

53rd Week Map






Health Education was given regarding fogging and abating measures. The deceased was a 55 year old female.

The cases presented with fever, headache and muscle pain. On RDK testing, 87 samples tested for Leptospirosis, 133 for Dengue, 121 for Malaria; out of which 05 Leptospirosis positive, 25 NS-1, 10-IGg, 5-IG M-Dengue, 3-PF Malaria, 01 mix Malaria positive. District RRT investigated the outbreak. Rapid fever survey done. Doxycycline chemoprophylaxis was given.
