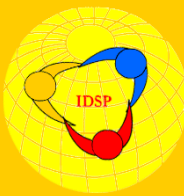

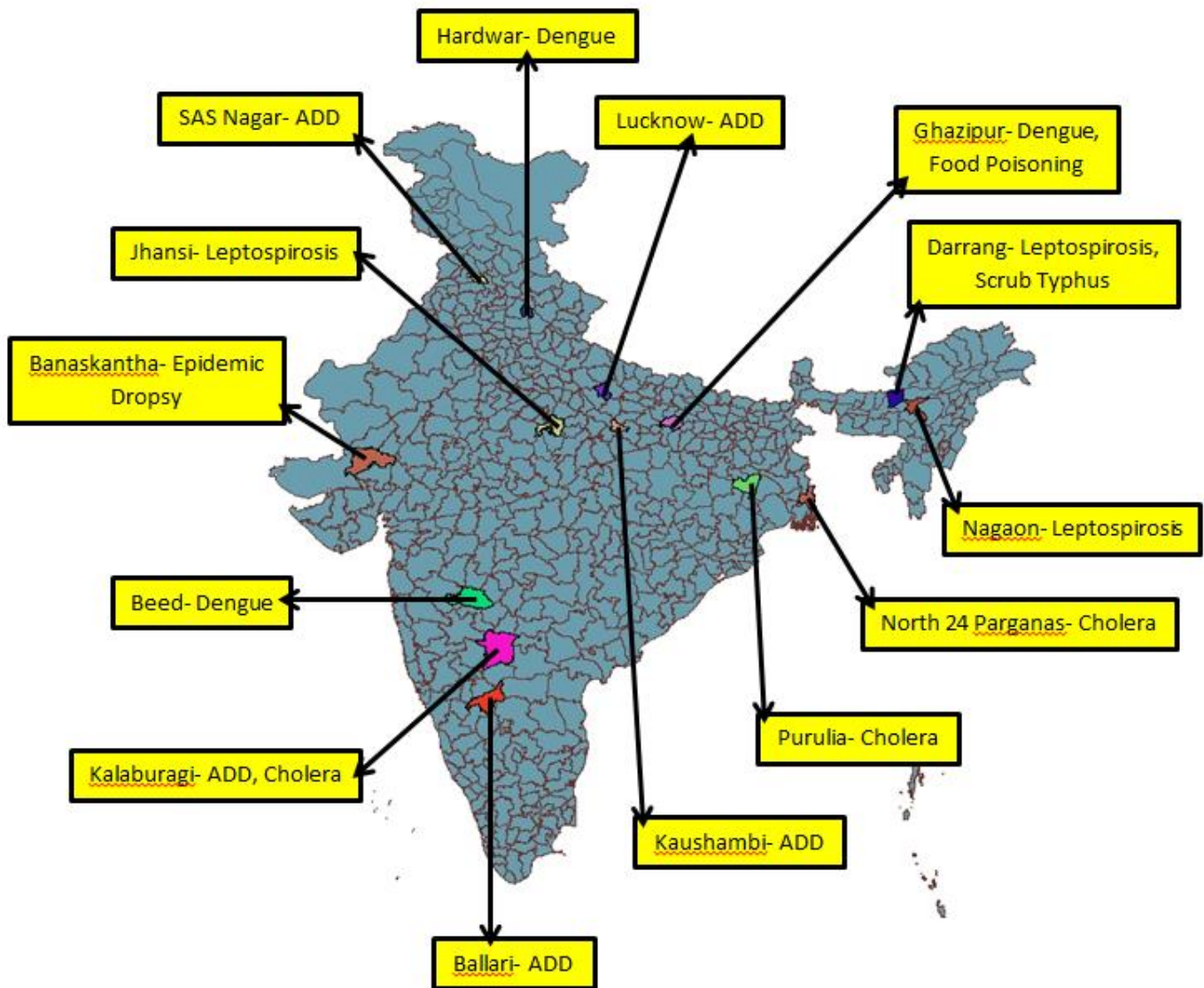

41st Week Map

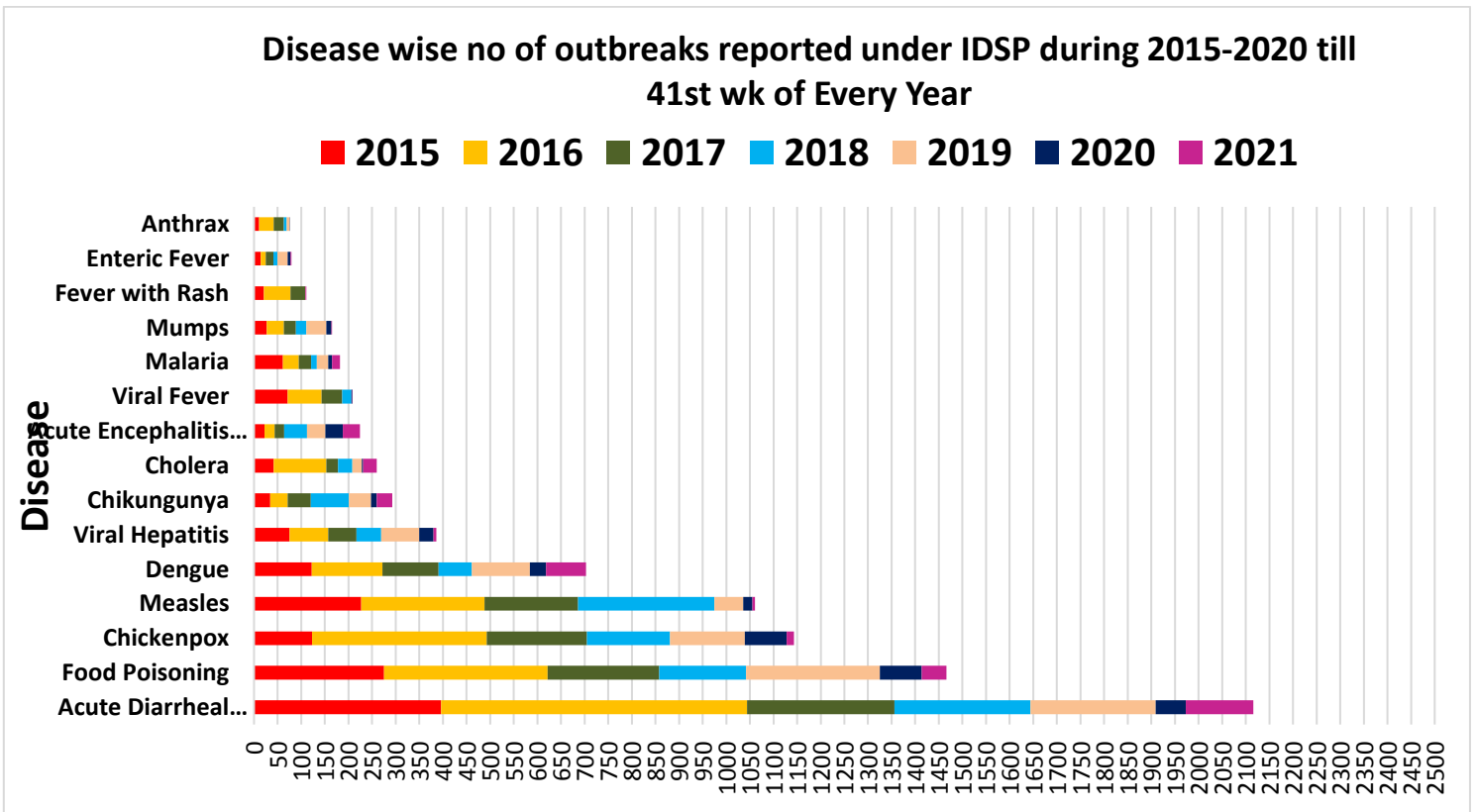
