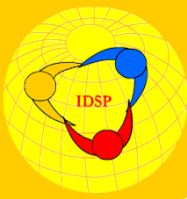

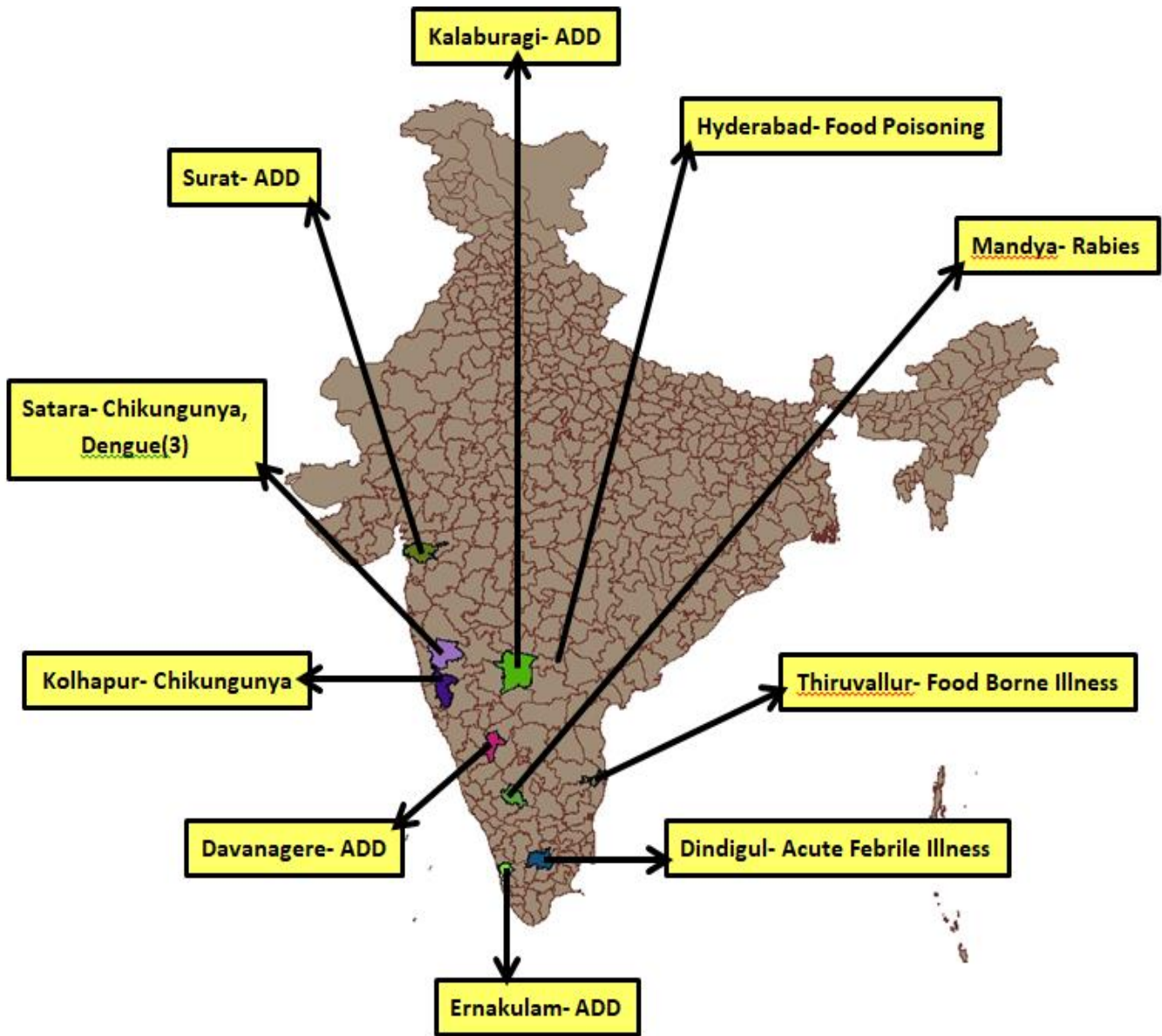

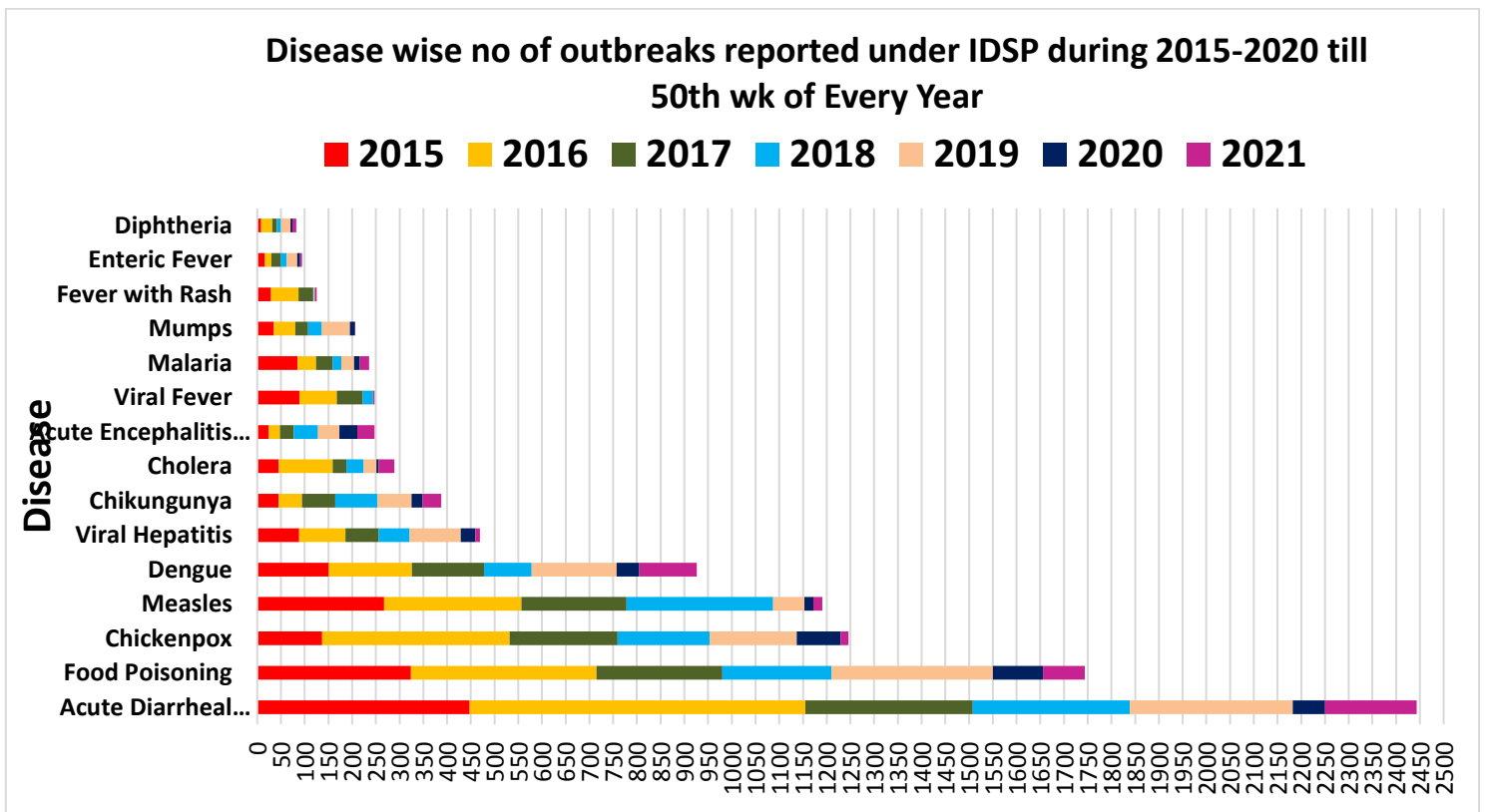

He was immediately sent to MIMS, Mandya on referral from PHC and then further referred to ED Hospital, Mysore. Patient was on treatment and later expired. The deceased was a male child. Inj. ARV was given to all family members. District RRT investigated the case. PHC was instructed to co-ordinate with Animal Husbandry regarding animal birth control measures and vaccination of all stray dogs in the village. Health education was given.

District RRT investigated the case. 10 blood samples were collected and sent to DPHL Satara. All 10 samples were found positive for Chikungunya by IgM ELISA. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Anti-larval spray was used and fogging done. Health education was given regarding importance of vector control measures.

District RRT investigated the outbreak. Anti-larval spray was used and fogging done. Health education was given regarding importance of vector control measures.

Three blood samples were collected and sent to DPHL Satara. Of these, three out of samples are found positive for Dengue by IgM ELISA. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Anti-larval spray was used and fogging done. Health education was given regarding importance of vector control measures.

Anti-larval spray was used and fogging done. Health education was given regarding importance of vector control measures.
