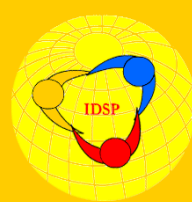

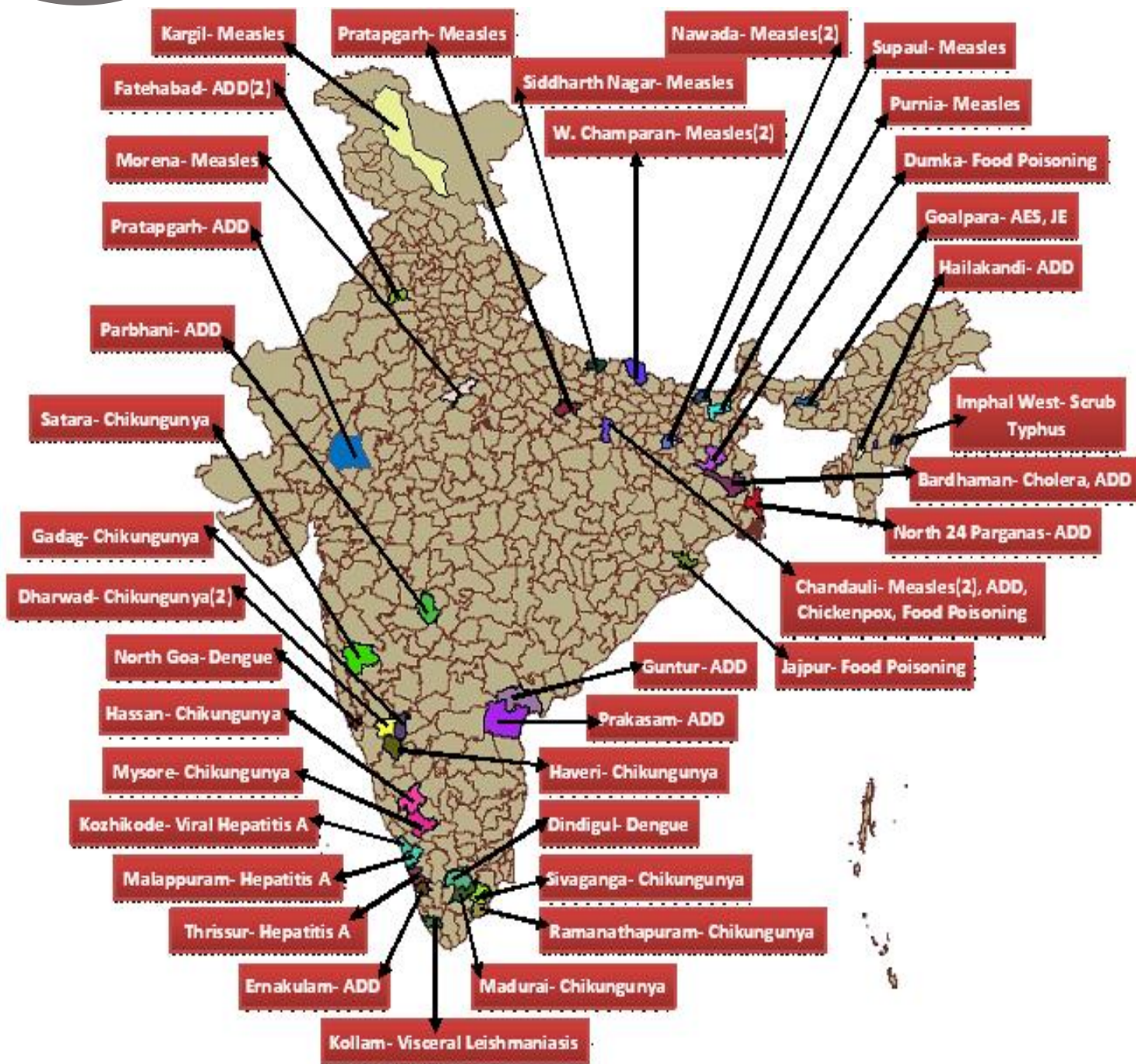

