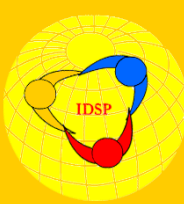

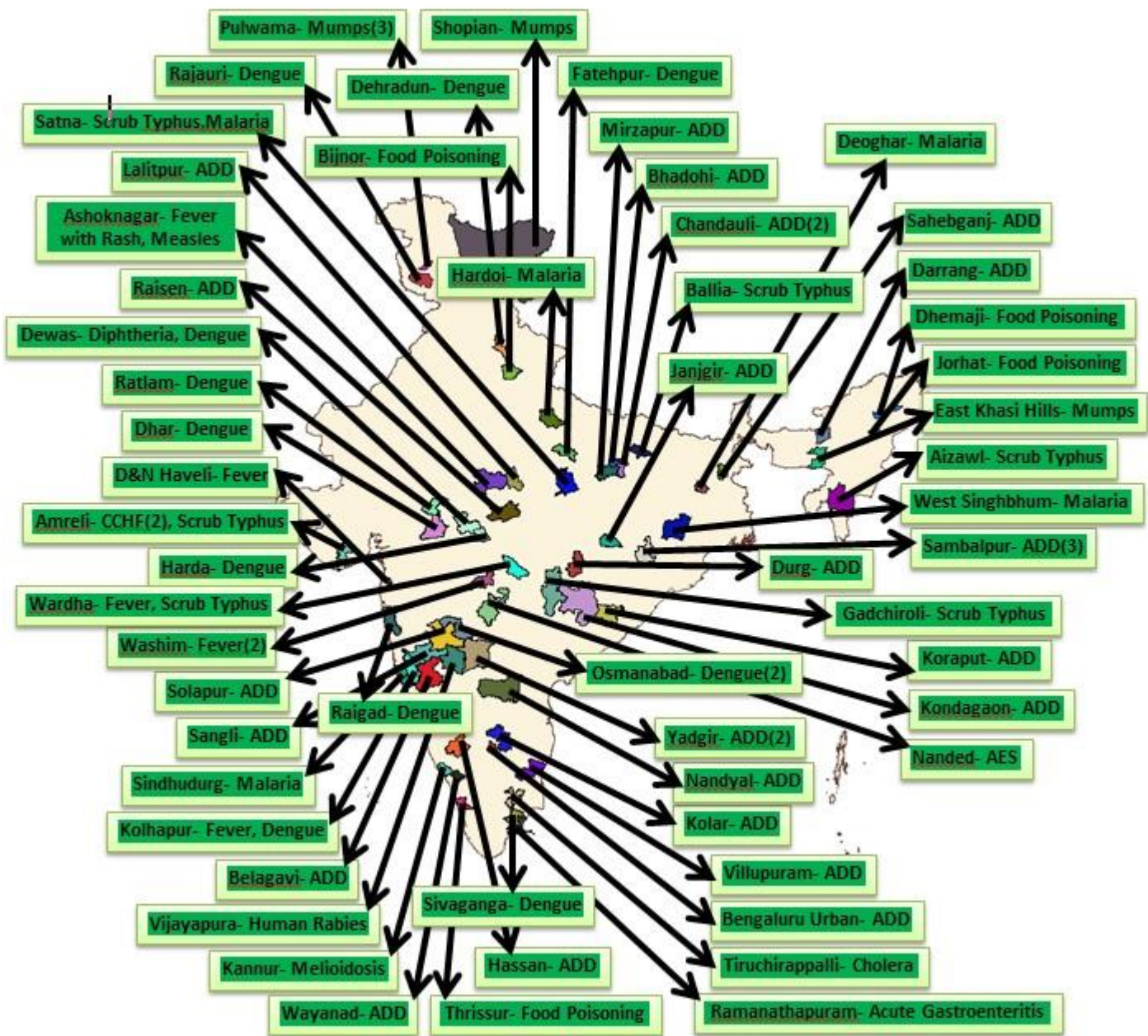

35th Week Map



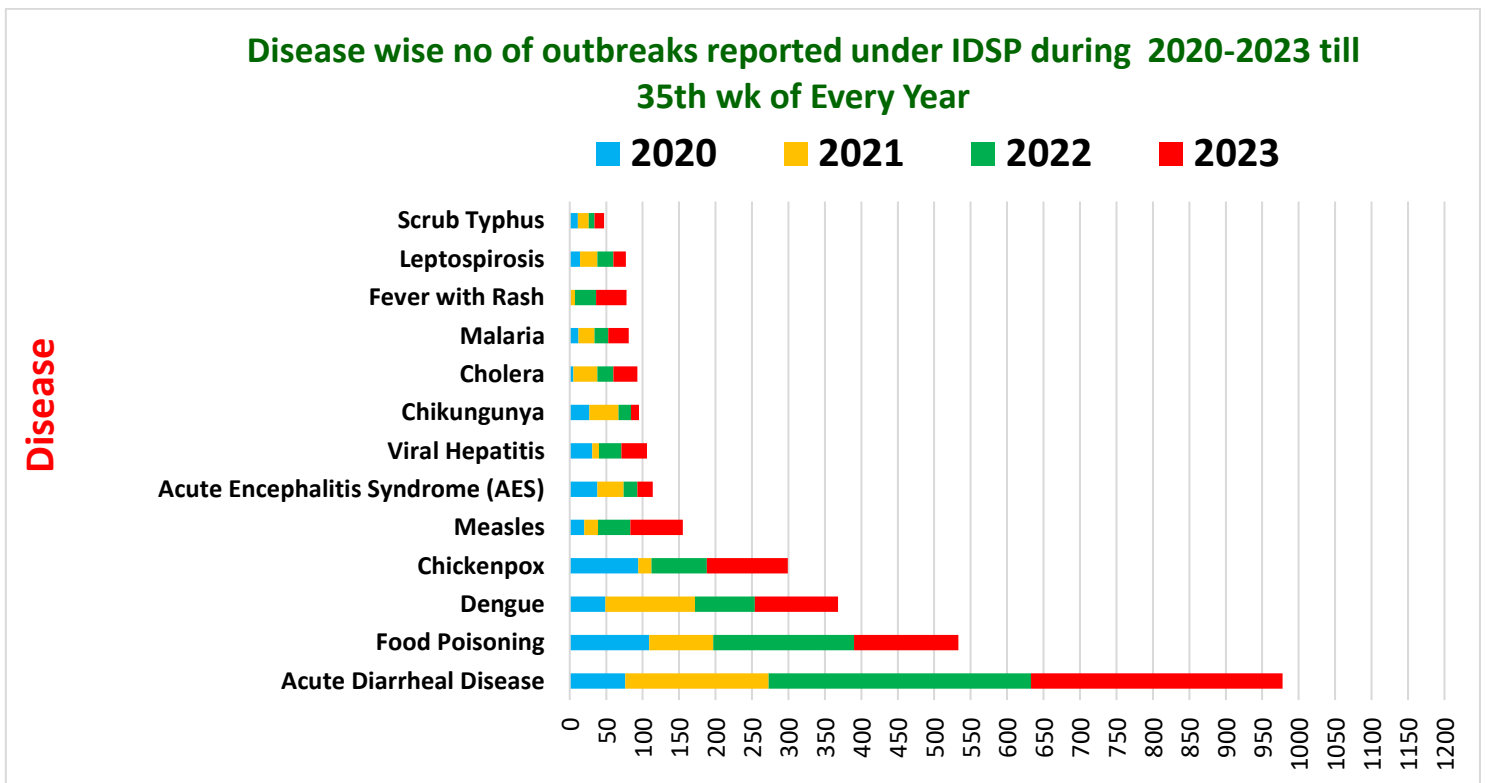
