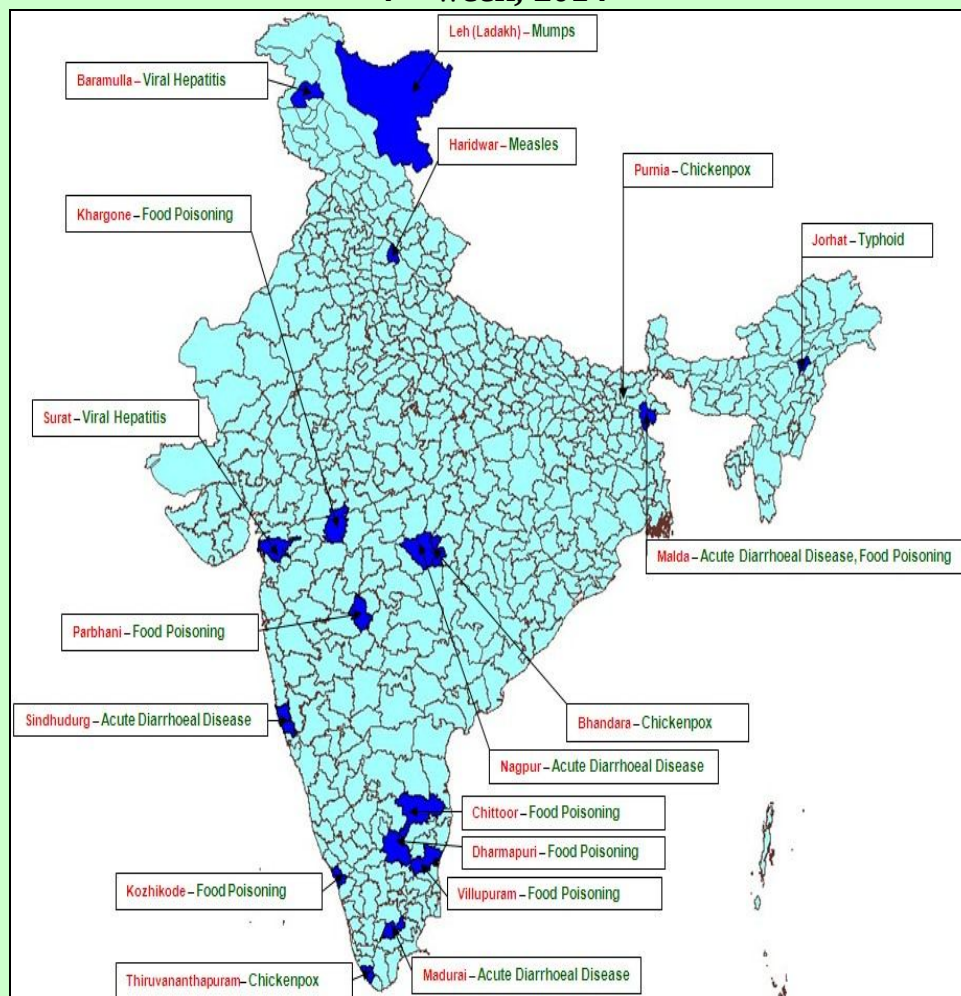


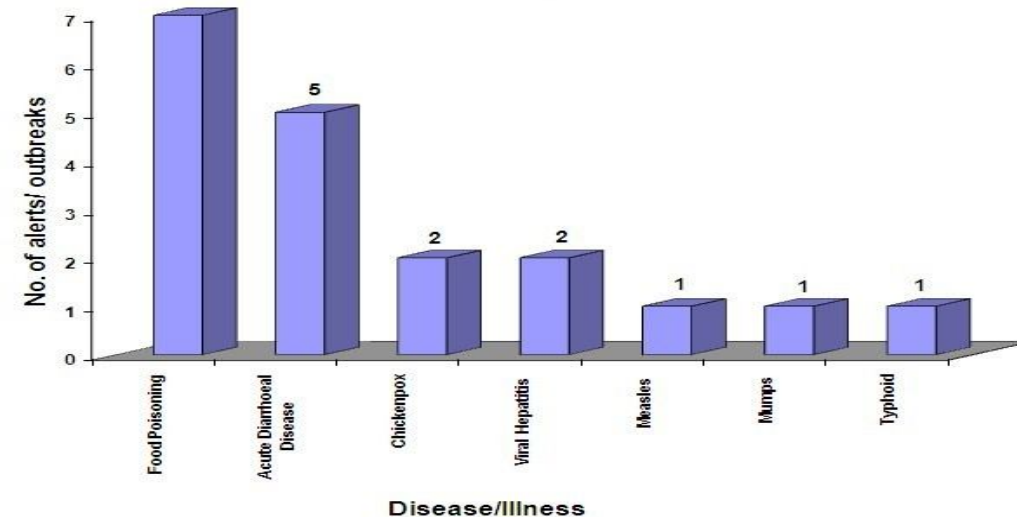

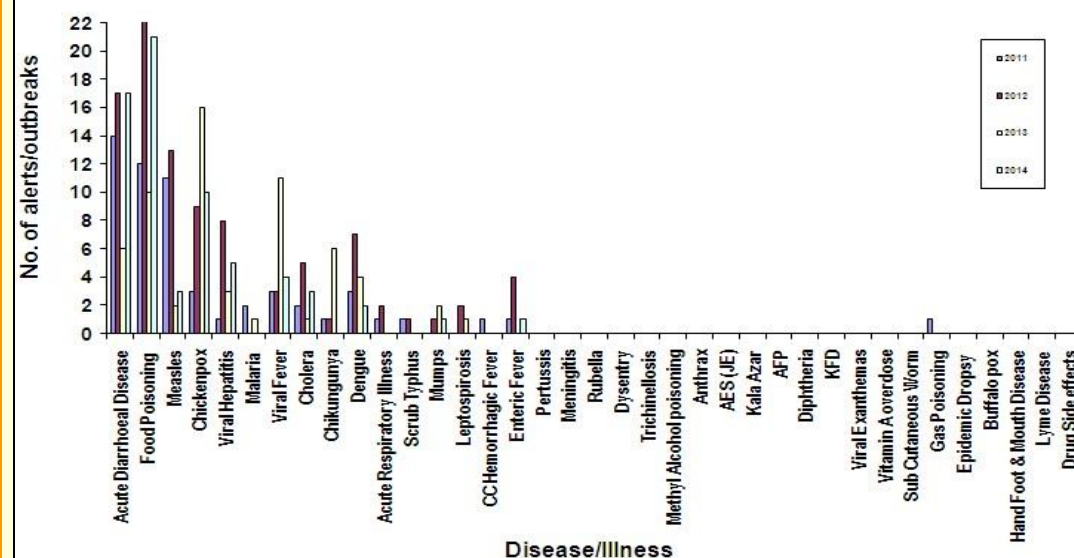
District wise disease alerts/outbreaks reported in the 4th week, 2014