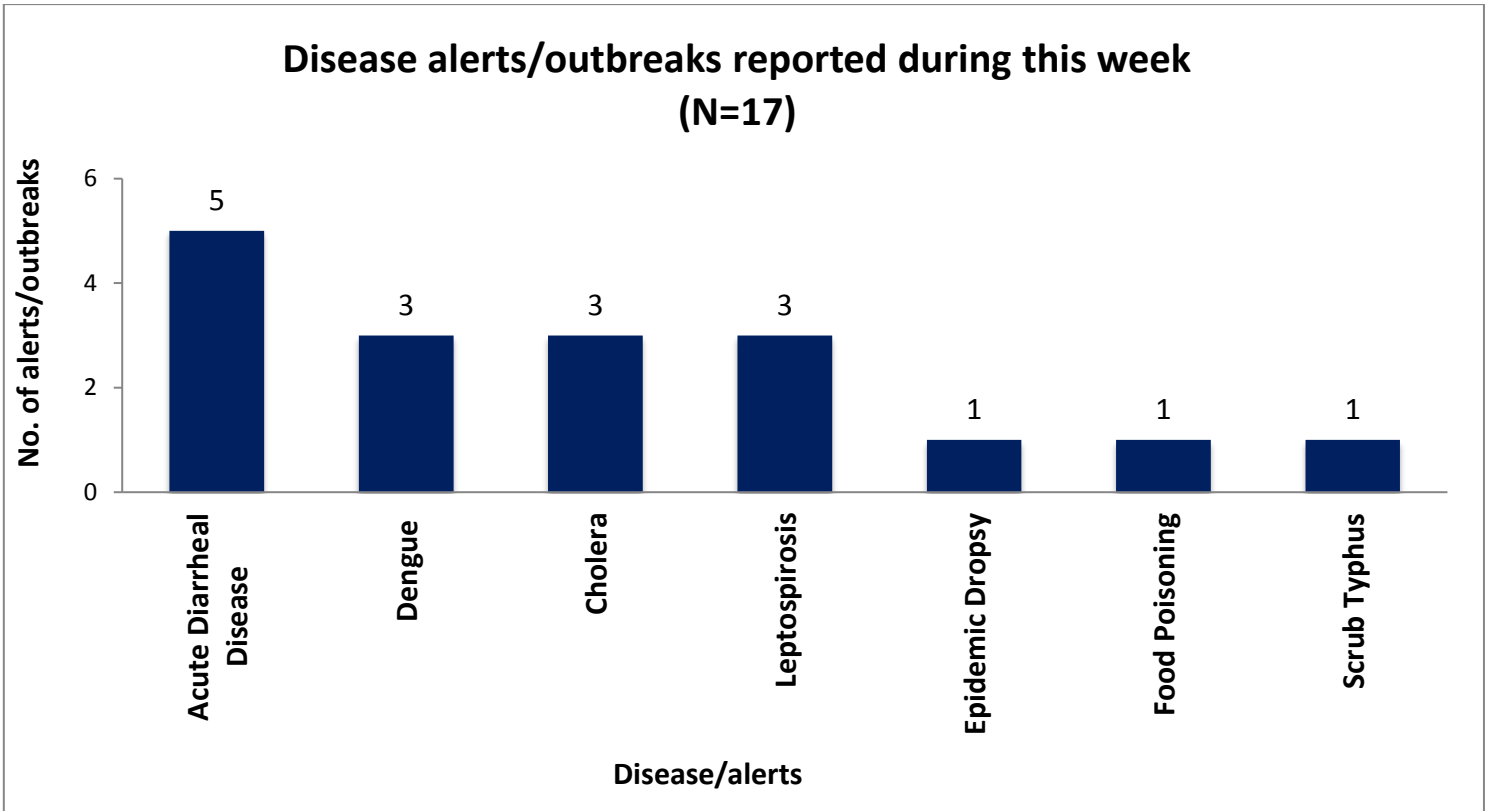