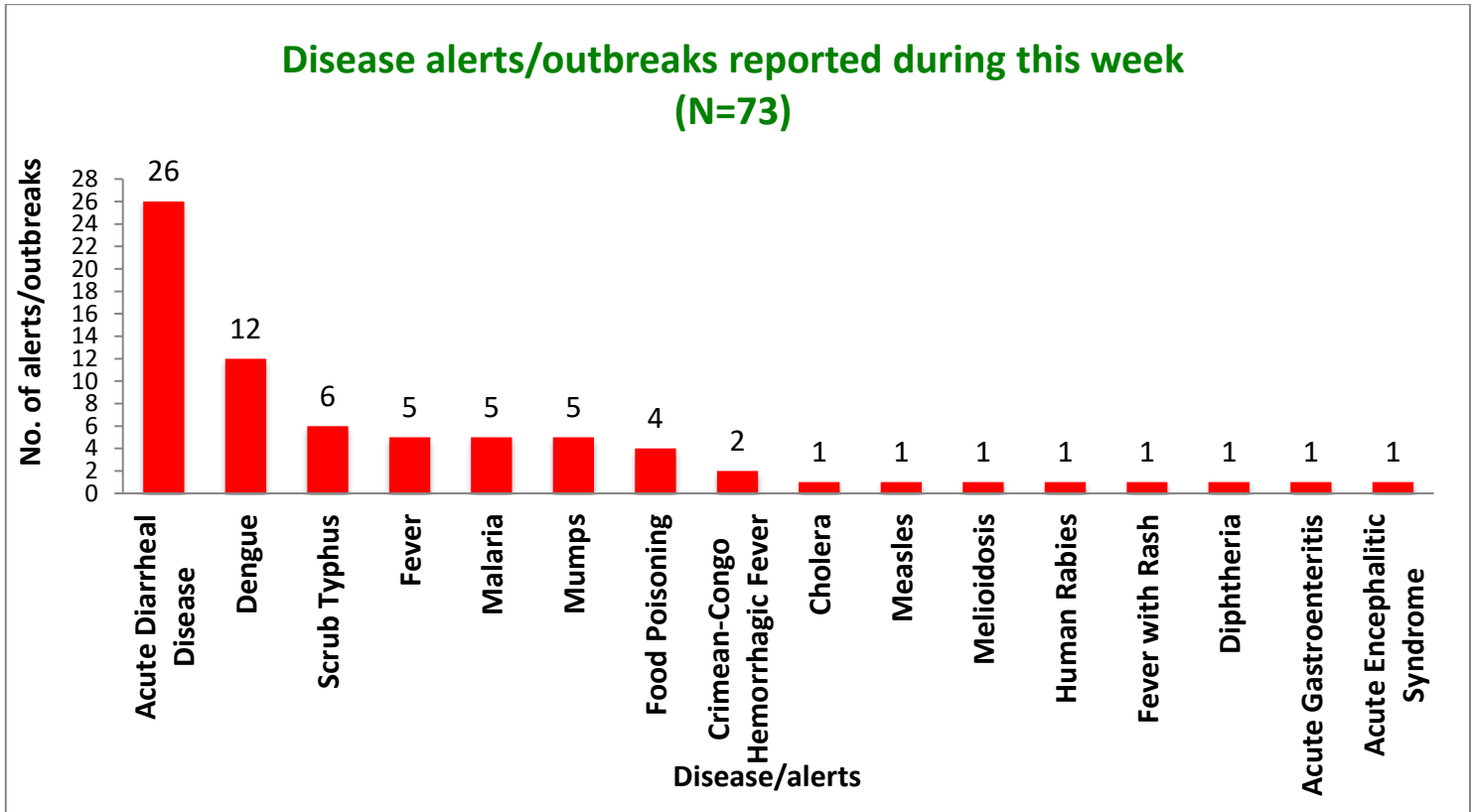
