

24<sup>th</sup> Week Map







The deceased were 17 and 22 years old females who died during treatment. 04 blood, 04 Urine, 01 Oil and 01 food samples were sent for lab analysis to Food & Drugs Laboratory, Vadodara and the sample of mustard oil was found to be unsafe for ingestion due to the presence of Argemone oil. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.

Cases presented with loose motion and mild abdominal pain. 04 water samples and 04 rectal swabs were sent for lab analysis to DPHL, Mayurbhanj. Out of these, 3 rectal swabs showed presence of E.coli. Water samples were found to be portable. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.

District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.

District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.
