





51st Week Map






The case was a 44-year-old male who presented with fever, headache and body ache, he took medicine from a local pharmacy but his condition deteriorated and he was admitted to a private nursing home and then referred to the Government hospital where he expired on the same day. Seven serum samples sent to DPHL, IDSP, Nagaon, out of which one sample was found positive for Leptospirosis by IgM ELISA. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.
AS/NGO/2021/51/0715	Assam	Nagaon	Dengue	01	00	20-12-21	22-12-21	Under Surveillance	Case reported from Village Katonigaon, PHC Singia Putoni MPHC, BPHC Kathiatoli, District Nagaon. Case presented with cough, fever, body ache, vomiting, stomach pain for which she took medicine from a local pharmacy but her symptoms worsened for which she was admitted to Gauhati Medical College and Hospital where she recovered and was discharged on the fifth day. Two serum samples were sent to DPHL, IDSP, Nagaon for further lab investigation, out of which one sample was found to be positive for Dengue by IgM ELISA. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given and fogging was done in the area.
JH/GDA/2021/51/0716	Jharkhand	Godda	Fever with Rashes	02	00	24-12-21	25-12-21	Under Control	Cases reported from Village Ratanpur, SC Tarwara, PHC/Block Sadarprakhand, District Godda. The cases presented with maculopapular rashes all over their body. Two blood and One nasopharyngeal swab sample were sent to RIMS, Ranchi for further lab analysis, the samples were found to be negative for Measles by IgM ELISA. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given. Vitamin A was given to the cases.

The cases presented with maculopapular rashes all over their body. Blood and Throat swab samples were sent to RIMS Microbiology Lab, Ranchi for further lab analysis, the samples were found to be negative for Measles by IgM ELISA. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.
MH/KOP/2021/51/0718	Maharashtra	Kolhapur	Acute Diarrheal Disease	12	01	20-12-21	22-12-21	Under Surveillance	Cases reported from AP/PHC Abdullat, SC Alat, Taluk Shirol, District Kolhapur. The cases belonged to the sugar cane tribe working in a field where the water source got contaminated. Some of the cases were admitted at IGM hospital for mild dehydration. The deceased was a 2-year-old male. Two water samples were sent to RH Shirol and RH Solankur for further lab analysis, the result is awaited. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.
TN/VIL/2021/51/0719	Tamil Nadu	Kallakurichi	Acute Diarrheal Disease	19	00	20-12-21	20-12-21	Under Surveillance	Cases reported from Village/HSC Vadamamanthur, PHC Seerpanandal, Block Rishivandiyam, District Kallakurichi. The cases presented with vomiting and diarrhea. The most affected age group was above 46 years of age. Contamination of the main water source was the reason of the outbreak. Four water samples were sent to DPHL, Kallakurichi for further lab analysis, the result is awaited. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given. Inspection and chlorination of the water source was done.
TN/TPL/2021/51/0720	Tamil Nadu	Tiruchirappalli	Fever	16	00	20-12-21	21-12-21	Under Control	Cases reported from Village Visuvambal Samuthiram (North), PHC B. Mettur, HSC Balakrishnampatty, Block Uppiliyapuram, District Tiruchirappalli. The cases presented with fever and rashes. The most common affected age group were children between 5-10 years of age. 11 Serum samples and 11 Nasopharyngeal swab samples were sent to SPHL, Chennai for further lab analysis, the samples did not test positive for anything significants. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given and the cases were isolated to prevent further spread.

TL/NLN/2021/51/0721	Telangana	Nalgonda	Dengue	08	00	20-12-21	23-12-21	Under Control	Cases reported from Khajira, Maram, Thipparthy, District Nalgonda. The cases presented with fever. 30 Samples were sent for further lab analysis, out of which eight samples were found to be positive for Dengue by IgM ELISA. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given. Fogging was done in the affected area and anti-larval measures were undertaken.
UP/FAT/2021/51/0722	Uttar Pradesh	Fatehpur	Jatropha Poisoning	35	00	20-12-21	21-12-21	Under Control	CaseS reported from Village Mandraon Fatehpur, PHC Khajuha, District Fatehpur. The cases presented with vomiting and most of the affected cases were children. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.

The cases presented with vomiting and diarrhea. Most of the affected age group were >14 years of age. Four water samples were sent to DPHL, Thiruvallur for further lab analysis, out of which all the water samples were found to be fit for drinking purpose. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given. Chlorinated water was distributed in the affected area.		
UP/PBT/2021/51/0724	Uttar Pradesh	Pilibhit	Chickenpox	29	00	10-12-21	Under Control	Case reported from Village Kishni, Block Bisalpur, District Pilibhit. Cases presented with fever and maculopapular rash. The diagnosis was made clinically. Most of the affected were children under 10 years of age. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given and all the cases were isolated at home to contain the spread.
