


(Food sample was not available for testing). Treatment of cases done at Amala Medical College. Chlorination of water source done. Control measures and preventive taken. Chlorination of water source done. Health education imparted among the affected people.

Health education given regarding food sanitation.

Paramedical staff deputed to the affected area for daily active surveillance. 5 sera samples tested IgM positive for Chikungunya at IIPM, Hyderabad. Antilarval measures, Pyrethrum spray and fogging activities undertaken. IEC activities undertaken regarding early treatment of cases and personal protection measures to be adopted by the community.	
2.	Karnataka	Hassan	x. Measles	8/0	09.01.11	Under surveillance	Cases with fever and rash reported from Village Dinka, PHC Dammaningala, Taluka Shravanabelagula. District RRT visited the affected area and investigated the outbreak. Out of 2 sera samples collected, 1 found positive for IgM Measles. Vitamin-A supplementation given to all susceptible children in the affected village. IEC activities undertaken regarding providing proper nutrition and early treatment of cases.	
3.	Rajasthan	Bikaner	xi. Malaria	296 / 2	28.08.10	Under control	Cases of fever confirmed as malaria, occurred at PHC Jamsar, Block Bikaner since August 2010, but were reported to CSU on 25.1.2011. Out of 3762 blood slides collected and examined so far, 285 found positive for <i>P. vivax</i> and 11 positive for <i>P. falciparum</i> . PHC medical team visited the affected area and treated cases. The probable cause for the outbreak could be water logging and high density mosquito breeding in the area along with lack of awareness about malaria control among the villagers. Active surveillance done by house to house visit. Mass fever survey and entomological surveillance done. DDT spray done and IEC activities undertaken regarding personal protection measures for prevention of malaria.	
4.	West Bengal	Paschim Medinipur	xii. Chicken pox	25 / 0	04.01.11	Under surveillance	Cases of fever and typical rash clinically diagnosed as Chicken pox reported from Ward No. 21, Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya. District RRT with medical team visited the affected area. IEC activities undertaken regarding isolation and early treatment of cases.
