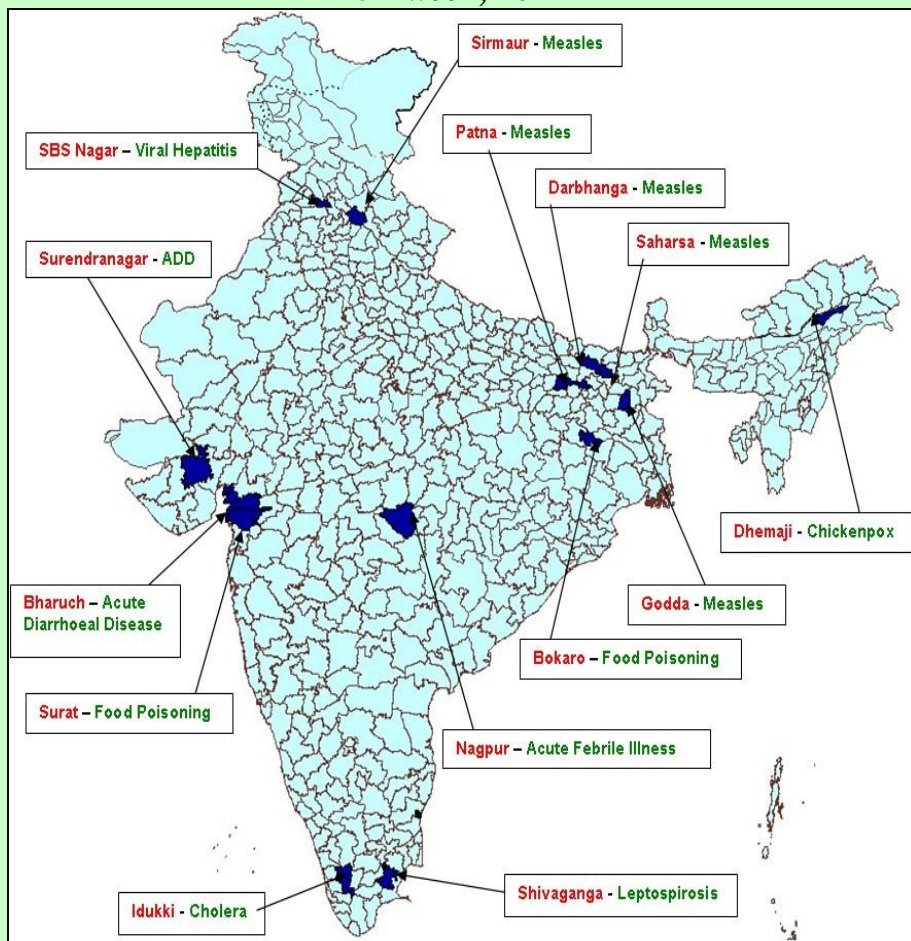


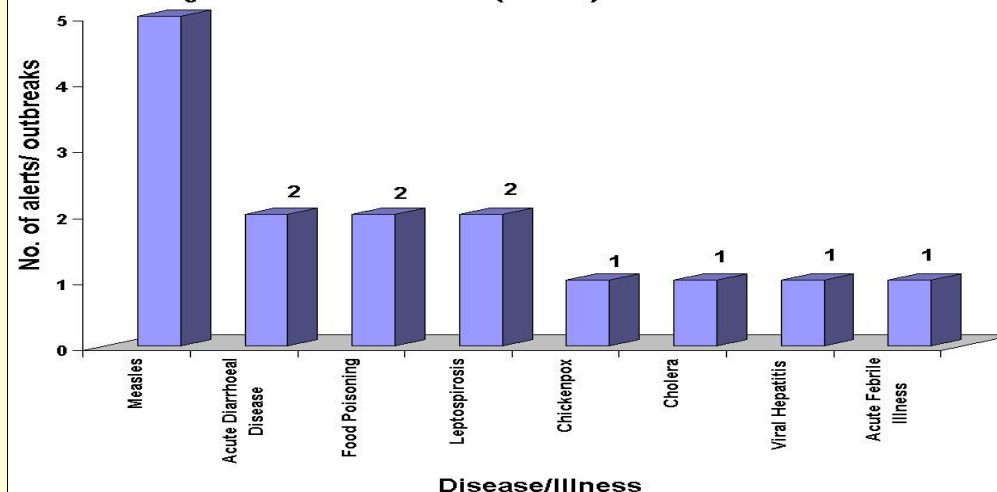

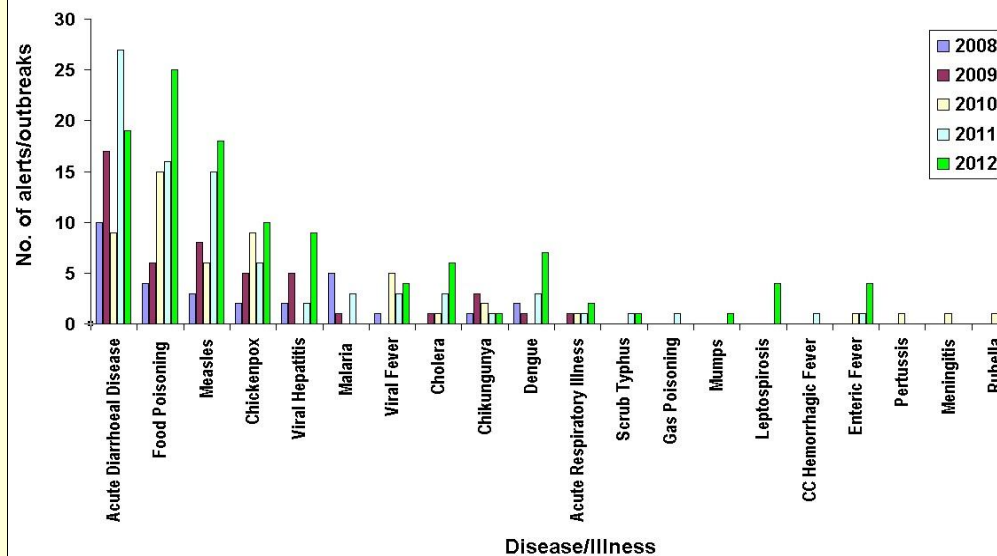
District wise disease alerts/outbreaks reported in the 5th week, 2012

