




41st Week Map








A total of 12 blood samples collected and sent to KGMU, Lucknow and 05 were found to be positive for Dengue by IgM ELISA. All cases treated. Fogging done. Source reduction activities undertaken. Health education given.

All 05 blood samples were found positive for Hepatitis E by IgM ELISA and both water sample was found to be unsatisfactory for human consumption by MPN test. All cases treated. Health education given on food and water hygiene.
