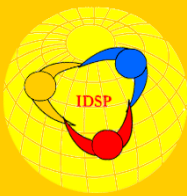

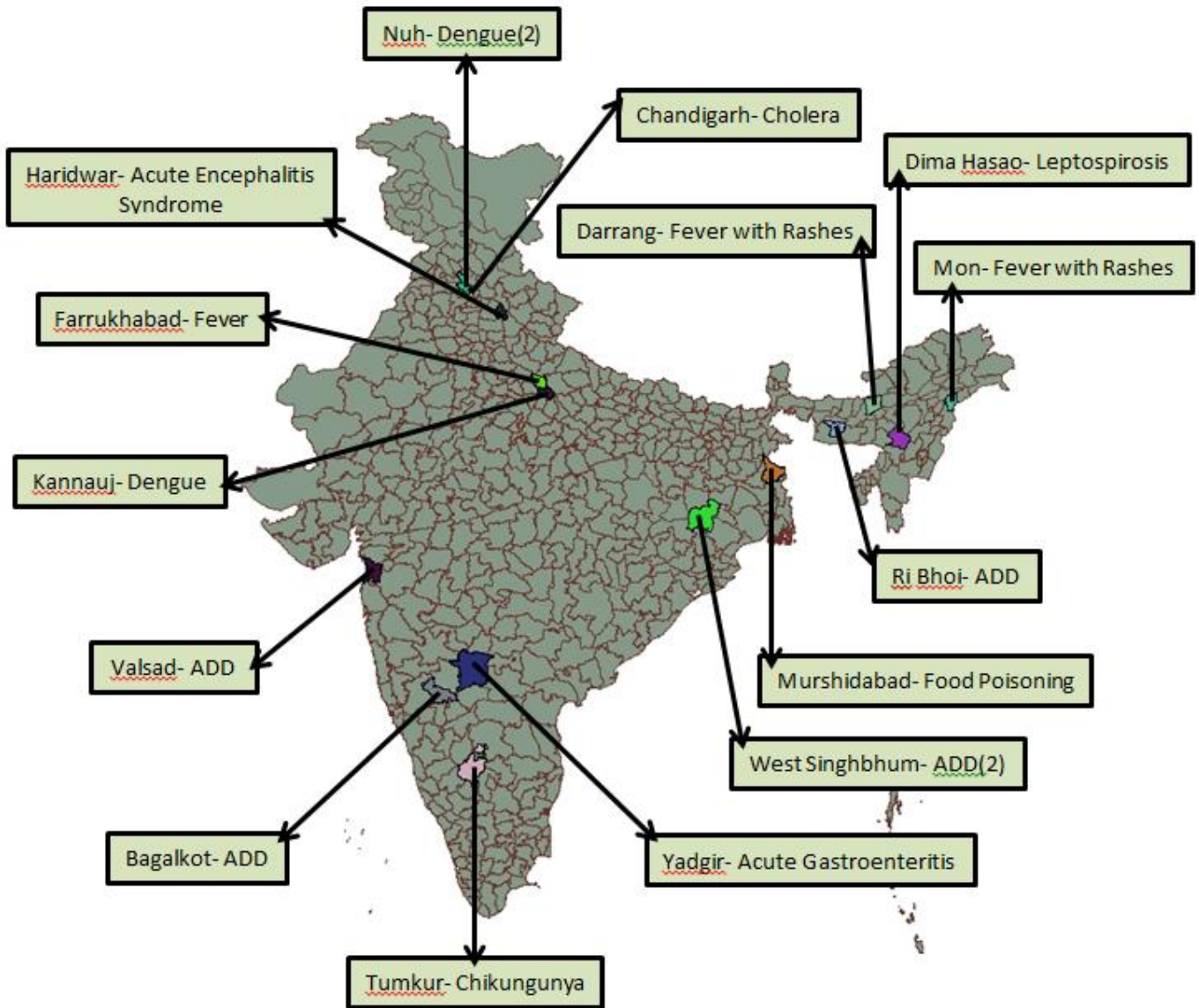

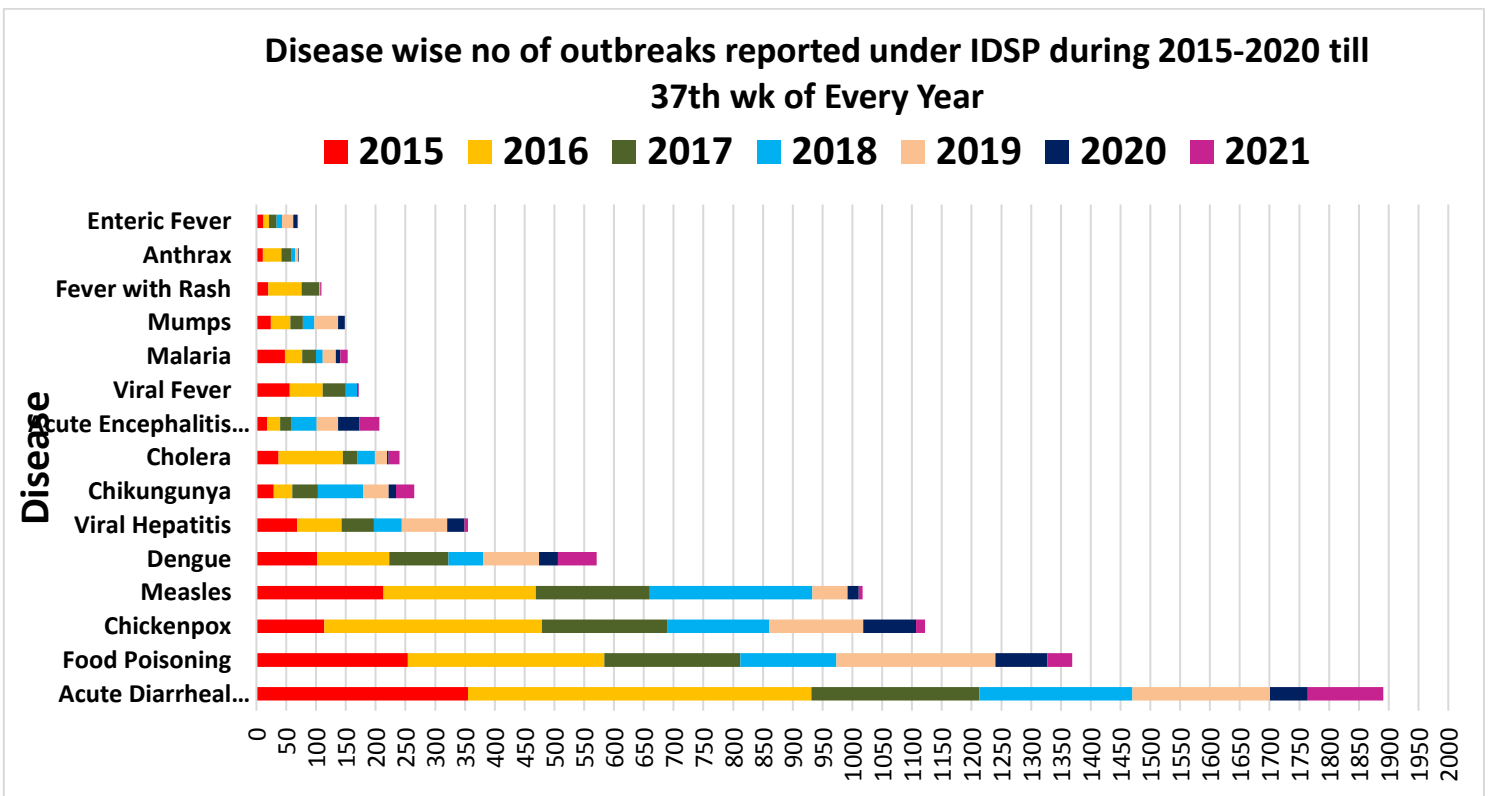

Cases presented with diarrhea and vomiting. Water reservoir was unprotected being the cause of outbreak. District RRT investigated the outbreak. All cases were treated by ORS and anti-diarrheal drugs. Active surveillance was done. Health education was given regarding importance of hygiene and sanitation measures.

All cases were treated by ORS and anti-diarrheal drugs. Active surveillance was done. Health education was given regarding importance of hygiene and sanitation measures.

One blood sample and two throat swab samples were sent for further lab investigation, the samples were found to be negative for Measles by IgM ELISA. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.

One CSF Sample was sent to GMC Haldwani for further lab analysis and it was found to be negative for Japanese Encephalitis. The deceased was a 7 year old male. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.
WB/MRS/2021/37/0461	West Bengal	Murshidabad	Food Poisoning	179	00	14-09-21	15-09-21	Under Control	Cases reported from Village Anandanagar, Kasimnagar, Sitanagar & Chak Islampur, SC Nalbatta, Sukdebmati, Block Raninagar-I, GP-Herampur, District Murshidabad. Three stool samples were sent to DPHL for further lab analysis, out of which all the samples showed the growth of staphylococcus aureus. Water sample was sent to PHE for further lab analysis, the result is awaited. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.

District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.

