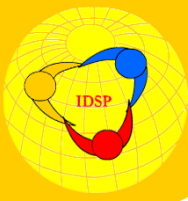

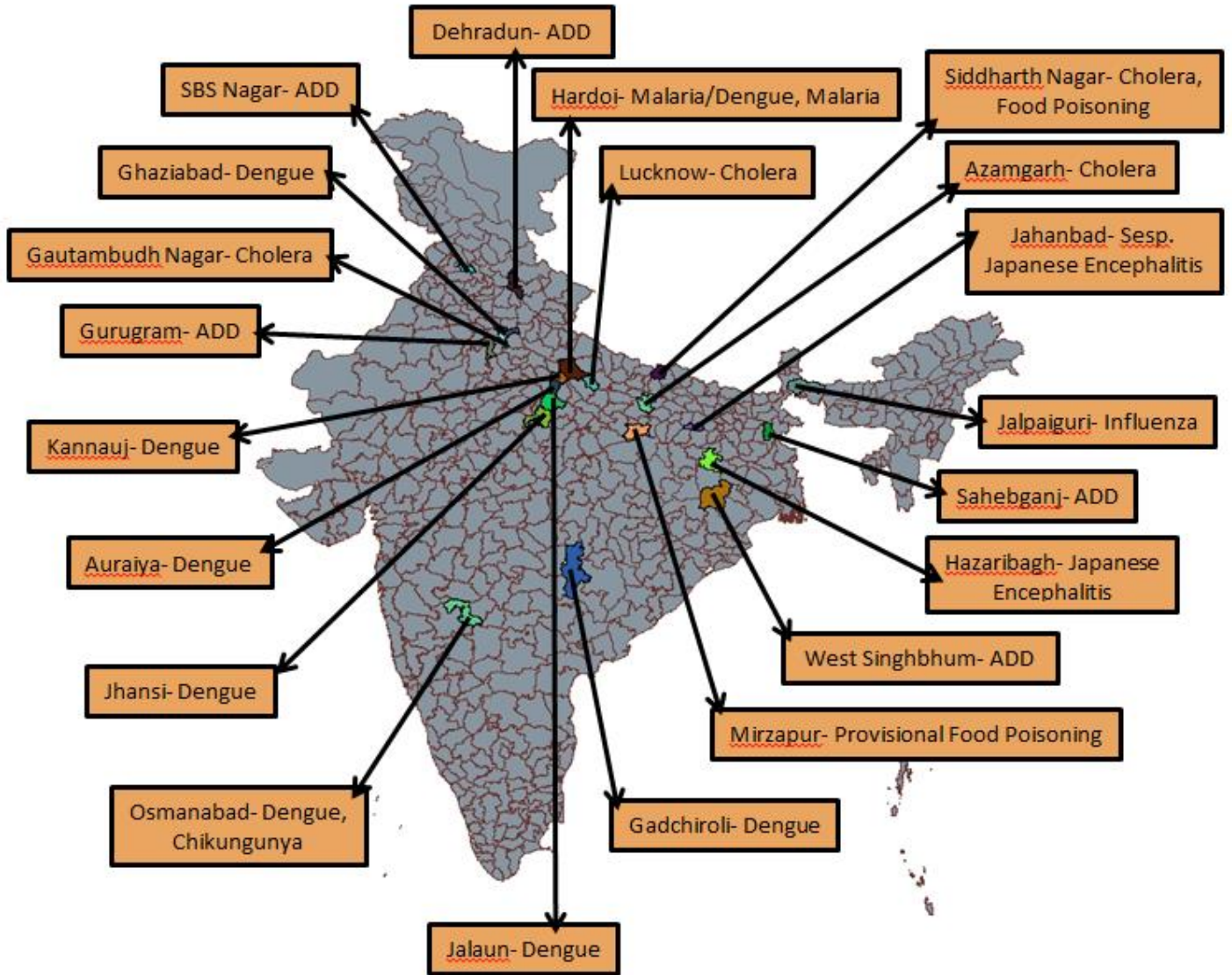