23rd Week Map



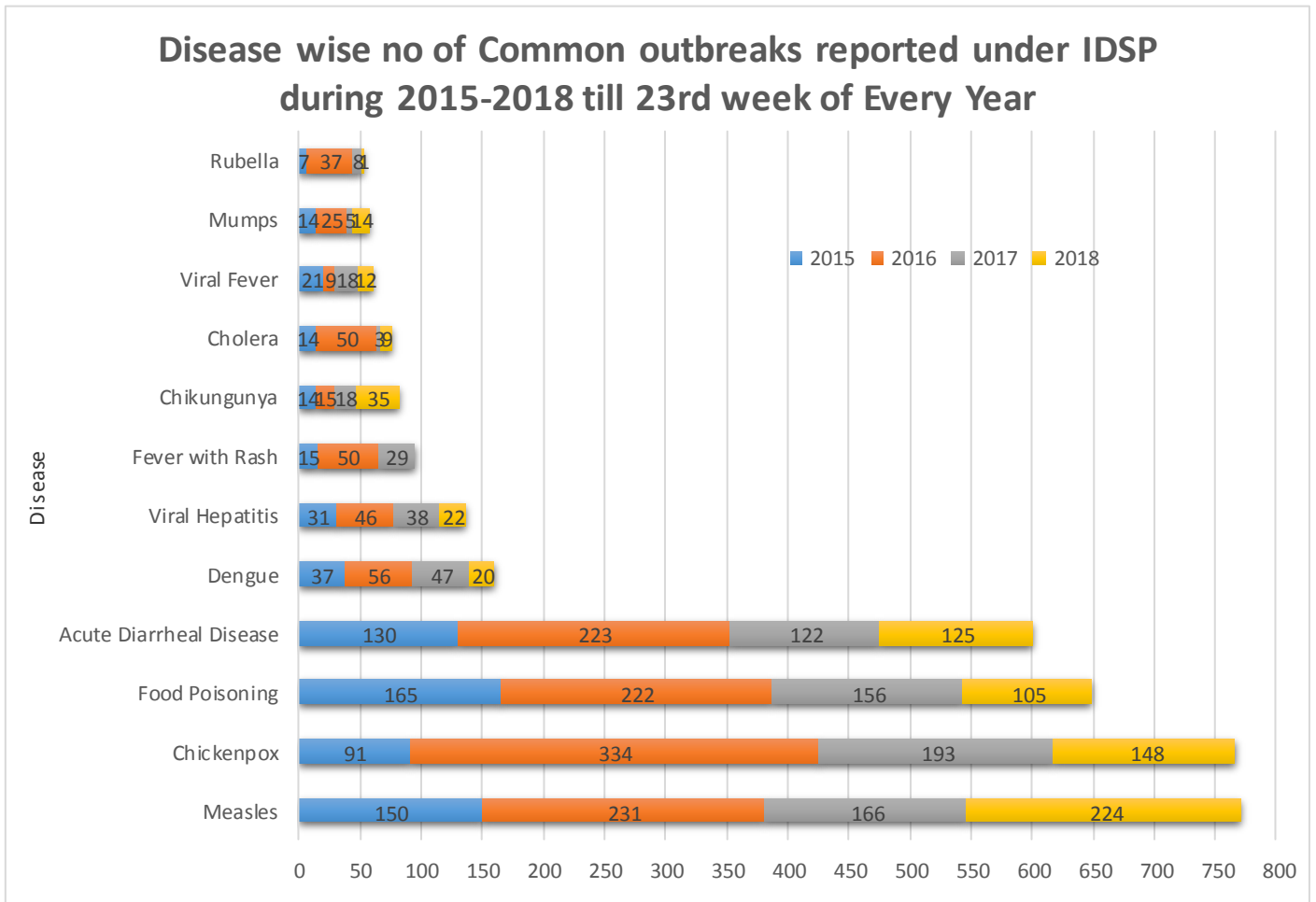
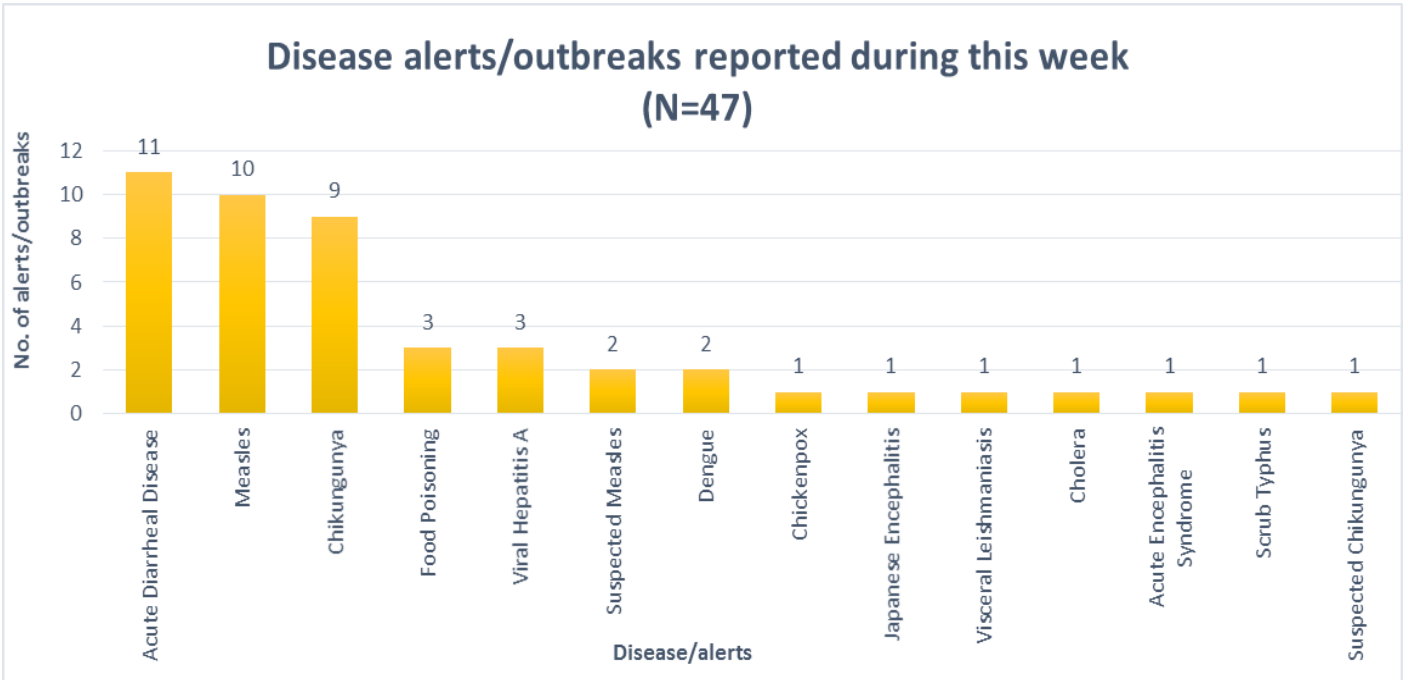
