. All cases treated. Vitamin A given to susceptible cases. Health education given.

House to house survey conducted. Cases presented with yellowish discoloration of eyes and urine, and weakness. A total of 13 blood samples were collected and tested at Bacteriology Lab, Karnal and 08 were found to be positive for Hepatitis E by IgM ELISA. A total of 281 OT samples collected and 374 were found fit and 07 were found unfit. A total of 16 BT samples were collected and all were found fit. All cases treated. Health education given.

A total of 04 samples collected and sent to SSH, CPRK, Kolhapur were found to be positive for Dengue by IgM ELISA. All cases treated. Source reduction activities undertaken. Fogging done. Health education given.

District RRT investigated the outbreak. House to house survey conducted. Cases presented with loose stools, vomiting and pain abdomen. Irregular and improper purification of water was observed. Pipeline leakages seen in the affected area. A total of 07 stool samples collected and 24 water samples collected and sent to Microbiology DPHL Lab. Of the 24 samples 01 was potable and 23 were nonpotable. Stool samples no organisms grown. All cases treated. Water chlorination done. Health education given.

State and District NVBDCP officials were informed. House to house survey conducted. Breeding of Aedes seen in water collection containers. Most cases were in the age group 30 to 45 years. Cases presented with fever, myalgia and headache. A total of 02 blood samples collected and sent to RPH Lab Ernakulam and were found to be negative. All cases treated. Source reduction activities undertaken. Fogging done. Health education given.
