







KN/BLE/2022/48/938	Karnataka	Ballari	Rabies	02	02	28-11-22	28-11-22	Under Surveillance	Cases reported from Village Badanahatti, CHC Kurugodu, Taluk Ballari, District Ballari. Both cases developed typical symptoms of rabies like dysphagia, hydrophobia, aerophobia, hyper salivation, hyper activity, seizures and insomnia within 10 to 15 days after dog bite. Two suspected Rabies death occurred in a 7 Y/M and 3 Y/F at Indira Nagara and S.T Street respectively in Badanahatti village. According to public and parents, bite was unprovoked and both cases had category III wounds. 7 Y/M has not received any anti rabies vaccine due to negligence and superstitious belief though they were advised to get rabies vaccine. 3 Y/F had received 04 doses of anti-rabies vaccine (ID route). The witnesses felt that dog appeared to be mad, had aggressive behavior with hyper salivation. On 1st Nov 2022 dog has been killed by public. District and Taluka RR Team visited and conducted Surveillance activities in the village. THO, MO and CHO were instructed to conduct the survey to find any other suspected Rabies dog bite cases, to conduct IEC activities for the villagers about Rabies disease, wound management and importance of ARV in any Animal bite conditions. Grama Panchayath and Veterinary department conducted the necessary rabies preventive and control measures especially dog restraining activities.

Two stool and Eight water samples collected and sent to PHI Bengaluru, where stool samples tested negative for Vibrio Cholerae and all water samples were found to be not suitable for potable purposes. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.

One serum sample sent to SIMS, Shivamogga which tested positive for JE by IgM ELISA. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.

Cases had fever on and off for two weeks and had history of head ache, convulsion and weakness. Ten Blood samples collected and sent to KIMS Hubli, where four tested positive for JE by IgM ELISA. The deceased was a 7 year female child. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.

Three water samples sent to DPHL Koppal were found suitable for potable purposes. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given regarding drinking of boiled and cooled water, consumption of hot cooked food, proper hand washing after defecation. Symptomatic treatment was given.

The incident occurred at Patel Nursing College, where 90 students staying in ladies PG Hostel had taken food prepared in mess and 15 developed symptoms. Two water samples sent to DPHL Ramanagara and were found fit for consumption. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.

Four vomitus, Three water and Three blood samples sent to DPHL Tumkur. Vomitus and blood samples showed no growth, whereas all water samples were found not potable. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given. Symptomatic treatment was given.

Seven samples collected and sent to PH Lab Thrissur where it tested NS1 positive by ELISA. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.

District RRT investigated the outbreak. House to house survey done around the villages for fever with rash identification in affected area. Public health measures such as samples being taken of suspected, isolation of cases done. Analysis done for vaccination status up to 5 year children and vitamin A were given to suspected child.

DISEASE OUTBREAKS OF PREVIOUS WEEKS REPORTED LATE Cases reported by ANM of Ward 79 and Uttarasi village, block -Depalpur, Zone Malharganj to District Surveillance Unit (DSU), Indore. 50 patients presented with Fever & Joint Pain since last 2-3 days. Blood samples of 46 cases sent to MGM Medical College and 4 to DPHL Lab, Indore and through ELISA test, out of which five samples came positive for dengue. Public health measures taken were-Rapid survey of the site for the symptomatic cases, IEC at affected area and Madhva Under education of community on the risks of mosquito-borne 05 00 19/11/2022 MP/INR/2022/48/955 Indore **Dengue Pradesh** Control diseases, using of personal household protection measures, such as window screens, repellents, coils and vaporizers, covering, emptying and cleaning of domestic water storage containers on a weekly basis, water collection sites were also checked and anti-larval measures were taken in the form of abating using Temephos and Anti-adult measures were taken in the form of fogging using Pyrethrum spray. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given. Cases reported from MBI Brick Kiln area of Bejimara GP under Dhanpur PHC of Sepahijala District with vomiting and diarrhea. One child reported dead, Prince Asur, S/o Laleswar Acute asur, 3 years/Male. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Under 09 01 17/11/2022 **Tripura** Sepahijala Diarrheal TR/SPH/2022/48/956 Health Camp was organized by respective PHC (Dhanpur) Control Disease and distribution of medicines. ORSs and Zinc tablets was done. Health education on hand washing and water purification at household level was imparted. Cases reported from Mathiya tola and Hathi Madari in urban Mau with symptoms of fever and bodyache. Seven samples Uttar Under tested positive for dengue by IgM ELISA.
