


Health education given.

Viral Hepatitis A &E	85	0	26/12/13	27/12/13	Under surveillance	Outbreak of jaundice reported from urban area of ward no. 6 (Koibarta Para, Ghosh Para lane) in Howrah Municipal Corporation, District Howrah. Medical team investigated the outbreak. House to house survey done. Poor drainage system and poor sanitary conditions were observed in the locality. All cases treated locally. Out of 27 serum samples collected, 9 samples were positive for Hepatitis A, 13 samples for Hepatitis E and 3 samples were positive for Hepatitis E & A (IgM ELISA) Chlorination of water sources done in the affected area. Halogen tablets distributed in the community. IEC done regarding safe drinking water, hygiene and sanitation.
