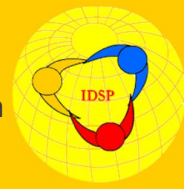
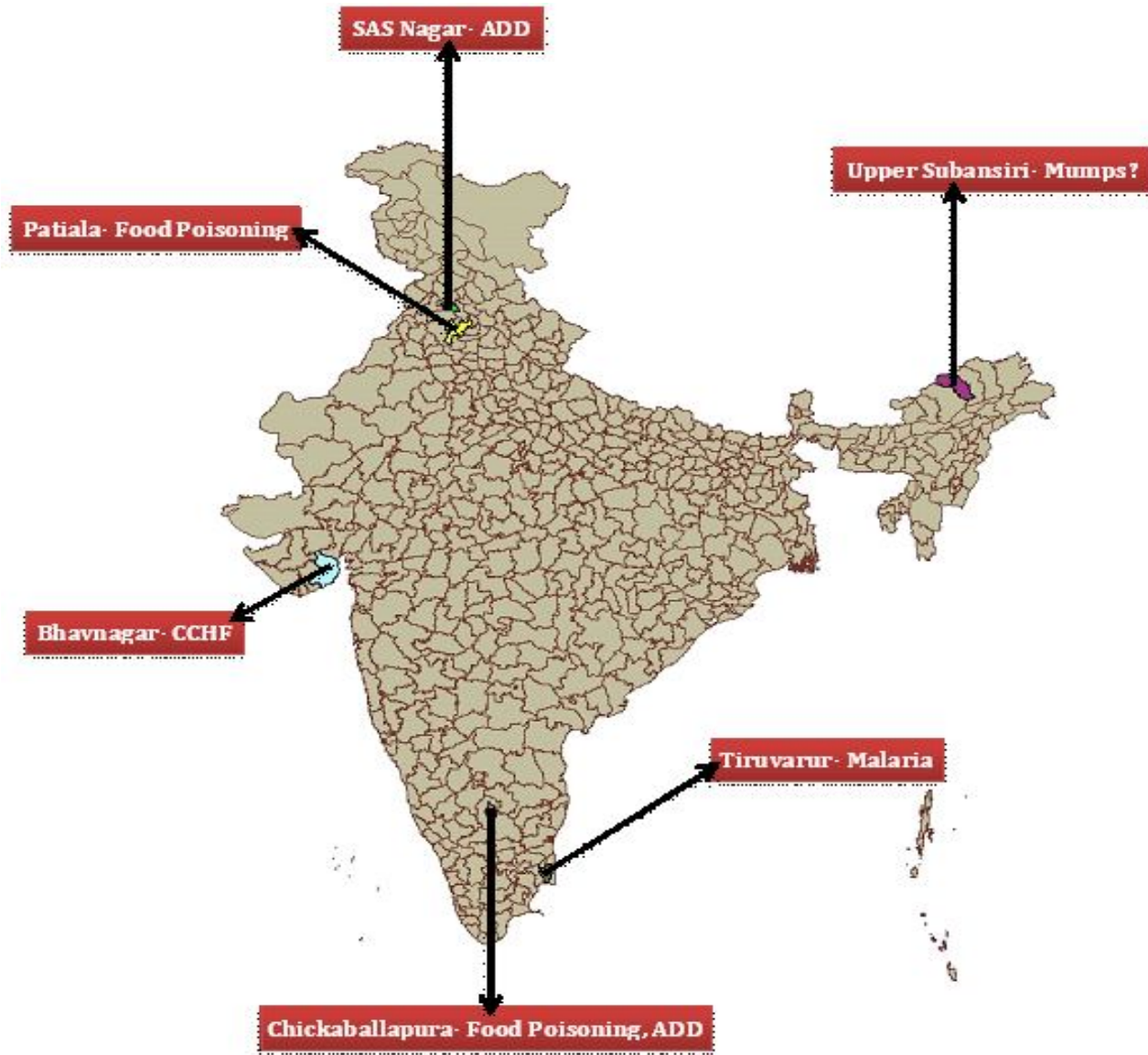