Nine blood samples were sent to DPHL, IDSP, Nagaon. Of these, one sample was found positive for Leptospirosis by IgM ELISA. The deceased case was a 65 years old female. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.
KN/BEL/2021/41/0546	Karnataka	Ballari	Acute Diarrheal Disease	11	00	16-10-21	16-10-21	Under Control	Cases reported from Taluk HB Halli, District Ballari. Cases presented with loose stools and vomiting. Nine stool samples were sent to DPHL, Ballari. Results awaited. District RRT investigated the outbreak. It was found that outbreak was due to pipeline damage and leakages that caused contamination of drinking water. Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water.

Cases presented with loose stools and vomiting. Two stool and 17 water samples were sent to PHC Madbul, DPHL. Stool samples found negative for Vibrio cholerae. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Due to heavy rain, there was contamination of drinking water pipelines with drainage water. Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water.

One stool sample and 10 water samples were sent for lab analysis to Ambalaga PHC. Of these, one stool sample showed presence of Vibrio Cholerae. RRT investigated the outbreak. Due to heavy rain, there was contamination of drinking water pipelines with drainage water. Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water.

Five blood samples were sent to District Hospital, Beed. Of these, three samples were found positive for dengue by IgM ELISA. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Anti-larval spray was used and fogging done. Health education was given regarding importance of vector control measures.

Cases presented with loose stools and vomiting. Five blood and four stool samples were sent for lab analysis. Result awaited. RRT investigated the outbreak. It was found that outbreak was due to contaminated drinking water. Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water.

Cases presented with loose stools. Three water samples were collected and sent to KGMU Lucknow and showed unfit for drinking. District RRT investigated the outbreak. It was found that drinking water pipelines were contaminated with drainage water. Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water and properly cooked food.
UK/HDW/2021/41/0552	Uttarakhand	Haridwar	Dengue	172	00	16-10-21	18-10-21	Under Control	Cases reported from Village Gadhrona, Block Narson, District Haridwar. Cases presented with fever, headache and retro-orbital pain. 414 blood samples were sent to Sub District Hospital Roorkee. Of these, 172 samples were found positive for Dengue by IgM ELISA. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Anti-larval spray was used and fogging done. Health education was given regarding importance of vector control measures.
WB/PRL/2021/41/0553	West Bengal	Purulia	Cholera	22	00	13-10-21	14-10-21	Under Control	Cases reported from Village Tilagara, SC Bhandapuara – Chipida, Block Purulia-I, District Purulia. Cases presented with loose stools. Two rectal swabs collected and sent to BSMCH Lab. Of these, one sample was showed growth of Vibrio cholerae. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water and properly cooked food.

Health education was given.

Cases presented with swelling of both feet. Two food samples were sent to F&D Dept Baroda and showed presence of argemone. The deceased cases were a 55 years old male, 24 years old male and an 18 years old female. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.

Cases presented with fever and headache. 12 blood samples were sent to BHU Varanasi. Of these, three samples were found positive for Dengue by IgM ELISA. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Anti-larval spray was used and fogging done. Health education was given regarding importance of vector control measures.

UP/GHP/2021/41/0558	Uttar Pradesh	Ghazipur	Food Poisoning	12	00	18-09-21	Under Control	Case reported from Village /SC Bhikepur, Block Devkali. Cases presented with vomiting and loose stools. Samples were not collected. District RRT investigated the outbreak. There was history of fish consumption from a pond where there was carcass of an animal. Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water and properly cooked food.
UP/JHN/2021/41/0559	Uttar Pradesh	Jhansi	Leptospirosis	08	00	15-09-21	Under Control	Cases reported from Village Simraha, Block Badagaon, Harsari, Babina and Outside Unnao gate Urban Area, MLB Medical College, District Jhansi. Cases presented fever and bodyache. 18 blood samples were collected and sent to MLB Jhansi. Of these, one sample was found positive for Leptospirosis by IgM ELISA District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.
UP/KHI/2021/41/0560	Uttar Pradesh	Kaushambi	Acute Diarrheal Disease	10	00	27-09-21	Under Control	Cases reported from Village Fatehsah ka Purwa, CHC/NPHC Kada, District Kaushambi. Cases presented with loose stools. Three water and six stool samples collected and sent to Regional Sanchari Lab, Lucknow. Of these, two water samples were found unfit for drinking. Six stool samples did not show any growth. District RRT investigated the outbreak. The outbreak was due to contamination of drinking water due to multiple leakages in the pipeline. Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water and properly cooked food.
WB/NCP/2021/41/0561	West Bengal	North 24 Parganas	Cholera	1027	01	07-09-21	Under Control	Cases reported from Village Kamarhati Municipality/Ward No. 1 to 8, District North 24 Parganas. Cases presented with loose stools. Nine rectal swab samples and 23 water samples were collected and sent to NICED & Mangal Pandey Water Lab. Of these, six rectal swab samples were found positive for Vibrio cholerae and one was found positive for Shigella flexneri. Three water samples were found positive for Vibrio cholerae O1 Ogawa. District RRT investigated the outbreak. The deceased case was a 50 years old female. Symptomatic treatment was given to all the cases. Chlorine tablets were distributed. Health education was given regarding importance of safe drinking water and properly cooked food.
