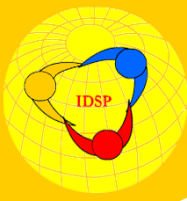

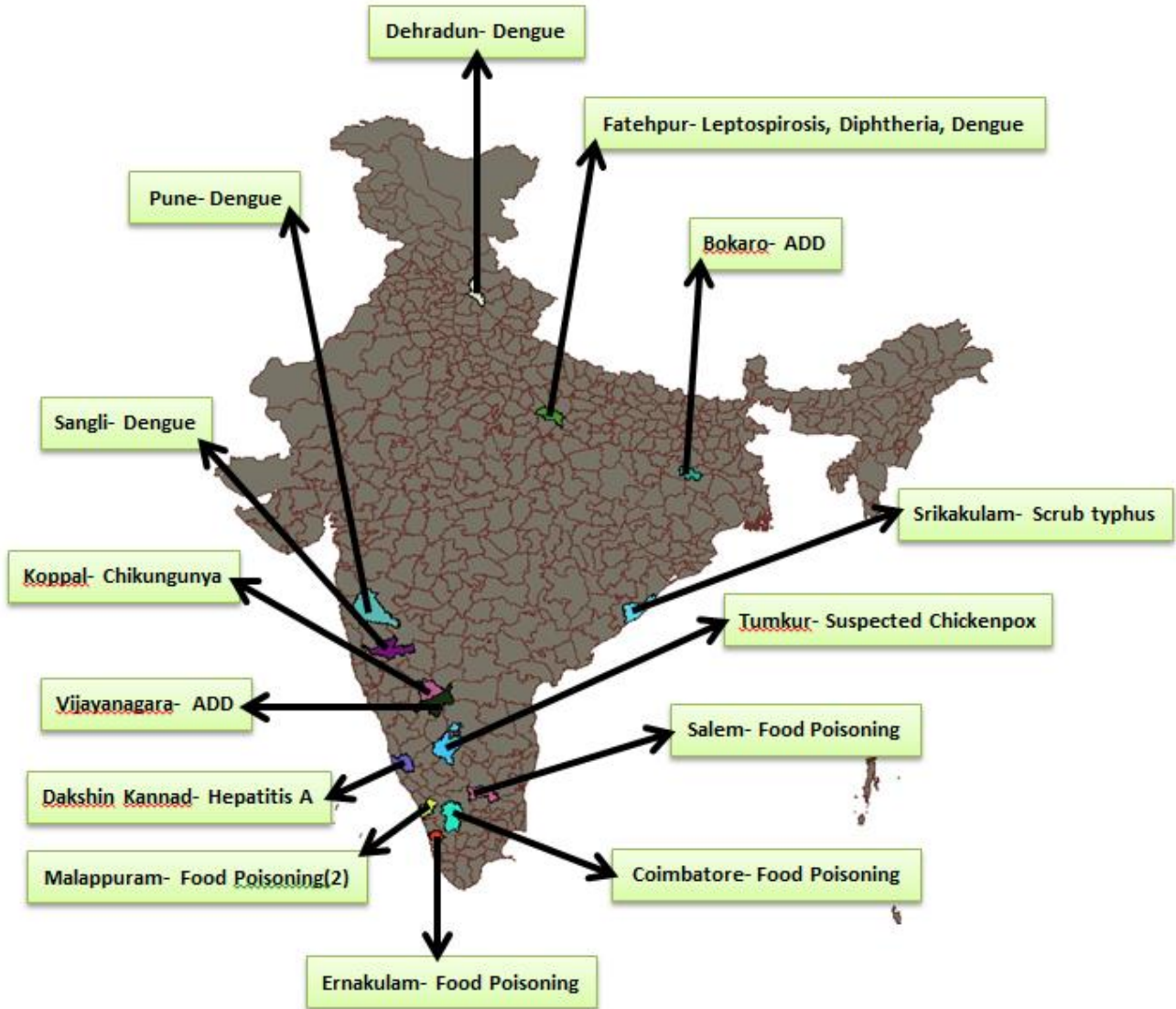

44th Week Map

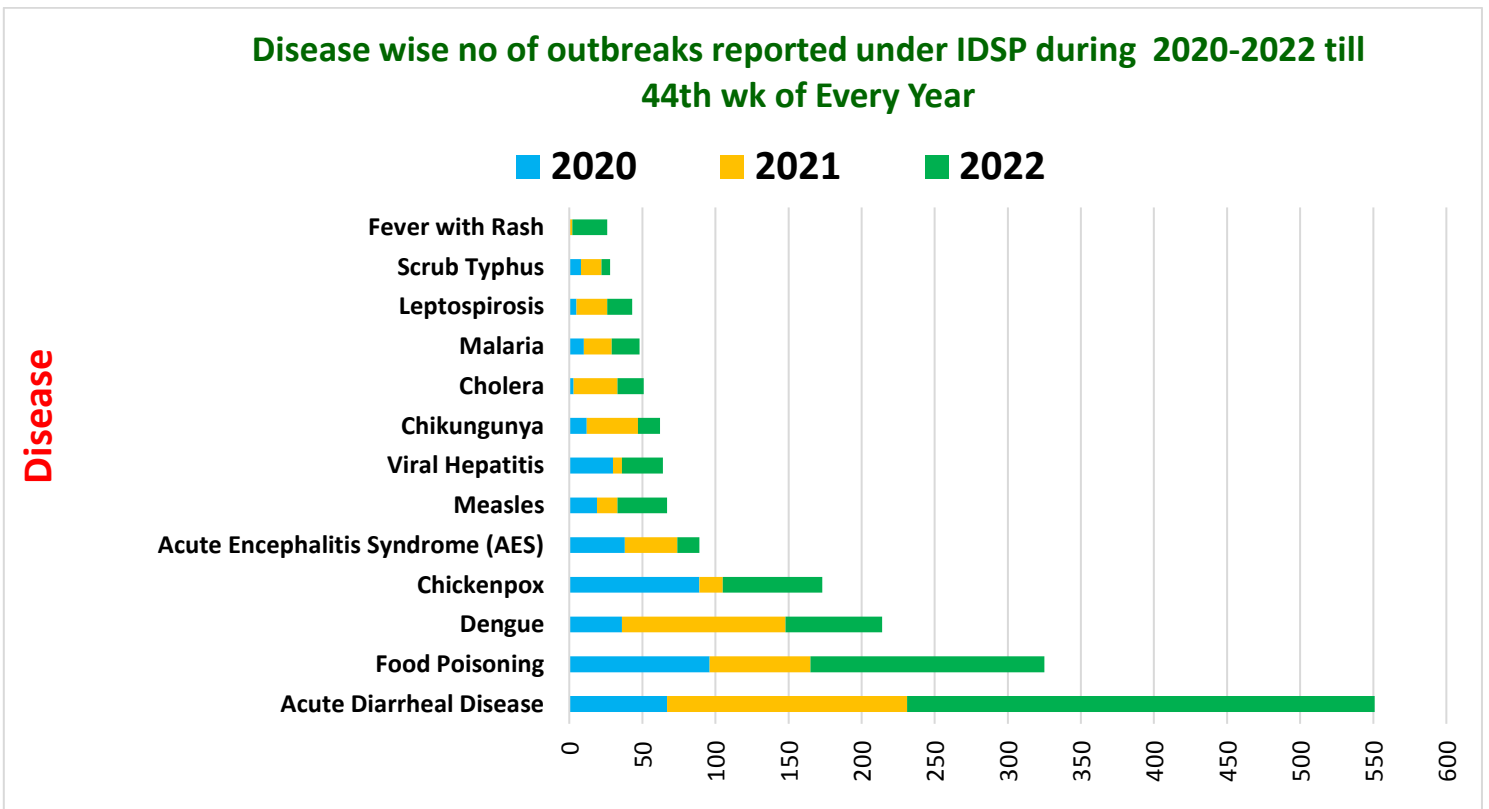
