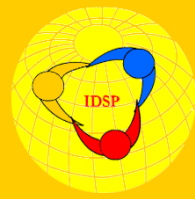

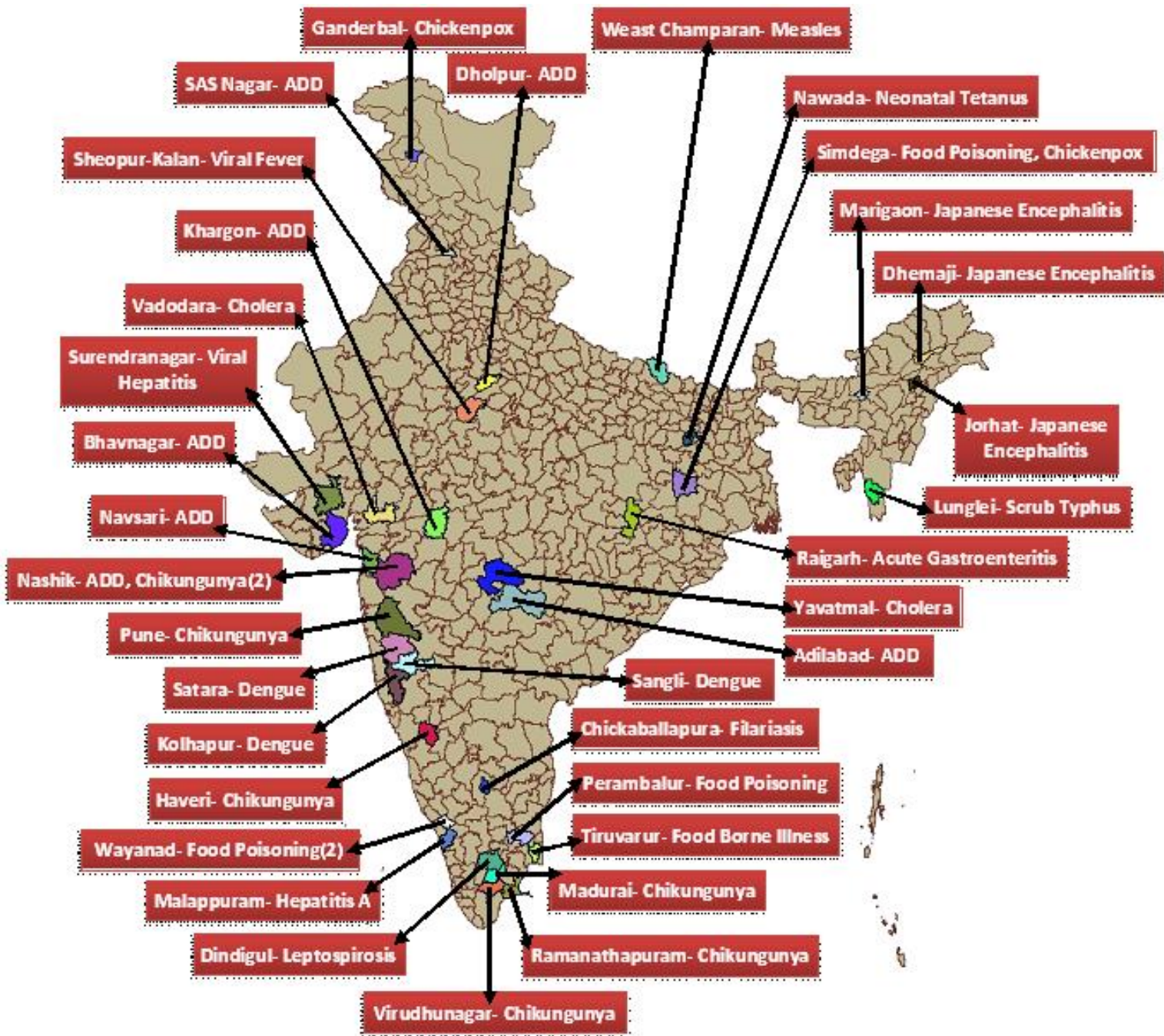

27th Week Map



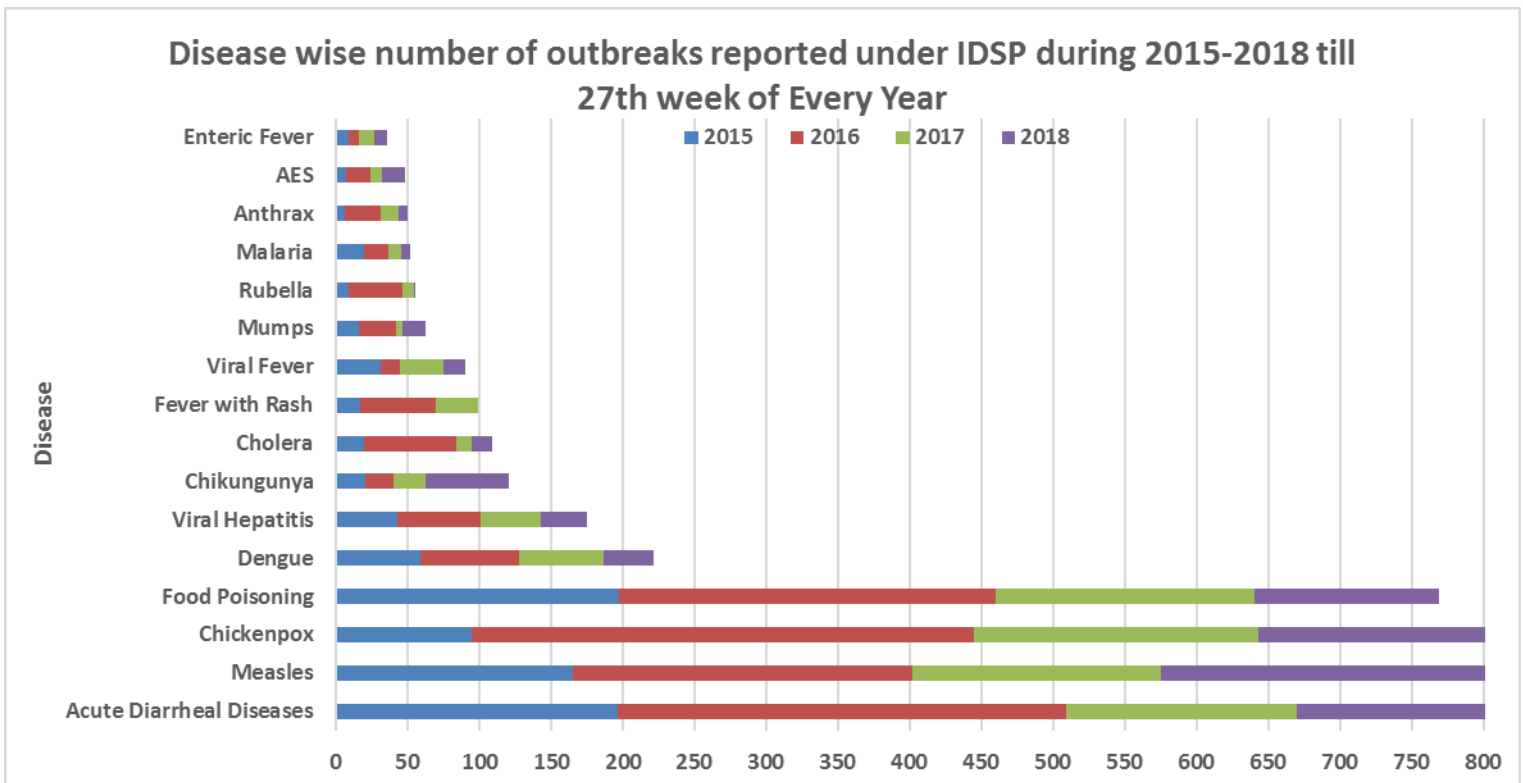
