






Cases were between 1-18 years of age. A total of 21 samples were collected and all 21 were found positive for Scrub Typhus by IgM using rapid testing kits. All cases treated. Health education given.

A total of 02 water samples were collected and found negative on H <sub>2</sub> S test. All cases treated. Health education given

Mosquito breeding sites observed in the affected area. Cases presented with fever, myalgia and headache. Cases belonged to all age groups, men and women both were equally affected. A total of 04 samples were collected and sent to RPH Lab Kannur, all were found positive for Dengue by IgM ELISA. All cases treated. Source reduction activities carried out. Fogging done. Health education given.
