






Cases had history of consumption of food consisting of fish, chicken and liquor after which they developed Diarrhea and admitted at NRI General Hospital. 3 stool samples collected at NRI Hospital and tested Negative. 2 water samples collected and sent to regional lab for biological & chemical analysis and found negative. One stool sample sent to Guntur Medical college, result awaited. All cases treated symptomatically. Health education given. Protection from heat wave also advised and a big tent with jumbo air coolers also installed at shelter for these workers. A 26 year old female and 70 year male died of illness.

All cases treated symptomatically. Health education given.