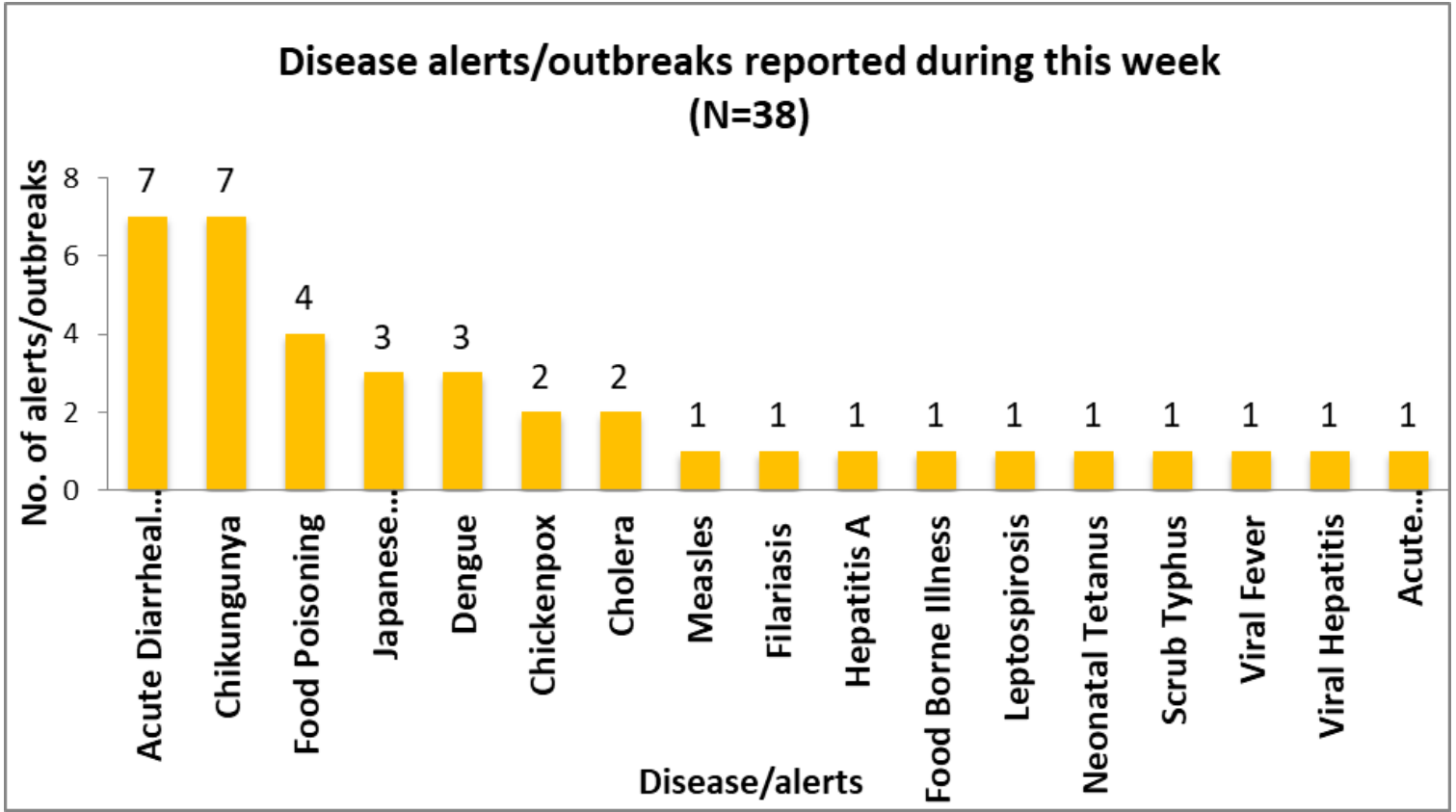