## 39<sup>th</sup> Week Map

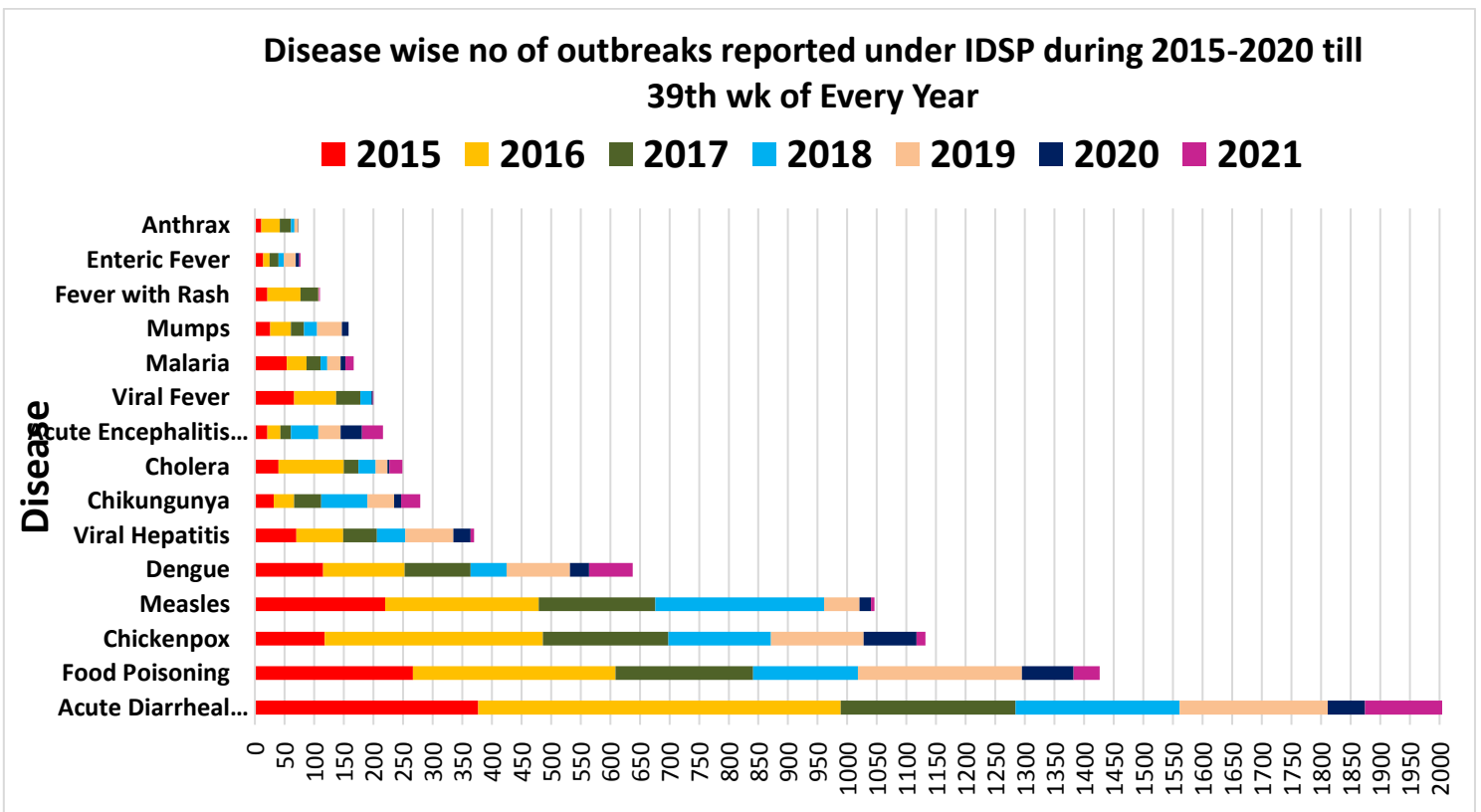
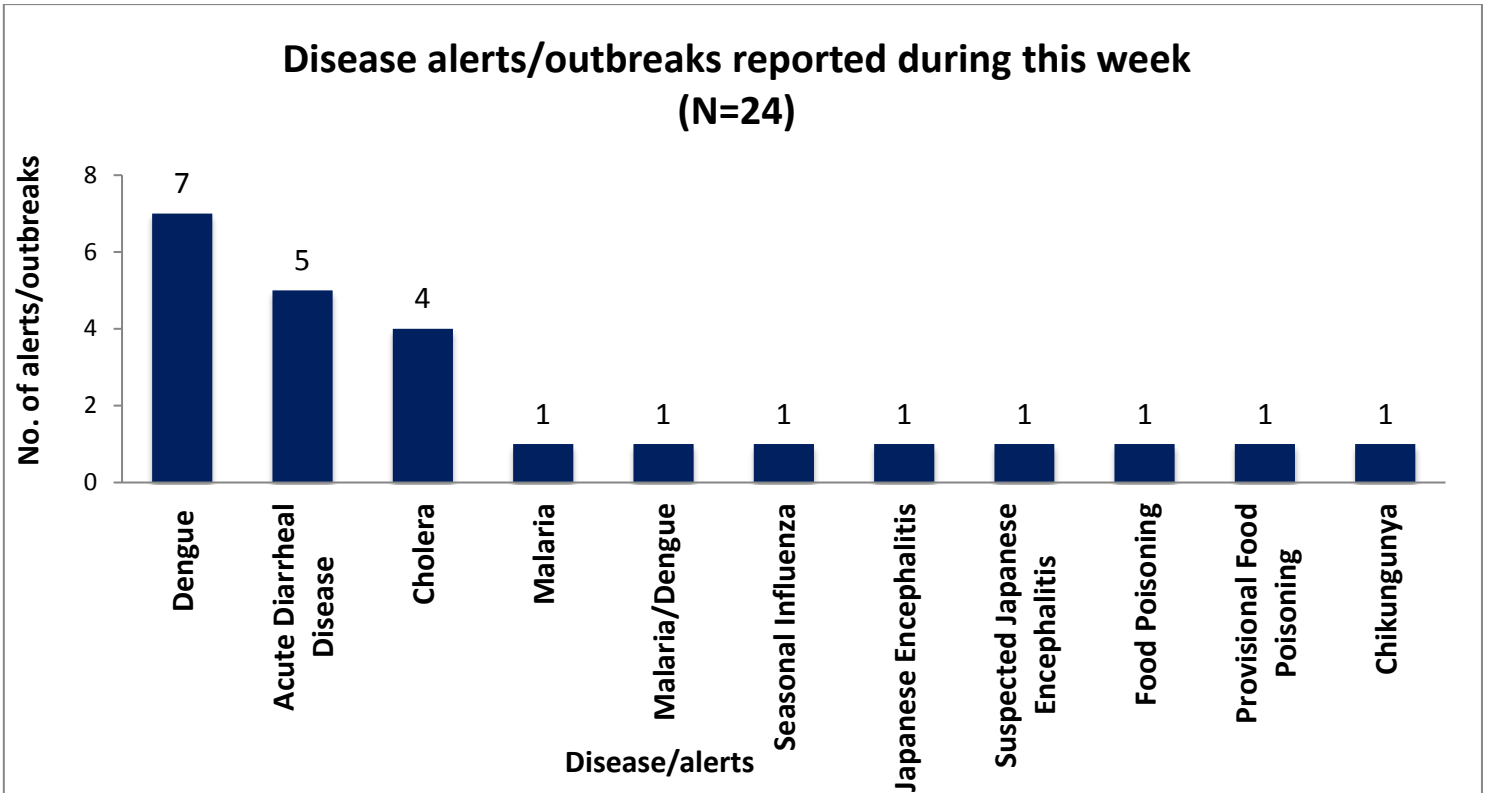