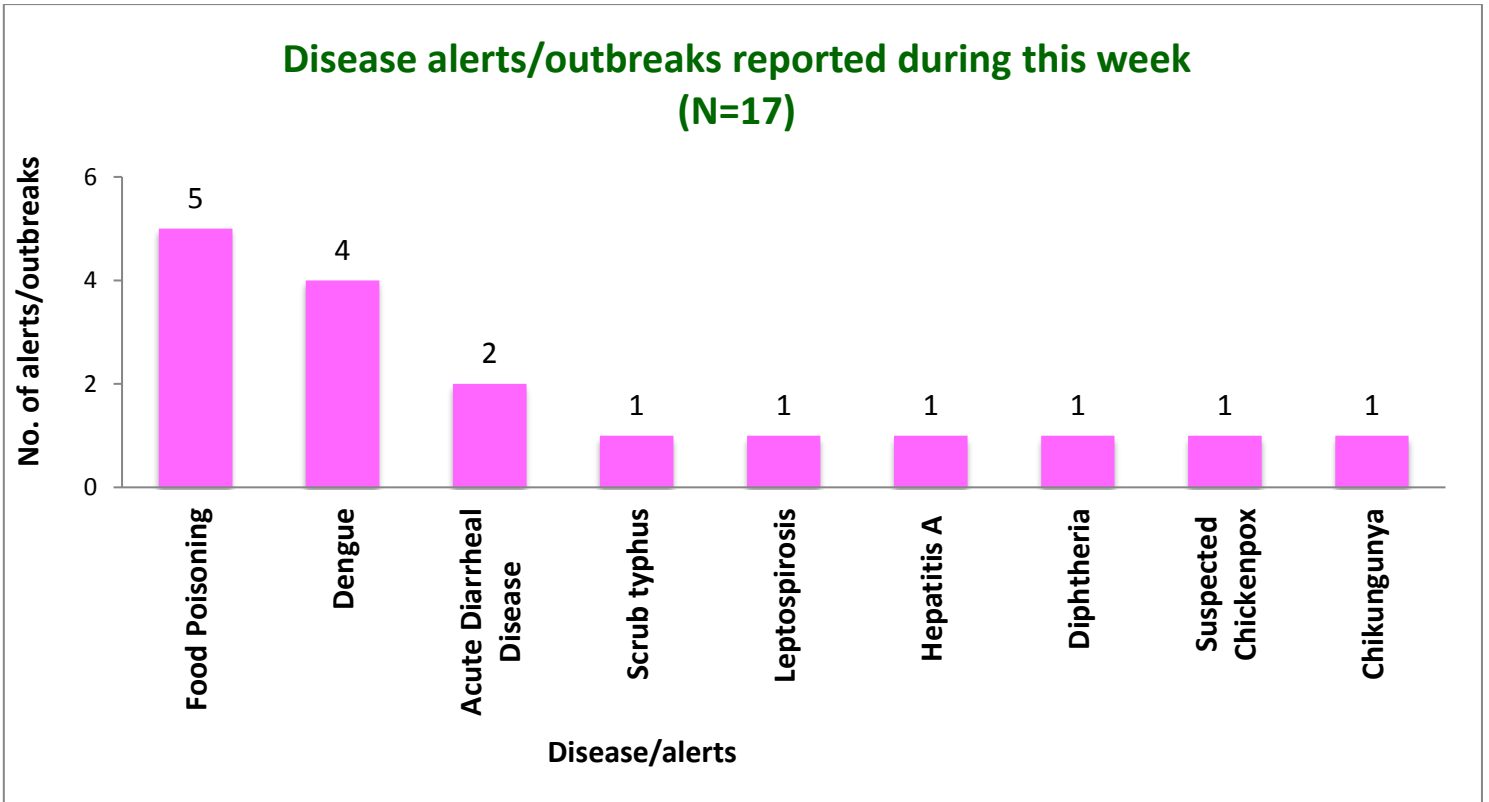

