

37th Week Map








A total of 02 stool samples were collected and tested at Dr. Lal Path Lab, Naharlagun; it was reported as Escherichia coli- heavy growth. A single water sample was collected and found positive for bacteriological test. All cases were treated symptomatically. Health education given.

A total of 22 samples of drinking water were taken by health department and sent to public health laboratory, Ramgarh for bacteriological testing; 12 samples were found unfit for consumption. A total of 06 samples of drinking water were collected and examined by PGI, Chandigarh and all were found positive for Cholera. A total of 02 sewage water samples were collected and examined at PGI, Chandigarh and both were positive for cholera. All students in the hostel were screened for similar complaints. Isolation facility was arranged in the hostel. All students and staff were immunized against diphtheria. Health education given.
