

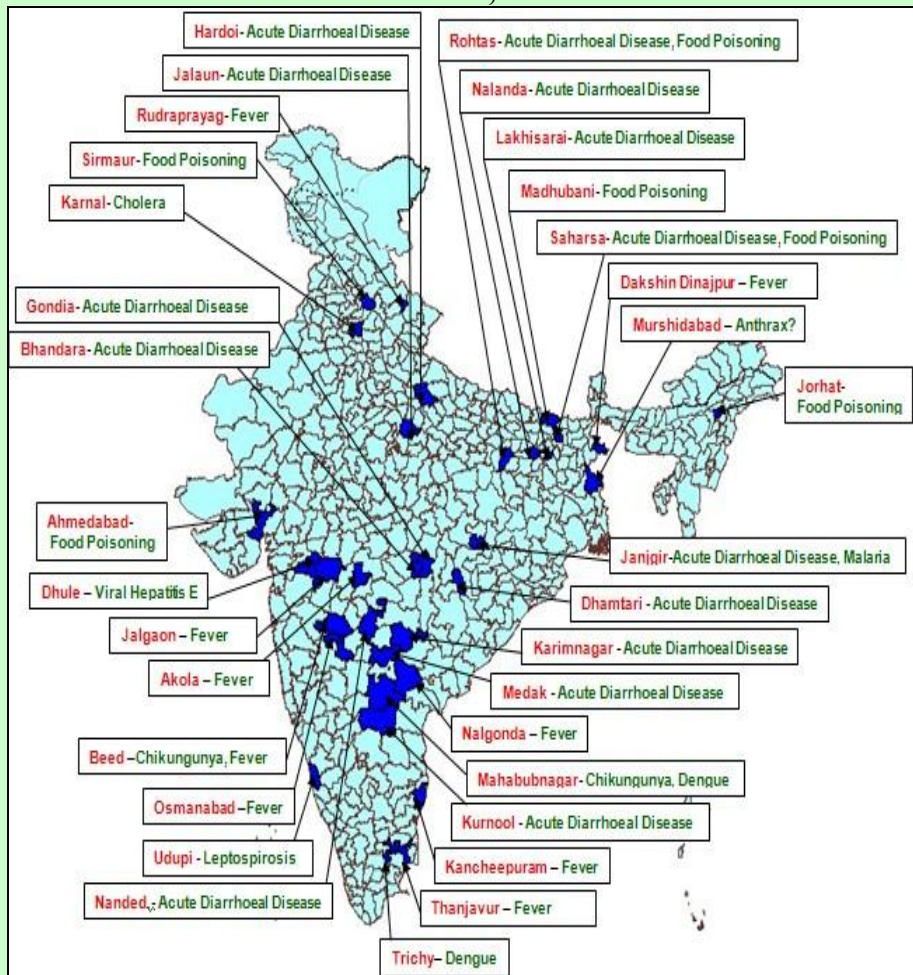

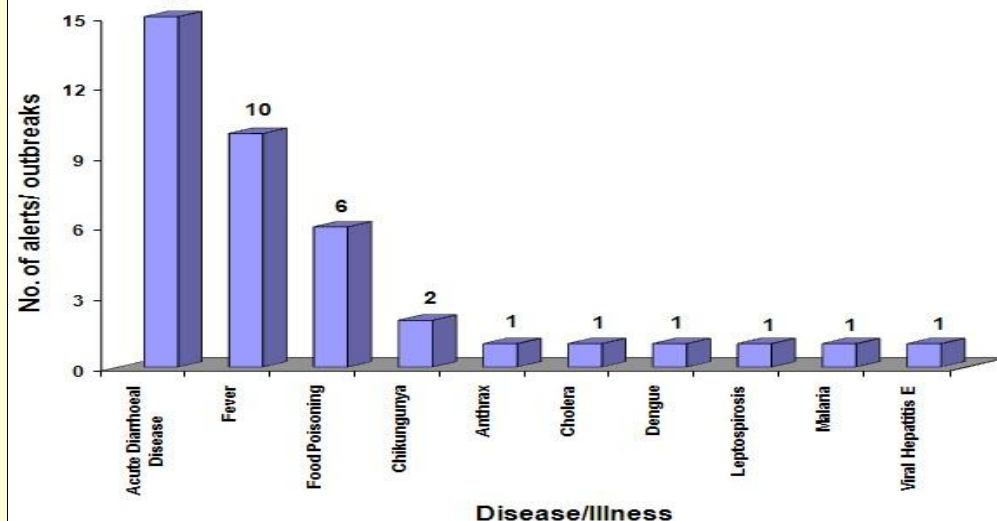
District wise disease alerts/outbreaks reported in the 35th week, 2012



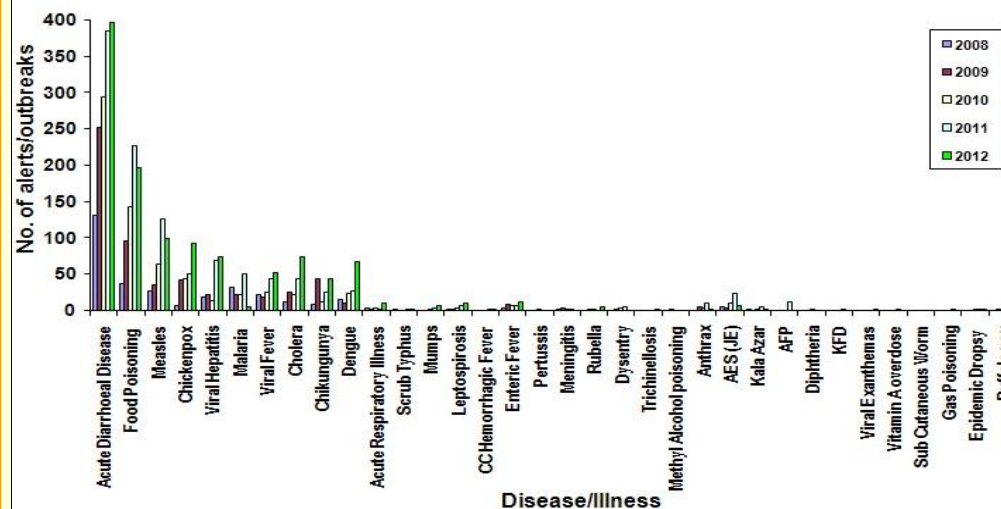
