




Chlorination of water sources done. Health education given regarding safe drinking water, hygiene and sanitation.

All 11 blood smears collected tested positive for <i>P. falciparum</i> . IEC done regarding personal protection.

All cases treated. 32 blood samples collected which tested positive for widal. Health education given regarding consumption of fresh food, hygiene and sanitation.