District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.

Six stool samples were sent to DPHL, SBS Nagar and six water samples were sent to SPHL for analysis. It was found that all the six stool samples showed growth of E.coli and all the six water samples were unfit for drinking. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.

Cases presented with fever and bodyache. 31 blood slides and seven blood samples were sent for lab analysis, of these all were found negative for Malaria and three blood samples were found positive for Dengue by IgM ELISA. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.

Medical College, Chakrapanpur Azamgarh. It was found that water sample were contaminated, 16 samples showed presence of E coli and two samples found positive for Vibrio Cholerae. The deceased cases were 4 years old female, 49 years old female and 5 years old male. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.

Stool and water samples were collected and sent for lab for testing. Stool samples showed growth of Vibrio cholerae. Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. District RRT investigated the outbreak. A total of 350 houses were surveyed in which all people were examined and no cases of diarrhea were found. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water.

District RRT investigated the outbreak. It was found that drinking water was contaminated with sewage water. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding the importance of safe drinking water.

Health education was given regarding importance of properly cooked food and safe drinking water.

Cases presented with loose stools. Six stool samples were sent to KGMU Lucknow, of which one sample was found positive for Vibrio cholera. The deceased cases were 34 years old female and a 5 years old male. District RRT investigated the outbreak. It was found that there was leakage and contamination of drinking water with sewage water. Health education was given regarding importance of properly cooked food and safe drinking water.

Out of these, there was no growth in stool samples, blood samples were found negative for Typhoid and Hepatitis A&E. Colliform was detected in the water samples and thus found unfit for drinking. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases, chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given.

The deceased cases were all females aged 3 months, 1.5 years and 6 years. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.

The outbreak was reported due to consumption of stale food at a religious gathering. All cases were symptomatically treated. Chlorination of water source was done. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water.
