

Subsequently the case was referred to VS General Hospital, Ahemdabad where the case was clinically diagnosed as CCHF. The case died on 17 <sup>th</sup> June 2012. No samples of the case were taken for lab confirmation. A Medical Doctor, who did intubation of the above case, presented symptoms of high grade fever, headache, anorexia, and metallic taste on 19 <sup>th</sup> June 2012. And he later expired on 22 <sup>nd</sup> June 2012. Samples of the above doctor were tested positive for CCHF. The third case was a ward boy in the VS General Hospital who was in contact with the first and second case. He developed symptoms of fever and decreased urine output on 22 <sup>nd</sup> June 2012 and later diagnosed as acute renal failure. The fourth case who was in contact with the doctor is undergoing treatment in the hospital. Surveillance strengthened within the 5km radius of the affected area. House to house survey done. Co-ordination with animal husbandry department has been established. 14 blood samples of animals were collected. 3 samples of ticks were taken. Deltamethrin spray done. Instructions given to all concerned departments and persons for maintenance of personal hygiene, six-step hand washing, keeping cattle clean, general sanitation measures, and reporting of symptomatic cases. Proper disposal of biomedical wastes and measures to safeguard health of health personal undertaken. IEC given to private practitioners to follow CCHF protocol and undertake universal precautions while treating patients. IEC in general population strengthened with the help of health staff, ASHA and Anganwadi workers.
