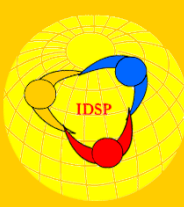

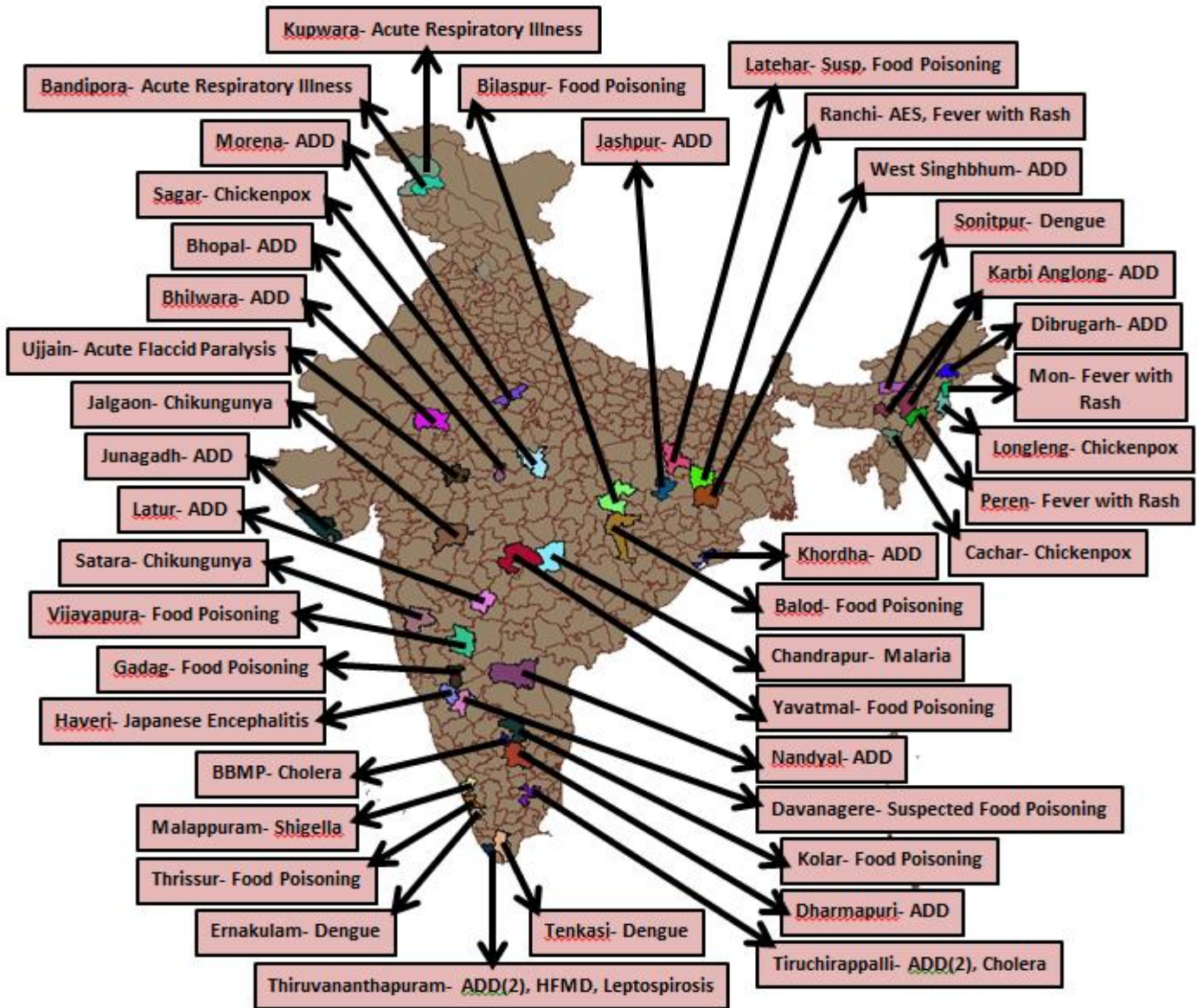

23rd Week Map

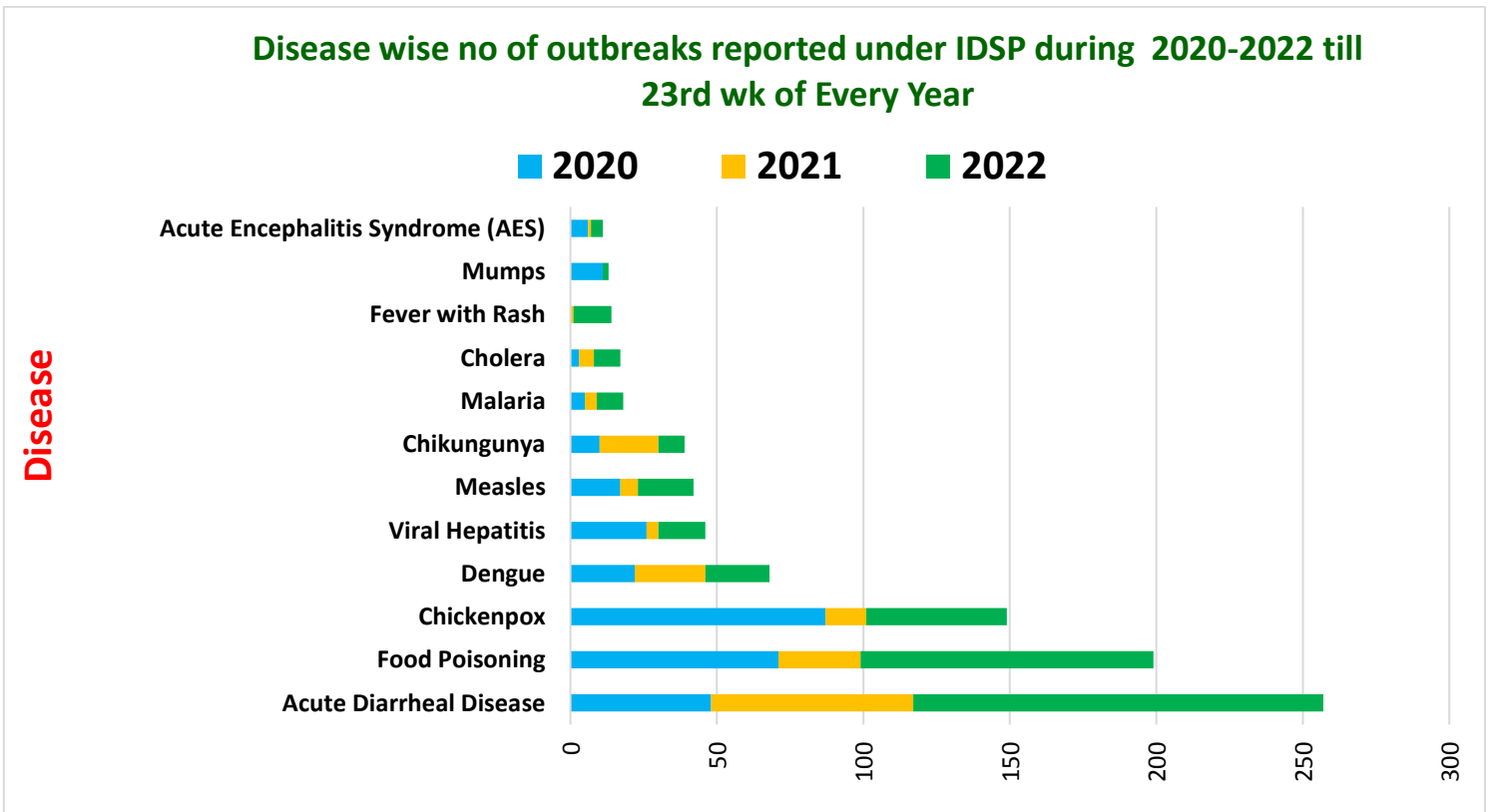
