

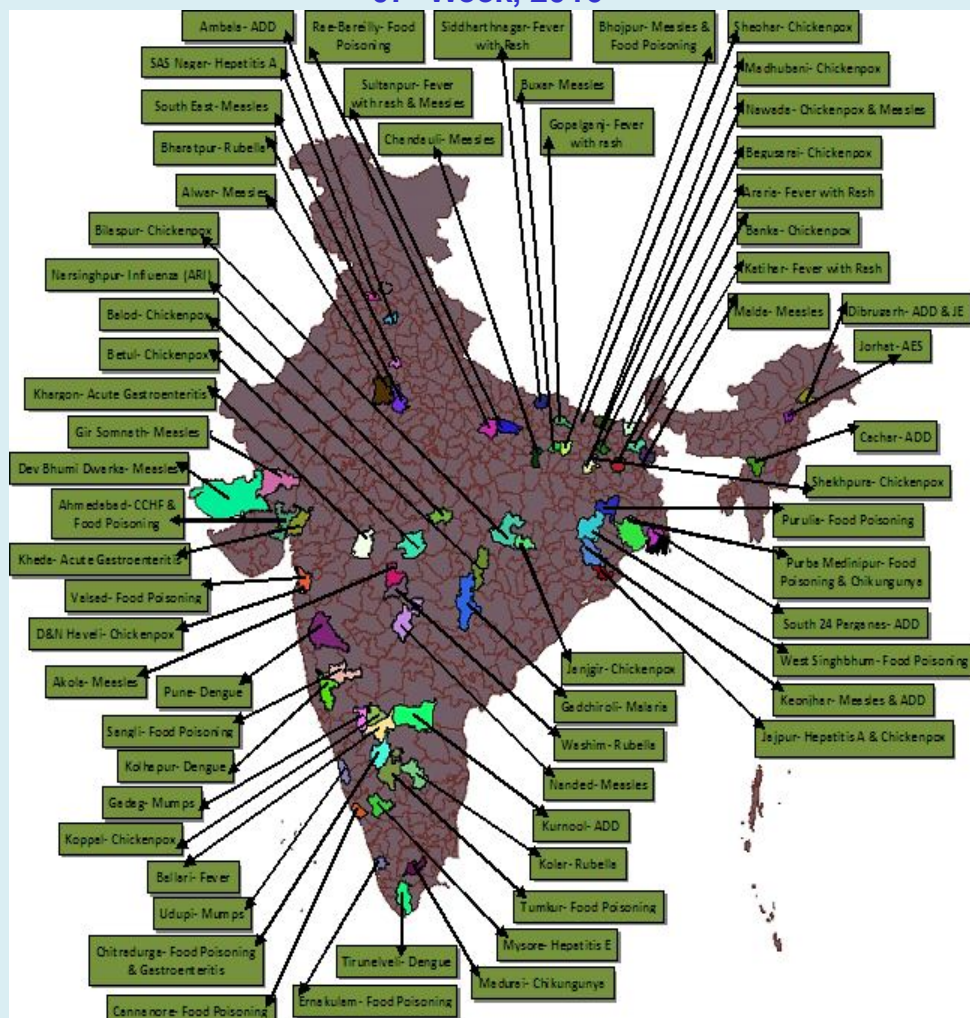

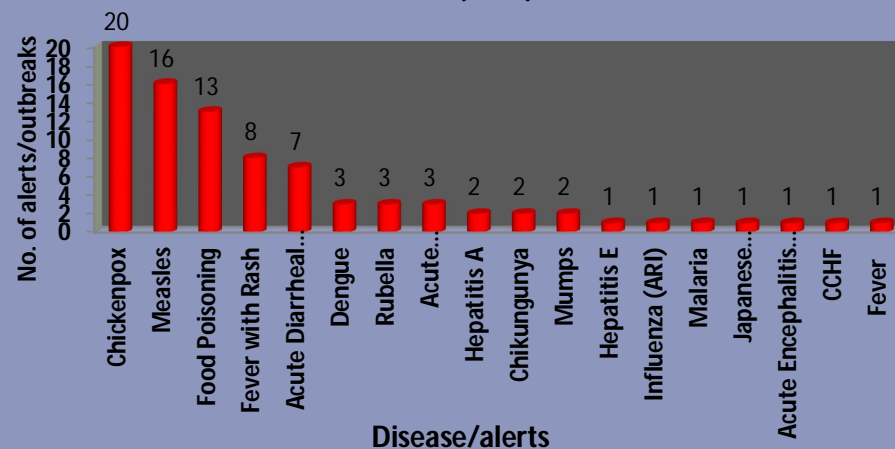

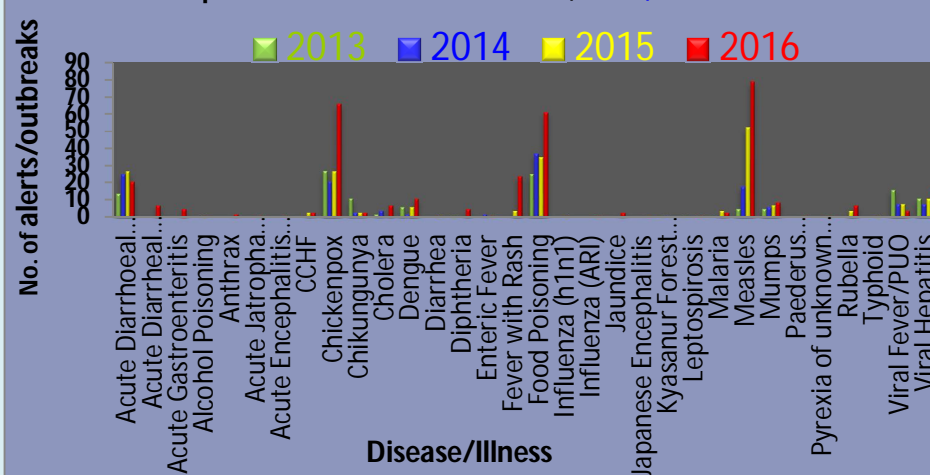
District wise disease alerts/outbreaks reported in the 07thWeek, 2016
