

Medical team visited the affected area and treated cases symptomatically. House to house surveillance done to find new cases and susceptible children were given prophylactic Vitamin A. Health education given regarding isolation and early treatment of cases. |

Halogen tablets and ORS packets distributed among the affected villagers. Temporary medical camp established in the village to treat cases and alternate drinking water provided till repair of water pipelines. IEC activities undertaken regarding drinking boiled water, personal hygiene and sanitation. |

Halogen tablets distributed among the households in the affected area. Health education given regarding hygiene and sanitation. |

IEC activities undertaken regarding hygiene and sanitation. |

Health education imparted among the school students. |

People instructed to drink boiled water and maintain sanitation and hygiene. |