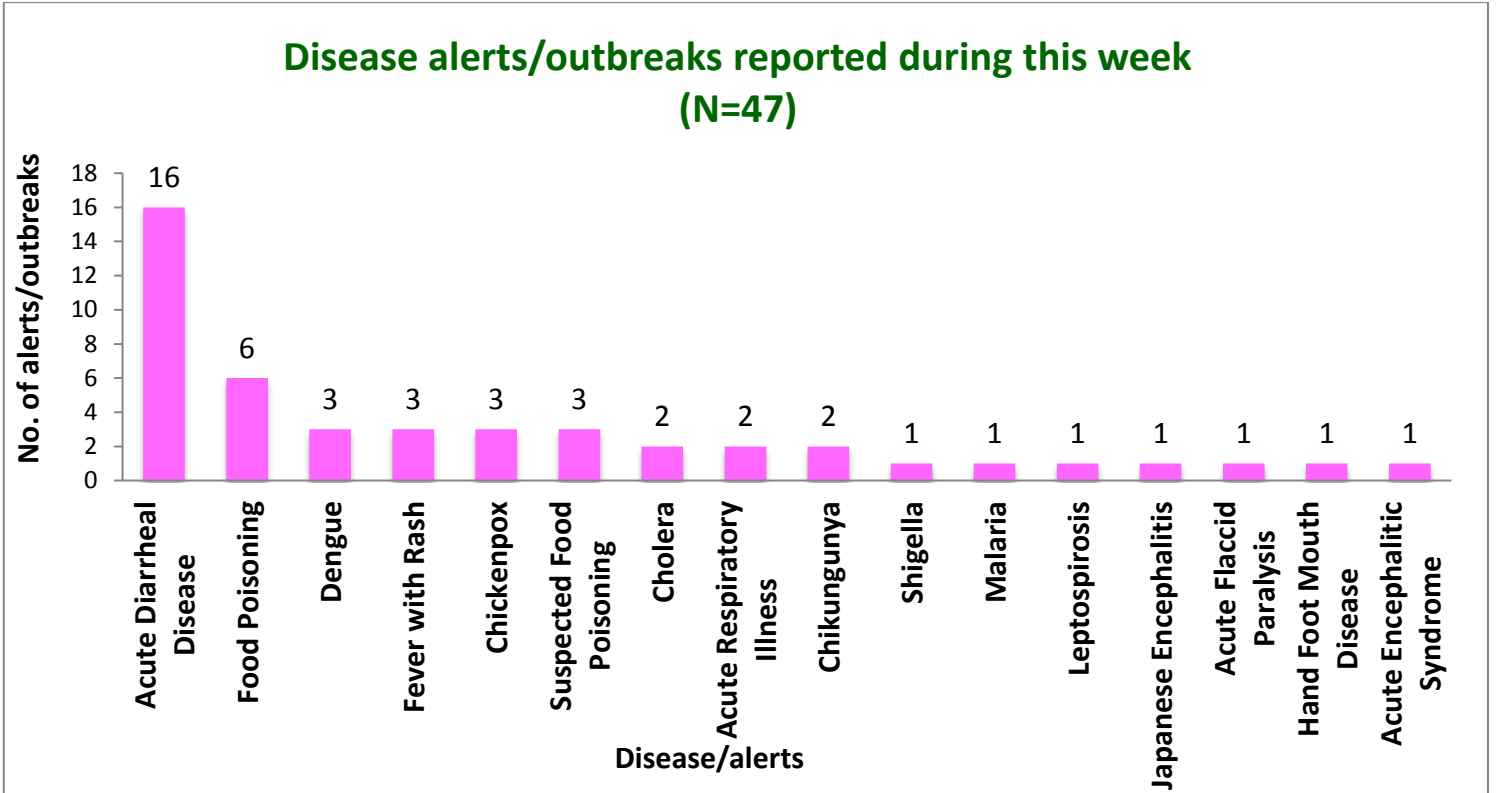
