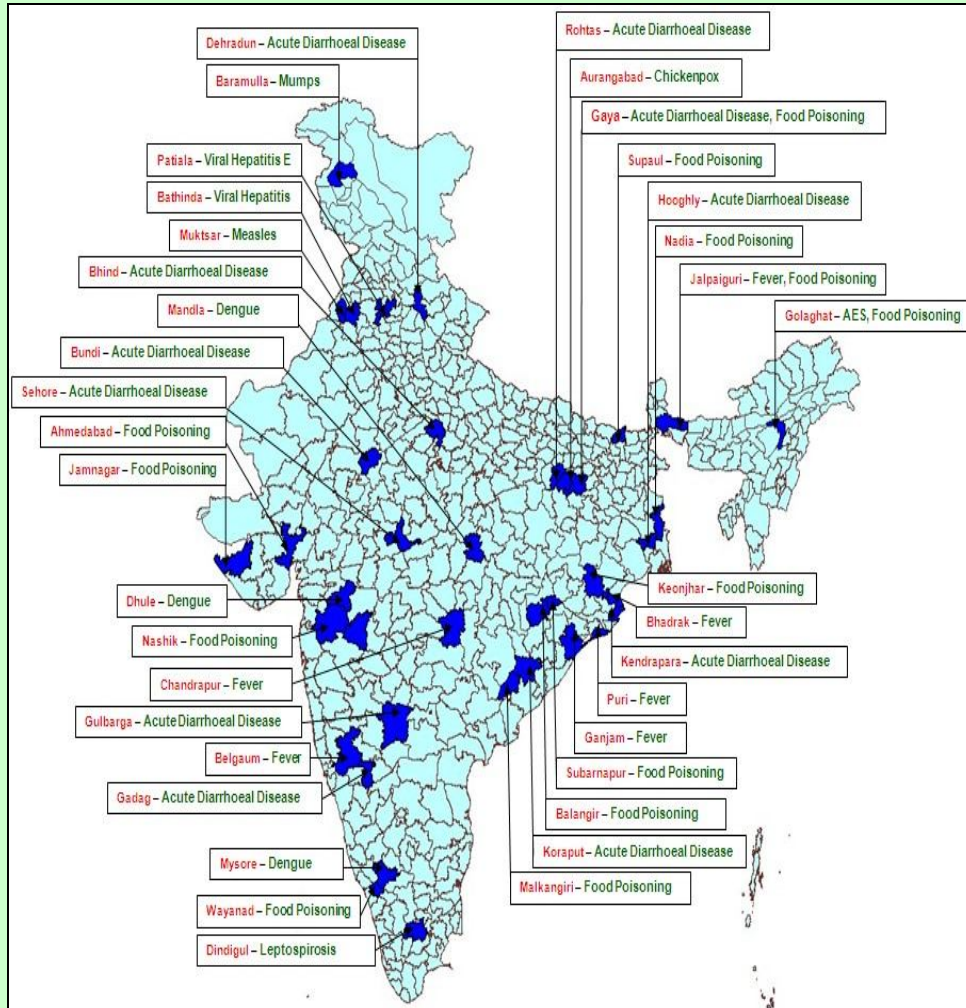


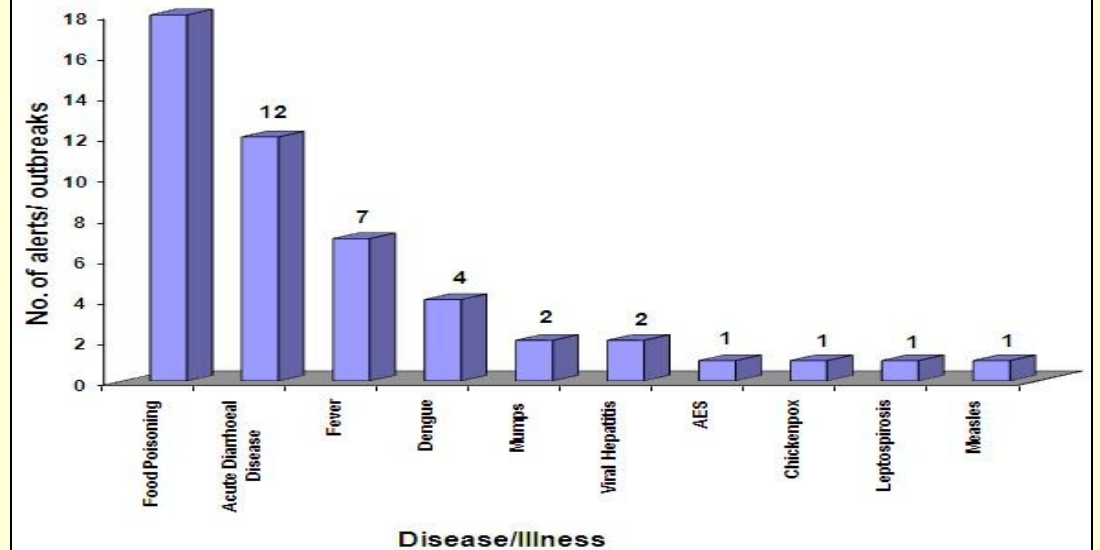

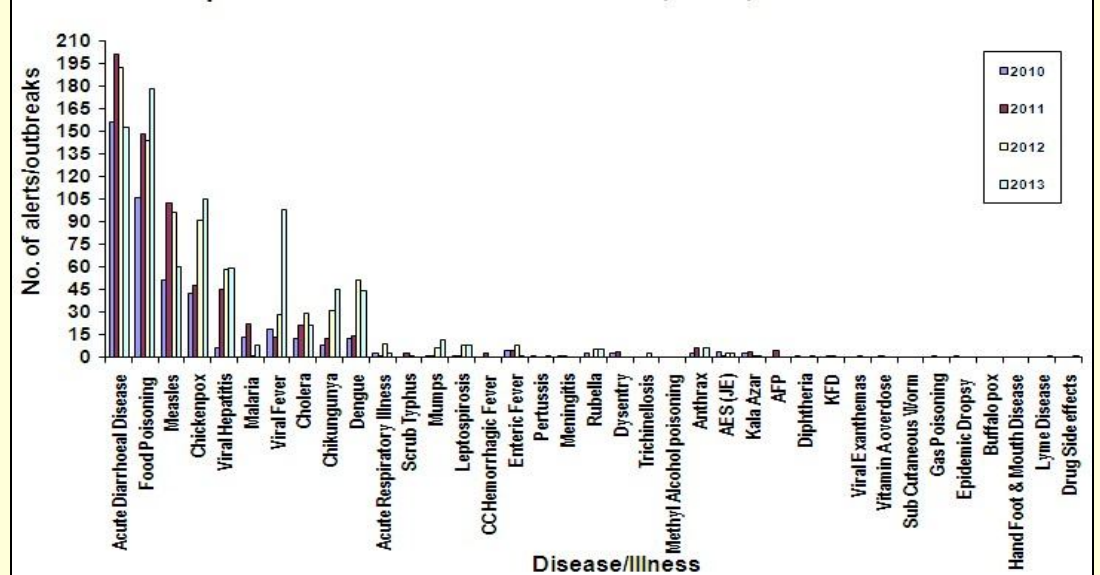
## District wise disease alerts/outbreaks reported in the 24<sup>th</sup> week, 2013