Health education given regarding isolation and early treatment of cases.

Gujarat	Bharuch	ii Acute Diarrhoeal Disease	88	0	05/02/12	05/02/12	Under surveillance	Cases with vomiting, abdominal pain and dehydration reported from Village/SC Vorasamni, PHC Pakhajan, Block Vagra. Medical camp organized by Medical Officer to treat cases. 2 water samples collected and sent to WASMO, Bharuch. Symptomatic treatment given to all cases. Patients with severe dehydration admitted in CHC Vagra for treatment. Active house to house survey done to find new cases. Chlorination of wells and water tanks done by health staff. Health education given regarding hygiene and sanitation.
		Surat	iii Food Poisoning	14	0	27/01/12	30/01/12	Under surveillance	Cases with symptoms of diarrhoea and vomiting reported from Village/Sub-center Tatithayaa, PHC Gangadhara, Block Palsana due to consumption of contaminated food at a common gathering. All the cases occurred in the same residential complex. PHC Medical team visited the affected area, treated cases and investigated the outbreak. Food samples not available for lab analysis. Health education given regarding food sanitation.
3.	Himachal Pradesh	Sirmaur	iv Measles	9	0	04/02/12	04/02/12	Under control	Cases with fever and rash reported from Village Shillru, SC Dudam, Rajgarh, Block Pachhad. All cases were given Vitamin-A solution and symptomatic treatment. Additional dose of measles vaccination given to children below 12 year of age. Out of 9 serum samples collected and sent to NCDC, Delhi, 3 samples tested positive for Measles IgM antibodies. Health education given regarding isolation and early treatment of cases.

Jharkhand	Godda	v Measles	27	0	28/01/12	30/01/12	Under surveillance	Cases with maculopapular rashes, red eyes and rhinorrhoea reported from villages Paharpur & Devanchak, SC Maljhakra, CHC Meherma, Block Thakurgangti. District RRT visited the affected area and investigated the outbreak. Symptomatic treatment given to all cases. Health awareness camp conducted.
		Bokaro	vi Food Poisoning	133	1	30/01/12	31/01/12	Under control	Outbreak reported from Village Lalpur, Akrant, PHC Chandankiyari due to consumption of contaminated food (fish and rice). All patients treated in Chandankiyari Health Center and discharged after treatment. Medical Officer of PHC with medical team visited the affected area and investigated the outbreak. Health education given regarding hygiene and sanitation.

District RRT visited the affected area and investigated the outbreak. Stool samples collected and sent for lab analysis to Microbiology lab, Kottayam; samples tested positive for hanging drop. One sample sent for stool culture tested positive for <i>V. cholerae</i> (Ogawa). House to house visit done by medical team. Water sources chlorinated. Emergency medical camp conducted to treat cases. IEC activities undertaken regarding safe drinking water, hygienic practices and sanitation measures.
6.	Tamil Nadu	Shivaganga	viii Leptospirosis	13	0	28/01/12	29/01/12	Under surveillance	Cases reported from Singampunari, Piranmala. District RRT visited the affected area and investigated the outbreak. Out of 11 serum samples collected and tested at Leptospirosis Reference Lab, 6 tested positive for Leptospirosis (IgM ELISA). Paramedical staff deputed to the affected area for active surveillance. Mass fever survey done. IEC activities undertaken regarding personal protection measures to be adopted by the community.
			ix Leptospirosis	11	0	05/02/12	05/02/12	Under control	Cases reported from Village Thethampatti, PHC Pulithipatti, Block S. Pudhur. RRT visited and investigated the outbreak. Out of 5 serum samples collected and send to ZET Trichy, 2 samples tested positive for Leptospirosis (IgM ELISA). Chlorination of water sources done. Prophylactic treatment given to contacts. Mass fever survey done. IEC activities undertaken regarding personal protection measures.

IEC activities undertaken regarding isolation and early treatment of cases and proper nutrition of children.

Medical team visited affected area and gave symptomatic treatment to all cases along with Vitamin-A solution. House to house surveillance is going on. IEC activities undertaken regarding early treatment of cases and proper nutrition of children.

District RRT with block level paramedical Staff visited the affected area and investigated the outbreak. Active house to house survey conducted to find new cases. All cases treated. ORS packets and chlorine tablets distributed in the locality. Leakage in water pipeline repaired. Health education given regarding hygiene and sanitation.

ORS packets and chlorine tablets distributed in the locality. Cases treated. Leakage in water pipeline repaired. Health education given regarding hygiene and sanitation.
