




Reporting Status of States/UT's





Community awareness and health education given by peripheral health team on the importance of food hygiene, safe drinking water and sanitation.

Report shows some fecal contamination in water. They gave history that they ate dal roti and tomato chutney. The affected age group was 10 years to 55 years. Final cause – Food contamination or in-digestion. ORS packets distribution done and water chlorination done in affected area. Community awareness and health education given by peripheral health team on the importance of food hygiene, safe drinking water and sanitation. Final cause was Food contamination.

IEC regarding hand washing, hygiene, safe preparation of food and avoiding street foods.

Chlorination of common water source done. Cleanliness activity in the village was done.

After the complete investigation of suspected cases, no complication was found in them. The team instructed the villagers to take proper health safety measures, wear masks and live in hygienic conditions and also instructed them to take boiled water for drinking purpose and hand washing before eating and after toilet.

All three blood samples collected, which tested positive for Measles by IgM ELISA. All public health measures are taken such as Isolation of cases done and symptomatic treatment given. House to house survey was done and vitamin A solution was administered to all cases. Extra routine immunization sessions was conducted to cover due beneficiaries of MR1 & MR2 vaccine and extra MR dose up to 10 years of age. Health education was given on the importance of immunization.