 52nd Week Map

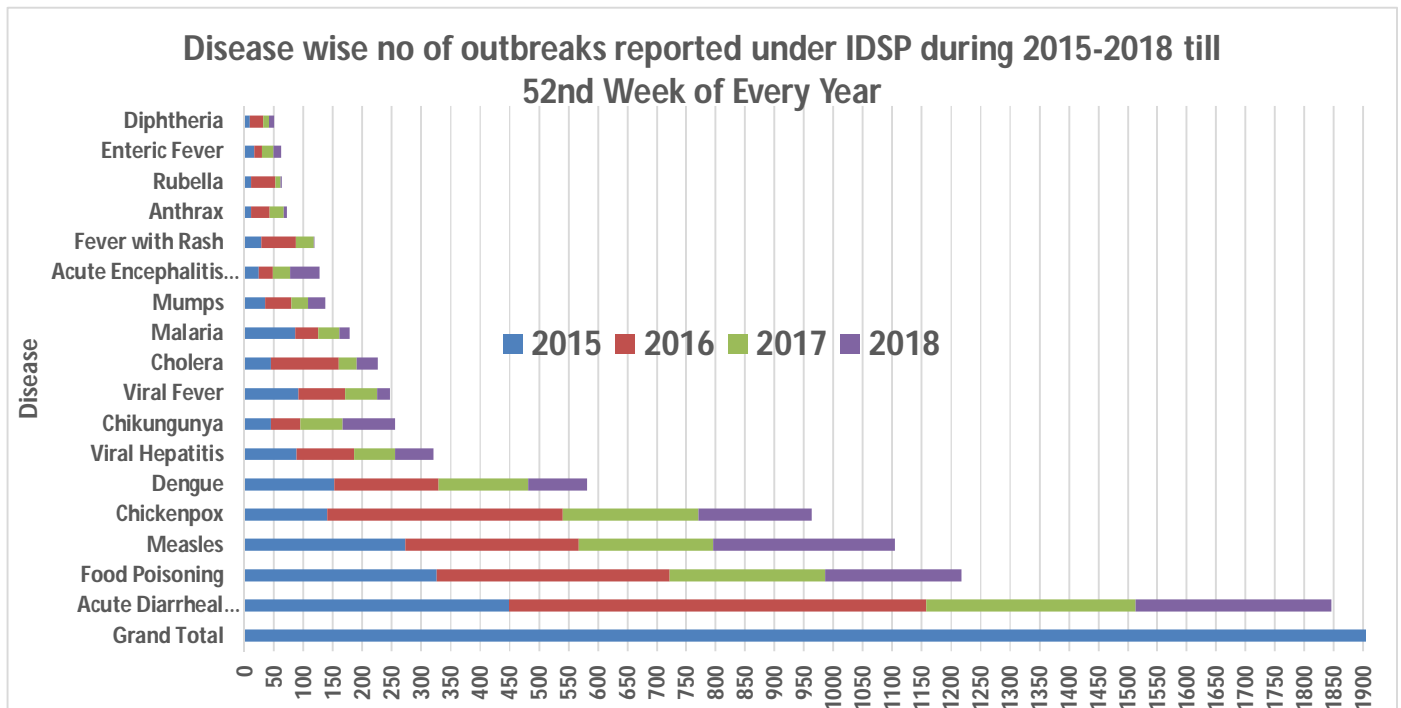
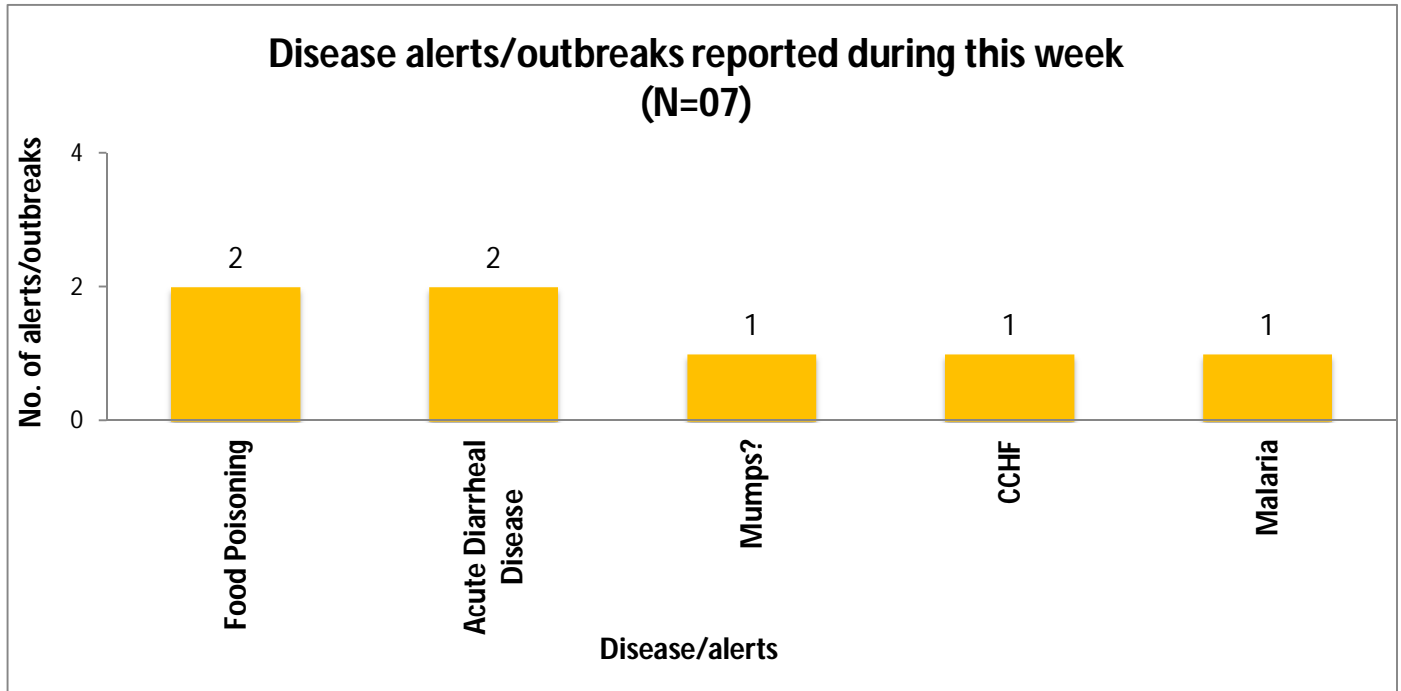