District RRT investigated the outbreak. Indoor and outdoor fogging was done under NVBDCP. Health education was given using IEC materials regarding awareness of the disease.

District RRT investigated the outbreak. Indoor and outdoor fogging was done under NVBDCP. Health education was given using IEC materials regarding awareness of the disease.

Cases presented with fever with chills. 10 blood samples were sent to DPHL Tumkur for further lab investigation. Of these, it was found that 4 samples were positive for Chikungunya by IgM ELISA. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.
<b>UP/FRK/2021/37/0467</b>	<b>Uttar Pradesh</b>	<b>Farrukhabad</b>	<b>Fever</b>	163	01	01-09-21	Under Control	Cases reported from Village Barhpur, Kamalganj, SC Amethi Kohna, Bidail, Patonja, Rajepur Saraymeda, District Farrukhabad. 602 samples were sent for further lab analysis, out of which all were found to be negative for Malaria by Rapid diagnostic test. Seven suspected Dengue cases were tested using IgM ELISA and one sample was found to be positive for Dengue. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.

UP/KAJ/2021/37/0468	Uttar Pradesh	Kannauj	Dengue	11	00	31-08-21	Under Surveillance	Cases reported from Village Tikhwa, CHC & Block Kannauj, District Kannauj. 25 serum samples were sent for further lab analysis, out of which nine samples were found to be positive for Dengue by IgM ELISA. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Indoor and outdoor fogging was done. Health education was given using IEC materials regarding awareness of the disease.
