



49<sup>th</sup> Week Map






AS/DBG/2020/49/497	Assam	Dibrugarh	Food Poisoning	03	03	30-11-20	04-12-20	Under Surveillance	Cases were reported from Village Kalyanpur Gaon, 2 No Chapatoli, SC Bhadoi, PHC/Block Tengakhat. All patients developed symptoms of fever, abdominal pain and vomiting. All three cases expired. They had history of consuming roti with chicken curry and chulai on 29.11.2020. It was found that two empty insecticide containers were used to carry chulai. Local police recovered both the containers which were still half filled from the nearby tea plantation area. District RRT investigated the outbreak.
CH/CHD/2020/49/498	Chandigarh	Chandigarh	Dengue	13	00	07-12-20	09-12-20	Under Surveillance	Cases were reported from Manimajra, Ramdarbar, Dhanas, Sec-30, Sec-40, Sec-26, Sec-25, Sec-7, DMC, Maulijagran. All the cases were tested positive by IgM ELISA and were treated. Intensification of Anti Larval work was done in these areas. Anti-Adult mosquito measure augmentation was being done. IEC activities regarding dengue prevention measures were being carried out in the form of Mega phone announcements, Hand bill distribution etc. The Anti Dengue activities had been clubbed along with COVID-19 related IEC activities in the area. Health education was given.

MH/AKL/2020/49/499	Maharashtra	Akola	Suspected Dengue	40	00	02-12-20	03-12-20	Under Surveillance	Cases were reported from Barshitakli, Pinjar Januna Nihida. 24 blood samples were taken and all were found negative for malaria for peripheral blood smears. 16 serum samples were collected and sent to GMC Microbiology laboratory Akola and 15 were negative and 1 positive for Dengue (IgM), 56 samples were taken for Covid RT-PCR and all tested negative. Surveillance activity was performed. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Preventive measures were carried out that included emptying containers, clearing drainage system, temifos activity and health education. Wide spread control measures were undertaken and along with public awareness IEC activities were conducted
MH/STA/2020/49/500	Maharashtra	Satara	Chikungunya	07	00	24-11-20	03-12-20	Under Control	Cases reported from Village Dhangarwadi, SC Kodoli, PHC Chinchner, Block Satara. District RRT investigated the outbreak. MIDC Areas, Uncovered water storing practices leading to increased density of mosquito larva. 05 serum samples were collected and sent to NIV Pune, result positive. HI=15.48, CI: 4.59, BI:18.64. 10 serum samples were sent to NIV, Pune on 25.11.2020. Out of which all 5 tested positive for Chikungunya, House to house container survey was carried out. Fogging was not done but advised. People were promoted to use protective measures against mosquito bites. Health education was given.

Any carrier or low symptomatic of chickenpox might have been the probable cause of this spread. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education regarding hygiene and sanitization was given. Awareness regarding prevention of diseases in jail was imparted.

Uncovered water storing practices leading to increased density of mosquito larva. 12 serum samples were collected and sent to Civil Lab, out of which 3 were positive for Dengue by IgM ELISA House to house survey was done.
