




District RRT investigated the outbreak. House to house fever survey done and a total of 9 positive malaria cases were identified. A total of 10054 blood slides have been examined since Jan 2019 out of which only 9 have turned positive. 7 were positive for P Falciparum and 1 each for P Vivax and mixed infection. All cases have been provided with antimalarial treatment. VBD camps were organized in the area. A total of 5200 ITBN were provided to the people. |

The suspected cause of the outbreak was lack of proper hygiene in food handling. Hygiene & sanitation related awareness given. All cases treated symptomatically. Health education given. |
