



Thirteen and Two blood samples collected and sent to DPHL Chikkaballapura, which tested negative for Dengue IgM ELISA. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given regarding use of mosquito repellants & use of safe drinking water. Fever & larva survey was done by health workers. Health check-up was done to all school children by the Sadli PHC Medical officer. Adviced for source reduction & larvae surveillance activities. Instructed to Gram Panchayath to take up fogging activity & maintain sanitation of the village.

Three water samples collected and sent to DSL Shivamogga, where one sample found to be unsatisfactory for consumption by H2S method. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.

Four water and Twenty five serum samples collected and sent to DPHL Tumkur, where two water samples were found to be non- potable and all serum samples tested negative for any pathogenic organism. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.
KN/TUM/2022/52/1022	Karnataka	Tumkur	Chickenpox	12	00	25-12-22	29-12-22	Under Surveillance	Cases reported from Village Kote Beedi, SC Koratagere C, PHC/CHC Vadagere, Taluk Koratagere, District Tumkur with fever and rashes. Two blood samples collcted and sent to BMCRI which tested positive for chickenpox by IgM ELISA, and two water samples sent to DPHL Tumkur where both found non potable by MPN test. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given. Routine contact survey carried out in the affected area. Isolation of active cases. IEC activities regarding the disease & personal hygiene is given to all students and community.

Two water sample collected and sent to Regional public health lab Ernakulam, where both samples showed no growth of coliforms and were sterile. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.

Stool samples collected and sent to Public Health Laboratory, Kozhenchery and State Public Lab, where samples were found PCR negative for viral gastroenteritis and culture, negative for pathogens. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given.
MH/KOP/2022/52/1025	Maharashtra	Kolhapur	Acute Diarrheal Disease	44	2	28-12-2021	28-12-2021	Under Control	Cases reported from PO- Shindewadi, SC- Satave, PHC-Borpadale, Tal- Panhala, Dist- Kolhapur with symptoms of nausea, vomiting & loose motion etc. 11 water samples and three stool samples were collected and were sent to DPHL, out of 11 water samples 10 samples were contaminated whereas no organism growth was detected in stool culture. Two deceased were Ku. Ritu Suresh Pawra, 04yrs. Female and Mrs. Rajeshri Rajesh Pawar, 50yrs female. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given. Active identification and control of source of infection carried out. Valve leakages were repaired, Medichlor distribution to all the houses, house to house survey and chlorination of water samples carried out. Symptomatic and prophylactic treatment of cases and suspects done.

Seven Stool and seven water samples were sent for investigation where they showed absence of Salmonell, Shigella, Vibrio cholera and pathogenic Escherichia coli. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Health education was given. Advised to chlorinate the drinking water. The entire area kept under surveillance by Health staff.
