All the cases were treated at tertiary care hospital, Kozhikode. 1 death occurred (a female patient aged 50) on 18th February 2013. 4 serum samples were collected for KFD, Dengue, Leptospirosis, Scrub typhus and Borrelia species at Manipal Institute of Virological Research. All the 4 serum samples were tested positive for Borrelia species (IgM, IgG). All the confirmed cases gave a history of exposure to deer tick bites prior to the onset of symptoms. Community sensitization done regarding avoiding contact with deer ticks. Forest staff sensitized for prevention and control measures. Adequate stock of essential drugs and DMP oil made available at health centres. A central team has gone for investigation.