Cases presented with loose watery stools, vomiting and abdominal pain. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Cases were given symptomatic treatment. ORS sachets and zinc tablets were distributed. The deceased case was a 55 years old female. Health education was given on the importance of safe drinking water, food hygiene and sanitation.
KN/NGP/2022/44/859	Karnataka	Dakshin Kannad	Hepatitis A	10	00	03-11-22	03-11-22	Under Control	Cases reported from Village Montepadav, PHC Natekal, Taluk Mangalore, District Dakshina Kannada. Cases presented with fever, nausea, abdominal pain and yellowish discolouration of eyes. Six blood samples were sent to DPHL, Dakshin Kannada and all the six samples were found positive for Hepatitis A by IgM ELISA. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Open water sources were chlorinated. Health education was given on the importance of safe drinking water and sanitation.
KN/NGP/2022/44/860	Karnataka	Koppal	Chikungunya	45	00	01-11-22	06-11-22	Under Surveillance	Cases reported from Village Hydranagar, PHC/CHC Kavaloor, Taluk Koppal, District Koppal. Cases presented with fever and bodyache. Three blood samples were sent to VIMS Ballari. Of these, two samples were found positive for Chikungunya by IgM ELISA. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Daily surveillance activities were carried out for active search of cases. Health education was imparted regarding the importance of vector control measures.

KN/NGP/2022/44/861	Karnataka	Tumkur	Suspected Chickenpox	24	00	31-10-22	05-11-22	Under Surveillance	Cases reported from Village Melekotte, Hunasehalli, PHC/CHC Tavarekere, Taluk Sira, District Tumkur. Cases presented with fever and rashes. Two blood and three water samples were sent to DPHL Tumkur. Result awaited. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Cases were isolated. Frequent changes of bedding and personal belongings, adequate diet and plenty of fluids were emphasized upon. Vitamin A Prophylaxis was given. Health education was imparted regarding importance of personal hygiene.

Cases presented with loose watery stools, vomiting and abdominal pain. 24 water samples and one stool sample was sent for lab analysis. result awaited. District RRT investigated the outbreak. It was found that there was contamination of drinking water with sewage water pipeline. Cases were given symptomatic treatment. ORS sachets and zinc tablets were distributed. Health education was given on the importance of safe drinking water, food hygiene and sanitation.

Cases presented with abdominal pain, loose stools and vomiting. One stool sample was collected and sent to RPH Lab, Ernakulam. No enteropathogenic organism was isolated. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given on the importance of safe drinking water, food hygiene and sanitation.

KL/NGP/2022/44/864	Kerala	Malappuram	Food Poisoning	16	00	29-10-22	01-11-22	Under Surveillance	Cases reported from PHC Chelembra, Block Kondotty, District Malappuram. Cases presented with abdominal pain, loose stools and vomiting. One water and food sample was collected and sent for lab analysis. Colliforms were detected in water samples and no pathogenic organism was isolated in food sample. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given on the importance of safe drinking water, food hygiene and sanitation.
KL/NGP/2022/44/865	Kerala	Malappuram	Food Poisoning	70	00	29-10-22	01-11-22	Under Surveillance	Cases reported from PHC/Block Vengara, District Malappuram. Cases presented with abdominal pain, loose stools and vomiting. Two water samples were collected and sent for lab analysis. Colliforms were detected and hence, found not suitable for potable purpose. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given on the importance of safe drinking water, food hygiene and sanitation.
MH/NGP/2022/44/866	Maharashtra	Pune	Dengue	07	01	26-09-22	01-11-22	Under Control	Cases reported from Village Malegaon Bk, PHC- Malgaon Bk, Taluk- Baramati, District Pune. Cases presented with fever, bodyache and weakness. Seven blood samples were sent to NIV, Pune. Of these, four samples were found positive for Dengue by IgM ELISA. The deceased case was a 11 years old female. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Fever and container survey of the area and fogging was done. Breeding sources were eliminated by introducing Guppy fishes. Health education was given regarding the importance of vector control measures.

