





Out of 1698, 386 were found positive in District Solan and 194 in Panchkula. District RRT investigated the outbreak and fever survey was done. All of the cases were given symptomatic treatment. Anti-larval spray and fogging was done. Health education was given regarding the importance of vector control measures.
