Health education was given. Case management was done at Chandragiri Private Hospital, Shivamogga, Contact tracing was done and screened for fever and sore throat. No new suspects were found. Health education was given on the importance of immunization.

District RRT investigated the outbreak and house to house survey was conducted. All cases were given symptomatic treatment. ORS sachets and halogen tablets were distributed. Health education was given on the importance of safe drinking water and sanitation.

All cases were given symptomatic treatment. ORS sachets, zinc tablets and halogen tablets were distributed. Health education was given on the importance of safe drinking water and sanitation.

All of them were found negative for Dengue, Malaria, Scrub typhus and SARS-CoV-2. District RRT investigated the outbreak. House to house survey was done. Health education was given on the importance of wearing masks and following COVID appropriate behavior.