MH/NGP/2022/44/867	Maharashtra	Sangli	Dengue	36	01	29-10-22	31-10-22	Under Control	Cases reported from A/P Waddi Taluka, District Sangli. Cases presented with fever, bodyache and headache. 20 blood samples were sent for lab analysis to GMC, Miraj. Of these, nine samples were found positive for Dengue by IgM ELISA. The deceased case was 30 years old male. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Fever and container survey of the area was done. Indoor and outdoor fogging was done. Breeding sources were eliminated by introducing Guppy fishes and anti-larval activities were conducted like use of Temifos in stored water, un-used tyres and pits were discarded. Health education was given regarding the importance of vector control measures.
TN/NGP/2022/44/868	Tamil Nadu	Salem	Food Poisoning	29	00	04-11-22	05-11-22	Under Surveillance	Cases reported from Village Kamalapuram (John Britto Matric Hr Sec School), HSC Kamalapuram, PHC Vellalapatti, Block Sarakkapillaiyur, District Salem. Cases presented with vomiting and abdominal pain. Six food samples were collected and sent to Salem Food Lab. Result awaited. Two water samples were collected and sent to DPHL, Mettur and were found suitable for potable purpose. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given on the importance of safe drinking water, food hygiene and sanitation.
UP/NGP/2022/44/869	Uttar Pradesh	Fatehpur	Leptospirosis	01	00	03-11-22	04-11-22	Under Control	Cases reported from Village Chaudhrana, District Fatehpur. Case presented with fever and bodyache. One blood sample was sent to KGMU, Lucknow and was tested positive for Leptospirosis by IgM ELISA. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Door to door survey was done. Health education was given on the importance of rodent control measures.

Case presented with upper respiratory tract infection. One throat swab sample was sent to SNCH, Prayagraj and was found positive for Corynebacterium diphtheria. District RRT investigated the outbreak. The deceased case was a 5 years and 11 months old male. Health education was given regarding the importance of immunization.

Cases presented with fever and abdominal pain. Seven blood samples were sent to Regional lab SVIMS Tirupati. Of these, four samples were found to be positive for Scrub typhus by IgM ELISA. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Prophylactic treatment with Cap. Doxycycline was given to all the adults. Prophylactic treatment with Tab. Azithromycin was given to all children aged below 10 years, to pregnant women and lactating mothers. Health education was given. Door to door fever surveillance was done.

TN/NGP/2022/44/872	Tamil Nadu	Coimbatore	Food Poisoning	13	00	20-09-22	Under Control	Cases reported from Village Selakarachal, Subcentre Selakarachal, District Coimbatore. Cases presented with vomiting, headache and abdominal pain. Water samples were collected from four different sources and sent to Regional Water Testing Laboratory, Coimbatore. Result awaited. Food samples were sent to District Food Analysis Laboratory, Coimbatore and was found suitable for potable purpose. 13 blood samples were sent for lab analysis. Result awaited. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given on the importance of safe drinking water, food hygiene and sanitation.
UP/NGP/2022/44/873	Uttar Pradesh	Fatehpur	Dengue	06	01	29-10-22	Under Control	Cases reported from Village Galatha, PS Aung Block-Deomai. Cases presented with fever and body ache. Five blood samples were sent to LLR Hospital for lab analysis. Of these, one sample was found positive for Dengue by IgM ELISA. District RRT investigated the outbreak. The deceased case was a 30 years old male. Fever and container survey of the area was done. Indoor and outdoor fogging was done. Breeding sources were eliminated and anti-larval activities were conducted. Health education was given regarding the importance of vector control measures.
UK/NGP/2022/44/874	Uttarakhand	Dehradun	Dengue	24	00	13-10-22	Under Surveillance	Cases reported from Dhakrani, Block Vikasnagar, District Dehradun. Cases presented with fever, headache and bodyache. Two water and seven blood samples were sent to DPHL Coronation District Hospital Dehradun. Result awaited. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Daily surveillance activities were carried out for active search of cases. Health education was imparted regarding the importance of vector control measures.
