




31st Week Map






CSF samples were sent for lab analysis and Japanese Encephalitis was confirmed by IgM ELISA by laboratories of respective districts, namely Fakhruddin Ali Ahmed Medical College, -Barpeta, Guwahati Neurological Research Centre - Guwahati, Guwahati, Assam Medical College and Hospital -Dibrugarh, Tezpur Medical College and Hospital, Tezpur. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.
