Health given regarding general sanitation, prevention of diarrhoea and safe drinking water.
2.	Assam	Kamrup	ii. Food Poisoning	42 / 0	31.08.09	02.09.09	Under control	Outbreak reported from Naktadol Village, Sualkuchi BPHC due to consumption of contaminated food (Prasad) in birthday party. Food samples sent for microbiological examination to Microbiology Department, GMCH and for chemical analysis to Forensic Department. Stool samples sent to Microbiology Department, GMCH for lab analysis; result awaited. All cases treated and health education given regarding food hygiene.
		Khargone	iii. Acute Diarrhoeal Disease	113 / 0	27.08.09	27.08.09	Under control	Outbreak reported from Tanda village, CHC Kasrawad due to consumption of contaminated water. District Rapid Response Team (RRT) investigated the outbreak. Water sample collected and sent for lab analysis; result awaited. All cases treated. Chlorination and disinfection of water sources done. Chlorine tablet distributed among villagers.
3.	Madhya Pradesh	Sagar	iv. Acute Diarrhoeal Disease	23 / 0	25.08.09	22.08.09	Under control	Outbreak reported from Jhadapura Mohalla, Jaruakheda village, Block Rahatgarh. RRT visited the affected area. Water sample collected and sent for lab analysis. Chlorination of water sources done and chlorine tablets distributed among villagers. IEC activities undertaken.
		Raisen	v. Malaria	341 / 2	25.08.09	29.08.09	Under control	Outbreak occurred at Agriya Kalan village, Gairatganj block. Blood smears from 21cases tested positive for Malaria. All cases treated with anti-malarial drugs. RRT visited the affected area. Rapid fever survey done for new cases. IEC activities done and health education imparted regarding personal protection measures for prevention of malaria.
4.	Karnataka	Chitradurga	vi. Cholera	8/0	28.08.09	28.08.09	Under control	Cases reported from Maskal Village, PHC Seegehatty, Hairiyur Taluka due to consumption of contaminated water. Out of 3 stool samples collected, one tested positive for <i>Vibrio cholerae</i> at Chitradurga district lab. Medical team deputed to affected area for control of outbreak. Water samples tested found unfit for drinking purpose. Tanks cleaned and disinfected in the affected village. Broken pipelines replaced by new ones by local authorities. Halogen tablets distributed in affected village. Chlorination of drinking water done. Health education given about sanitation, personal hygiene and importance of use of boiled water.
		Chikmagalur	vii.Acute Diarrhoeal Disease	22 / 0	30.08.09	30.08.09	Under control	Outbreak reported from Eshwarahally village, Taluka Chikmagalur due to consumption of contaminated water. Water pipeline valves found leaking at many places thereby contaminating drinking water supply. All cases treated. House to house active search done for new cases of diarrhoea. Stool and water samples sent for lab analysis to district lab; result awaited.

IEC activities undertaken. Health education given regarding sanitation and hygienic practices.

Many fever cases have been reported from other villages under neighboring PHC Dharahra. All cases treated with antimalarial drugs. Mass chemoprophylaxis given with chloroquine. IEC activities done and health education given regarding personal protection measures.