District RRT investigated the outbreak. House to house survey done. A farmer by occupation was admitted in Civil Hospital, Ahmendabad on 22nd December 2018. 1 serum sample collected and sent to NIV Pune was positive for CCHF (IgM ELISA). Out of 57 contacts (19 close contacts and 38 health care providers) serum samples were collected and sent to NUIV, Pune; were negative for CCHF (IgM ELISA). Animal Husbandry Dept collected 10 tick samples and 10 animal serum samples and sent to NIV, Pune; result awaited. Anti-tick measures (Liq delta force) spraying done in the affected area. Indoor spraying (Malathion) done in the affected area. Health education given regarding personal protection. |

Medical Camp organized and cases were treated symptomatically. ORS packets were distributed in the affected area. Chlorination of water sources done. Health education regarding personal hygiene and sanitation given. |

District RRT investigated the outbreak. House to house survey done. Pipeline leakages were observed in the community. 04 water samples collected, result awaited. ORS packets and chlorine tab were distributed. Health education given regarding personal hygiene and sanitation. |
| TN/TVR/2018/52/1607 | Tamil Nadu | Tiruvarur | Malaria | 31 | 00 | 25-12-18 | 30-12-18 | Under Surveillance | Cases reported from Village Sembadavankadu, Pettai, SC Sembadavankadu. PHC/Block Muthupettai. District RRT investigated the outbreak. House to house fever survey done. Out of 28 blood samples collected, 17 samples were positive for PV & 1 sample positive for PF& PV. Fogging done, anti-larval measures and indoor residual spraying done. All cases treated symptomatically. Health education given. |
